

The Exalted Name and Word

Psalm 138:2 I bow down toward your Kadosh temple and give thanks to your Name for your steadfast love and your faithfulness, for you have exalted above all things your Name (8034. shem) and your Word (565. imrah / Commandment).

Proverbs 30:4 Who has gone up to the Shamyim (heavens) and come down? Who has gathered the wind in His fists? Who has bound the waters in a garment? Who established all the ends of the earth? What is His Name, and what is His Son's Name, If you know it?

Exodus 3:14-15 And Aluahym said to Moshah (Moses), HaYAH (HAUAH) Asher (HU) HaYAH (HAUAH); and He said, you shall say this to the sons of Yisrael, HaYAH (HAUAH) has sent me to you. And Aluahym said to Moshah (Moses) again, You shall say this to the sons of Yisrael, **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) the Aluahym of your fathers, the Aluahym of Abraham, the Aluahym of Isaac, and the Aluahym of Yaqoob (Jacob), has sent me to you. This is My Name forever, and this is My memorial from generation to generation.

Isaiah 42:8 I am **יְהוָה** (Yahuah); that is My Name; and I will not give My esteem to another, nor My praise to engraved images.

The Importance of the knowing the Name:

Psalms 85:10 Mercy and truth are met together; righteousness and shalum (peace) have kissed each other.

Psalms 86:15 But you, O **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), are a Aluahym merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness.

Psalms 99:5 Exalt **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) our Aluahym; worship at his footstool! Kadosh is he!

Psalms 99:9 Exalt **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) our Aluahym, and worship at his Kadosh hill; for **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) our Aluahym is Kadsosh.

Psalms 100:4-5 Enter his gates with thanksgiving, and his courts with praise! Give thanks to him; Baruch his Name!**5** For **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) is good; his steadfast love endures forever, and his faithfulness to all generations.

Psalms 115:1 Not to us, O **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), not to us, but to your Name give esteem, for the sake of your steadfast love and your faithfulness!

Exodus 9:16 “And for this reason I have raised you up, in order to show you My power, and in order to declare My Name in all the earth.

Deuteronomy 28:58-59 “If you do not guard to do all the Words of this Torah that are written in this book, to fear this esteemed and awesome Name, **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) your Aluahym, **59** then **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) shall bring upon you and your descendants extraordinary plagues, great and lasting plagues, and grievous and lasting sicknesses.” (Could this be part of the reason so many are sick?)

Jeremiah 23:26 “Till when shall it be in the heart of the prophets? – the prophets of falsehood

and prophets of the deceit of their own heart, 27 who try to make My people forget My Name by their dreams which everyone relates to his neighbor, as their fathers forgot My Name for Ba'al.

Do your Preachers and Bible teachers tell you that it is not important to acknowledge the Name of **יהוה** (Yahuah)? Note: the English word "Lord" is a direct translation of the Hebrew word "Ba'al". Are you praying to Ba'al or are you praying to **יהוה** (Yahuah)? In **1 Kings 18:21-40** we read the story of EliYah and the priests of Ba'al, the priests of Ba'al called out to "the Lord", EliYah called out to **יהוה** (Yahuah). (A shocking fact is that Webster's Dictionary defines Ba'al as The LORD, as does the Hebrew language)! Many today "blaspheme" the Name of our Father and Savior with a pagan name- The LORD (Ba'al).

Hosea 2:16-17 And at that day, says **יהוה** (Yahuah), you shall call Me, My husband; and you shall no more call me, My Ba'al (Lord). For I will take away the Names of the Ba'als out of her mouth; and they shall no more be remembered by their Name.

Exodus 20:7 "You do not bring the Name of **יהוה** (Yahuah) your Aluahym to naught, for **יהוה** (Yahuah) does not leave the one unpunished who brings His Name to naught (Shav), means to bring it to nothingness, to make it worthless by not declaring his Kadosh Name.

Psalms 140:13 Surely the righteous will give thanks to Your Name; The upright will dwell in Your presence.

Psalms 34:3 Oh, magnify **יהוה** (Yahuah) with me, and let us exalt his Name together!

Psalms 68:26 Baruch Aluahym in the congregations, Even **יהוה** (Yahuah), you who are of the fountain of Yisrael.

Psalms 104:1 Baruch **יהוה** (Yahuah), O my soul! O **יהוה** (Yahuah) my Aluahym, You are very great; You are clothed with splendor and majesty,

Psalms 106:1-2 Praise **יהוה** (Yahuah)! Oh give thanks to **יהוה** (Yahuah), for He is good; For His loving kindness is everlasting. Who can speak of the mighty deeds of **יהוה** (Yahuah), Or can show forth all His praise?

Psalms 111:1-10 Praise **יהוה** (Yahuah)! I will give thanks to **יהוה** (Yahuah) with all my heart, In the company of the upright and in the assembly. Great are the works of **יהוה** (Yahuah); They are studied by all who delight in them. Splendid and majestic is His work, And His righteousness endures forever.

Psalms 117:1-2 Praise **יהוה** (Yahuah), all nations; Praise Him, all peoples! For His loving kindness is great toward us, And the truth of **יהוה** (Yahuah) is everlasting. Praise **יהוה** (Yahuah)!

Psalms 135:1-3 Praise **יהוה** (Yahuah)! Praise the Name of **יהוה** (Yahuah); Praise Him, O servants of **יהוה** (Yahuah), You who stand in the house of **יהוה** (Yahuah), In the courts of the house of our Aluahym! Praise **יהוה** (Yahuah), for **יהוה** (Yahuah) is good; Sing praises to His Name, for it is lovely.

Psalms 150:1-2 Praise **יהוה** (Yahuah)! Praise **יהוה** (Yahuah) in His sanctuary; Praise Him in His mighty expanse. Praise Him for His mighty deeds; Praise Him according to His excellent greatness.

Luke 19:37-38 As soon as He was approaching, near the descent of the Mount of Olives, the whole crowd of the disciples began to praise **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) joyfully with a loud voice for all the miracles which they had seen, shouting: "Baruch is the King who comes in the Name of **יְהוָה** (Yahuah); Shalum (Peace) in Shamyim (heavens) and esteem in the highest!"

1 Chronicles 16:28-29 Ascribe (give) to **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), O families of the peoples, Ascribe to **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) glory and strength. Ascribe to **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) the glory due His Name; Bring an offering, and come before Him; Worship **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) in Kadosh array.

Psalms 96:3-9 Ascribe (give) to **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), O families of the peoples, Ascribe to **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) esteem and strength. Ascribe to **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) the esteem of His Name; Bring an offering and come into His courts. Worship **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) in Kadosh attire; Tremble before Him, all the earth.

Psalms 29:1-2 Ascribe (give) to **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), O sons of the mighty, Ascribe to **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) esteem and strength. Ascribe to **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) the esteem due to His Name; Worship **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) in Kadosh array.

Psalms 100:1-2 Shout joyfully to **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), all the earth. Serve **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) with gladness; Come before Him with joyful singing.

Malachi 2:4-7 "Then you will know that I have sent this Commandment to you, that My covenant may continue with Levi," says **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) of hosts. "My covenant with him was one of life and shalum (peace), and I gave them to him as an object of reverence; so he revered Me and stood in awe of My Name. "True instruction was in his mouth and unrighteousness was not found on his lips; he walked with Me in shalum (peace) and uprightness, and he turned many back from iniquity.

Psalms 34:1-3 I will Baruch **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) at all times; His praise shall continually be in my mouth. My soul will make its boast in **יְהוָה** (Yahuah); The humble will hear it and rejoice. O magnify **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) with me, And let us exalt His Name together.

Psalms 63:3-4 Because Your loving kindness is better than life, My lips will praise You. So I will Baruch You as long as I live; I will lift up my hands in Your Name.

Psalms 69:30-31 I will praise the Name of **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) with song And magnify Him with thanksgiving. And it will please **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) better than an ox Or a young bull with horns and hoofs.

Psalms 86:12-13 I will give thanks to You, O **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) my Aluahym, with all my heart, And will glorify Your Name forever. For Your loving kindness toward me is great, And You have delivered my soul from the depths of Sheol.

Revelation 15:2-4 And I saw something like a sea of glass mixed with fire, and those who had been victorious over the beast and his image and the number of his Name, standing on the sea of glass, holding harps of **יְהוָה** (Yahuah). And they sang the song of Moshah (Moses), the bond-servant of **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), and the song of the Lamb, saying, "Great and marvelous are Your works, O **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluahym, the Almighty; Righteous and true are Your ways, King of the nations! "Who will not fear, O **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), and glorify Your Name? For You alone are Kadosh; For all the Nations will come and worship before you, for your righteous acts have been revealed."

Isaiah 26:13 O אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) our Aluahym, other masters besides You have ruled us; But through You alone we confess Your Name.

Malachi 2:1-2 "And now this Commandment is for you, O priests. "If you do not listen, and if you do not take it to heart to give honor to My Name," says אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) of hosts, "then I will send the curse upon you and I will curse your barachah; and indeed, I have cursed them already, because you are not taking it to heart.

Psalms 91:14-16 Because he has set his love on Me, therefore I will deliver him; I will set Him on high because He has known My Name. He shall call on Me and I will answer Him; I will be with Him in distress; I will rescue Him and honor Him. I will satisfy him with length of days and will make him see My salvation.

Isaiah 52:5-6 So then what is to Me here, declares אַיָּהּ (Yahuah)? For My people is taken for nothing; his rulers howl, declares אַיָּהּ (Yahuah). And My Name is continually despised, every day. So My people shall know My Name thus in that day; for I am He speaking. Behold Me!

Jeremiah 16:21 And, behold, I will make them know; this time I will cause them to know My hand and My might; and they shall know that My Name is אַיָּהּ (Yahuah).

Malachi 1:11 For from the east to the west, My Name shall be great among the nations, and everywhere incense shall be offered to My Name; and a pure food offering; for My Name shall be great among the nations, says אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) of hosts.

Is אַיָּהּ (Yahuah)'s Name only for the Yisraelites and Hebrews?

Malachi 1:14 But cursed be a deceiver and there is a male in his flock, yet he vows it, but he sacrifices a blemished one to אַיָּהּ (Yahuah). For I am a great King, says אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) of hosts, and My Name is feared among the nations.

Malachi 2:2 If you will not hear, and if you will not set it on your heart to give esteem to My Name, says אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) of hosts, then I will send the curse on you, and I will curse your barachah And indeed, I have cursed it, because you are not setting it on your heart.

Are you willing to defy אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) and suffer His curses?

Psalms 68:4 Sing to Aluahym, sing praise to His name; lift up for Him who rides in the deserts; by His name אַהּ (Yah); and rejoice in His presence.

Psalms 135:3 Praise אַיָּהּ (Yahuah)! For אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) is good! Sing praises to His Name, for it is delightful.

Psalms 148:13 Let them praise the Name of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah); for His Name alone is exalted; His esteem is above the earth and Shamyim (Heavens).

Isaiah 47:4 Our Redeemer; אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) of Hosts is His Name, the Kadosh One of Yisrael.

Psalms 103:1 Barach אַיָּהּ (Yahuah), O my soul; and all within me, Barach His Kadosh Name.

Psalm 23:1-6 אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) is my shepherd; I shall not want. He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters. He restores my soul. He leads me in paths of righteousness for his Name's sake. Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of

death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me. You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; you anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. ...

Revelation 14:1 And I saw, and behold, the Lamb standing on Mount Zion! And with Him were a hundred and forty four thousand (144,000), with the Name of His Father having been written on their foreheads.

Revelation 11:18 And the nations were full of wrath; and Your wrath came, and the time of the judging of the dead, and to give the reward to Your slaves, to the prophets, and to the Chosen believers, and to the ones fearing Your Name, to the small and to the great, and to destroy those destroying the earth.

Revelation 3:8 I know your works. Behold, I have given a door being opened before you, and no one is able to shut it, for you have a little power and have kept My Word, and have not denied My Name.

John 17:6 I I revealed Your Name to the men whom You gave to Me out of the world. They were Yours, and You gave them to Me; and they have kept Your Word.

The Savior, **OWYAZL** (Yahusha) HaMashiach, states clearly in recorded scripture that He taught the Name of **AYAZL** (Yahuah) to the disciples and they kept his Word.

Importance of knowing the Word (Torah)

Isaiah 42:21 - **AYAZL** (Yahuah) was pleased, for his righteousness' sake, to magnify his Torah and make it glorious.

Psalms 56:4 - In Aluahym I will Halal (praise) his Word, in Aluahym I have put my trust; I will not fear what flesh can do unto me.

Psalms 56:10 - In Aluahym will I Halal (praise) his Dabar (Word): in **AYAZL** (Yahuah) will I Halal (praise) his Dabar (word).

2 Timothy 3:16-17 All Scripture is breathed out by Aluahym and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, that the man of **AYAZL** (Yahuah) may be competent, equipped for every good work.

Matthew 5:18 - For verily I say unto you, Till Shamyim (Heavens) and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the Torah (law), till all be fulfilled.

Matthew 24:35 - Shamyim (Heavens) and earth shall pass away, but my Words shall not pass away.

Isaiah 42:21 **AYAZL** (Yahuah) was pleased for His righteousness' sake To make the Torah (law) great and glorious.

Ezekiel 3:1-27 And he said to me, “Son of man, eat whatever you find here. Eat this scroll, and go, speak to the house of Yisrael.” So I opened my mouth, and he gave me this scroll to eat. And he said to me, “Son of man, feed your belly with this scroll that I give you and fill your stomach with it.” Then I ate it, and it was in my mouth as sweet as honey. And he said to me, “Son of man, go to the house of Yisrael and speak with my words to them. For you are not sent to a people of foreign speech and a hard language, but to the house of Yisrael— ...

Psalm 103:19-22 אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) has established His throne in the Shamyim (heavens), And His sovereignty rules over all. Baruch אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), you His Malakym (Angels), Mighty in strength, who perform His Word, Obeying the voice of His Word! Baruch אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), all you His hosts, You who serve Him, doing His Will.

Psalm 119:105 Your Word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.

Joshua 1:8 This Book of the Torah (Law) shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.

Matthew 4:4 But he answered, “It is written, “Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every Word that comes from the mouth of Aluahym.””

Romans 15:4 For whatever was written in former days was written for our instruction, that through endurance and through the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope.

Hebrews 4:12 For the Word of אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

1 Timothy 4:13 Until I come, devote yourself to the public reading of Scripture, to exhortation, to teaching.

Psalm 119:18 Open my eyes, that I may behold wondrous things out of your Torah (law).

Psalm 119:10-11 With my whole heart I seek you; let me not wander from your Commandments! I have stored up your Word in my heart, that I might not sin against you.

John 15:7 If you abide in me, and my Words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you.

John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God (Aluah), and the Word was god (Aluahym).

Psalm 1:2 But his delight is in the Torah of אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), and on his Torah he meditates day and night.

2 Timothy 2:15 Do your best to present yourself to Aluahym as one approved, a worker who has no need to be ashamed, rightly handling the Word of truth (Torah).

Psalm 119:1-176 Baruch (Blessed) are those whose way is blameless, who walk in the Torah of אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah)! Baruch (Blessed) are those who keep his testimonies, who seek him with their whole heart, who also do no wrong, but walk in his ways! You have Commanded your precepts to be kept diligently. Oh that my ways may be steadfast in keeping your statutes! ...

Isaiah 40:8 The grass withers, the flower fades, but the Word of our Aluahym will stand forever.

Psalm 56:4 In Aluahym, whose Word I praise, in Aluahym I trust; I shall not be afraid. What can flesh do to me?

1 Timothy 4:5-6 For it is made Kadosh by the Word of אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) and prayer. If you put these things before the brothers, you will be a good servant of אֱלֹהִים (Yahusha HaMashiach),

being trained in the Words of the Amunah (faith) and of the good doctrine that you have followed.

2 Timothy 3:16 All Scripture (Word) is breathed out by Aluahym and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness,

Proverbs 30:5 Every Word of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) proves true; he is a shield to those who take refuge in him.

Isaiah 55:10-11 “For as the rain and the snow come down from Shamyim and do not return there but water the earth, making it bring forth and sprout, giving seed to the sower and bread to the eater, so shall my Word be that goes out from my mouth; it shall not return to me empty, but it shall accomplish that which I purpose, and shall succeed in the thing for which I sent it.

James 1:19-25 Know this, my beloved brothers: let every person be quick to hear, slow to speak, slow to anger; for the anger of man does not produce the righteousness of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah). Therefore put away all filthiness and rampant wickedness and receive with meekness the implanted Word, which is able to save your souls. But be doers of the Word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. For if anyone is a hearer of the Word and not a doer, he is like a man who looks intently at his natural face in a mirror. ...

John 8:32 And you will know the truth (Torah), and the truth (Torah) will set you free.”

Acts 17:11 Now these Hebrews were more noble than those in Thessalonica; they received the Word with all eagerness, examining the Scriptures daily to see if these things were so.

Psalms 19:7-11 The Torah of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) is perfect, reviving the soul; the testimony of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) is sure, making wise the simple; the precepts of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) are right, rejoicing the heart; the Commandment of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) is pure, enlightening the eyes; the fear of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) is clean, enduring forever; the rules of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) are true, and righteous altogether. More to be desired are they than gold, even much fine gold; sweeter also than honey and drippings of the honeycomb. Moreover, by them is your servant warned; in keeping them there is great reward.

Psalms 119:11 I have stored up your Word in my heart, that I might not Sin against you.

John 5:39-40 You search the Scriptures because you think that in them you have eternal life; and it is they that bear witness about me, yet you refuse to come to me that you may have life.

John 17:17 Sanctify them in the truth (Torah); your Word (Torah) is truth.

1 Thessalonians 2:13 And we also thank אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) constantly for this, that when you received the Word of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), which you heard from us, you accepted it not as the word of men but as what it really is, the Word of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), which is at work in you believers.

Romans 10:17 So Amunah (faith) comes from hearing, and hearing through the Word of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah).

Psalms 119:9-11 How can a young man keep his way pure? By guarding it according to your Word. With my whole heart I seek you; let me not wander from your Commandments! I have stored up your Word in my heart, that I might not sin against you.

Psalms 33:4 For the Word of אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) is upright, and all his work is done in faithfulness.

Isaiah 55:11 So shall my Word be that goes out from my mouth; it shall not return to me empty, but it shall accomplish that which I purpose, and shall succeed in the thing for which I sent it.

Mark 12:24 אֱלֹהִים (Yahusha) said to them, “Is this not the reason you are wrong, because you know neither the Scriptures nor the power of Aluahym?”

Proverbs 4:20-22 My son, be attentive to my Words; incline your ear to my sayings. Let them not escape from your sight; keep them within your heart. For they are life to those who find them, and healing to all their flesh.

2 Peter 1:20-21 Knowing this first (1st) of all, that no prophecy of Scripture comes from someone's own interpretation. For no prophecy was ever produced by the will of man, but men spoke from Aluahym as they were carried along by the Ruach HaKodesh.

Jeremiah 15:16 Your Words were found, and I ate them, and your Words became to me a joy and the delight of my heart, for I am called by your Name, O אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), Aluahym of hosts.

Ephesians 5:26 That he might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the Word,

Ezra 7:10 For Ezra had set his heart to study the Torah of אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), and to do it and to teach his statutes and rules in Yisrael.

John 15:1-27 “I am the true vine, and my Father is the vine dresser. Every branch in me that does not bear fruit he takes away, and every branch that does bear fruit he prunes, that it may bear more fruit. Already you are clean because of the Word that I have spoken to you. Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in me. I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing. ...

Proverbs 4:20 My son, be attentive to my Words; incline your ear to my sayings.

Psalms 18:30 This Aluahym—his way is perfect; the Word of אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) proves true; he is a shield for all those who take refuge in him.

Psalms 119:9 How can a young man keep his way pure? By guarding it according to your Word.

Deuteronomy 8:3 And he humbled you and let you hunger and fed you with manna, which you did not know, nor did your fathers know, that he might make you know that man does not live by bread alone, but man lives by every Word that comes from the mouth of אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah).

John 8:31 So אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) said to the Hebrews who had believed in him, “If you abide in my Word, you are truly my disciples,

John 6:63 It is the Ruach who gives life; the flesh is no help at all. The Words that I have spoken to you are Ruach and life.

Psalms 1:1-2 Baruch (Blessed) is the man who walks not in the counsel of the wicked, nor

stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of scoffers; but his delight is in the Torah of **אֵלֹהִים** (Yahuah), and on his Torah he meditates day and night.

Jeremiah 29:13 You will seek me and find me, when you seek me with all your heart.

Proverbs 30:5-6 Every Word of **אֵלֹהִים** (Yahuah) proves true; he is a shield to those who take refuge in him. Do not add to his Words, lest he rebuke you and you be found a liar.

Psalms 119:130 The unfolding of your Words gives light; it imparts understanding to the simple.

1 Peter 1:23 Since you have been reborn again from above, not of perishable seed but of imperishable, through the living and abiding Word of **אֵלֹהִים** (Yahuah);

Deuteronomy 10:16-21 “You shall therefore lay up these Words of mine in your heart and in your soul, and you shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. You shall teach them to your children, talking of them when you are sitting in your house, and when you are walking by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise. You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates, that your days and the days of your children may be multiplied in the land that **אֵלֹהִים** (Yahuah) swore to your fathers to give them, as long as the Shamyim (heavens) are above the earth.

John 7:38 Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, ‘Out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.’”
