

Halal (Praise)

Scripture commands all living creatures to Halal (praise) **אָהַל** (Yahuah) (**Psalm 150:6**).

Enter his gates with thanksgiving (Todah), and his courts with praise (Tehillah)! Give thanks to him; Barak (bless) his name! **Psalm 100:4**

Halal 1984 is a primary Hebrew root word used in Hebrew for praise. Our word "HalluYAH (**Psalm 106:1**) as written in Greek as halleluYah" comes from this base word. It means "to be clear, to shine, to boast, show, to rave, celebrate, to be clamorously foolish."

Tehillah 8416 is derived from the word halal and means "the singing of halals, to sing or to laud; perceived to involve music, especially singing; hymns of the Ruach (Spirit).

Yadah 3034 is a verb with a root meaning, "the extended hand, to throw out the hand, therefore to worship with extended hand."

Towdah comes from the same principle root word as yadah, but is used more specifically. Towdah literally means, "an extension of the hand in adoration, avowal, or acceptance." By way of application, it is apparent in the Psalms and elsewhere that it is used for thanking **אָהַל** (Yahuah) for "things not yet received" as well as things already at hand.

Zamar means "to pluck the strings of an instrument, to sing, to praise; a musical word which is largely involved with joyful expressions of music with musical instruments.

Meaning of Praise:

1. (v.) To commend; to applaud; to express approbation of; to laud; -- applied to a person or his acts.
2. (v.) To extol in words or song; to magnify; to glorify on account of perfections or excellent works; to do honor to; to display the excellence of; -- applied especially to the Divine Being.
3. (v.) To value; to appraise.
4. (v.) Commendation for worth; approval expressed; honor rendered because of excellence or worth; laudation; approbation.
5. (v.) Especially, the joyful tribute of gratitude or homage rendered to the Divine Being; the act of glorifying or extolling the Creator; worship, particularly worship by song, distinction from prayer and other acts of worship; as, a service of Halal (praise).
6. (n.) The object, ground, or reason of Halal (praise).

The word Praise comes from the Latin pretium, "price," or "value," and may be defined generally as an ascription of value or worth. Praise may be bestowed upon unworthy objects or from improper motives, but true praise consists in a sincere acknowledgment of a real conviction of worth. Its type may be seen in the representation given in adoration of **אָהַל** (Yahuah) and of his son **וְיָהוּשָׁא** (Yahusha), which is inspired by a sense of their worthiness to be adored (**Revelation 4:11; Revelation 5:12**).

אָהַל (Yahuah) is the Object of Halal (praise):

In scripture it is **אָהַל** (Yahuah) who is especially brought before us as the object of Halal (praise). His whole creation praises Him, from the Malakym (angels) of Shamyim (heavens) (**Psalm**

103:20 Revelation 5:11) to those lower existences that are unconscious or even inanimate (**Psalm 19:1-4; Psalm 148:1-10 Revelation 5:13**). But it is with the Todah (praises) offered to **יהוה** (Yahuah) by man, and with the human duty of praising **יהוה** (Yahuah), that the Scriptures are principally concerned.

Psalm uses the term Halal (praise) 50 times. (13) thirteen times in (6) six verses. The first verse provides the “where” of Halal (praise)—everywhere! “Halal (Praise) **יהוה** (Yahuah) in his sanctuary; Halal (praise) him in his mighty Shamyim (heavens).

- The next verse teaches “why” to Halal (praise) **יהוה** (Yahuah): “Halal (praise) him for his acts of power; Halal (praise) him for his surpassing greatness.”

- Verses 3–6 note “how” to Halal (praise) **יהוה** (Yahuah)—with a variety of instruments, dance, and everything that has breath. Every means we have to make sound is to be used to Halal (praise) **יהוה** (Yahuah)!

The Hebrew words translated as “praise” have a deeper meaning than is conveyed in English. They instruct the worshiper is to take specific physical action.

The Grounds of Halal (praise).

Sometimes **יהוה** (Yahuah) is praised for His inherent qualities. His majesty (**Psalm 104:1**) or Kadoshness (holiness) (**Isaiah 6:3**) fills the mind, and He is "glorified as Aluah (God)" (**Romans 1:21**) More frequently He is praised for His works in creation, providence, and redemption.

The Modes of Praise.

True Halal (praise) of **יהוה** (Yahuah), as distinguished from false Halal (praise) (**Isaiah 29:13, Matthew 15:8**), is first of all an inward emotion—a gladness and rejoicing of the heart (**Psalm 4:7; Psalm 33:21**), a music of the soul and Ruach (spirit) (**Psalm 103:1 Luke 1:46**), which no language can adequately express (**Psalm 106:2 2 Corinthians 9:15**). But utterance is natural to strong emotion, and the mouth instinctively strives to express the Todah (praises) of the heart (**Psalm 51:15**).

Many of the most moving passages in Scripture come from the inspiration of the Ruach (spirit) of Halal (praise) awakened by the power, the wisdom, the kindness and but above all by the revelation of **יהוה** (Yahuah)'s redeeming Ahavah (love).

The one who Zamar (praises) **יהוה** (Yahuah) desires to Halal (praise) Him in the hearing of other men (**Psalm 40:10**), and desires also that their Todah (praises) should be joined with his own (**Psalm 34:3**). Further, the Ruach (spirit) of Halal (praise) is a Ruach (spirit) of song. It may find expression in other ways—in sacrifice (**Leviticus 7:13**), or testimony (**Psalm 66:16**), or prayer (**Colossians 1:3**); but it finds its most natural and its fullest utterance in lyrical and musical forms.

When **יהוה** (Yahuah) fills the heart with Halal (praise), He puts a new song into the mouth (**Psalm 40:3**). The Book of Psalms is the proof of this for the Tanakh (Old Testament). And when we pass to the New Covenant we find that it is alike for Malakym (angels) and for mankind, for the higher moods of Halal (praise) express themselves in bursts of song (**Luke 2:14 Ephesians 5:19, Colossians 3:16, Revelation 5:9, Revelation 14:3, Revelation 15:3**).

Both in the Tanakh (Old Testament) and New Covenant (New Testament), the Ruach (spirit) of song gives birth to public Halal (praise). In their earlier expressions the Zamar (praises) of Yisrael were

joyful outbursts in which song was mingled with shouting and dancing to a rude accompaniment of timbrels and shofar's (**Exodus 15:20 2 Samuel 6:5, 14**).

The Duty of Halal (praise).

Halal (praise) is represented in scripture as a duty no less than a natural impulse and a delight. To fail in this duty is to withhold from אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah)'s esteem that belongs to Him (**Psalms 50:23 Romans 1:20**); it is to shut one's eyes to the signs of His presence (**Isaiah 40:26**), to be forgetful of His mercies (**Deuteronomy 6:12**), and unthankful for His kindness (**Luke 6:35**).

The book of Psalms is a collection of songs filled with Todah (praises) to אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah). Among them is **Psalm 9**, which says, "I will be glad and rejoice in you; I will sing the Zamar (praises) of your Name, O Most High" (verse 2). **Psalm 18:3** says אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) is "worthy of Halal (praise)." **Psalm 21:13** Zamar (praises) אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) both for who He is and for His great power: "Be exalted in your strength, אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah); we will sing and Halal (praise) your might."

Man can also be the Object of Halal (praise):

Man can also be the object of praise, and may receive it either from אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) or from his fellow-men. There is a praise which is itself a condemnation (**Luke 6:26**) Woe to you, when all people speak well of you, for so their fathers did to the false prophets, an honor which seals the eyes in unbelief (**John 5:44**), a careless use of "good" which is dishonoring to אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) (**Luke 18:19**) And **OWYָּאֵל** (Yahusha) said to him, "Why do you call me good? No one is good except אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) alone. . This is the "praise of men" which **OWYָּאֵל** (Yahusha) warned His followers to shun as being incompatible with the "Halal (praise) of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah)" (**Matthew 6:1-4; John 12:43, Galatians 1:10, 1 Thessalonians 2:6**).

On the other hand, there is a praise that is the instinctive homage of the soul to righteousness (**Luke 23:47**). Such praise, so far from being incompatible with the Halal (praise) of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), is a reflection of it in human consciousness; and so Paul associates Halal (praise) with virtue as an aid and incentive to Kadosh (holy) living on which the mind should dwell (**Philippians 4:8**).

Scriptural worship is expressed not only with our whole life (**Romans 12:1**), but with our whole body. Scripture models corporate praise as a whole group activity. It has nothing to do with entertainment or putting on a show to attract seekers. It is intended for everyone to participate.

Actions speak louder than words. Your outward expression reveals your heart attitude. Sometimes we don't feel like worshipping and praising, we have to choose to Halal (praise) even when we don't feel like it.

Choosing to engage with אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) will change your attitude. אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) promises to reward those who choose to draw near to him (**James 4:8**) Literally, choosing to Halal (praise) אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) is a transformative experience, it renews your mind.

"Be transformed by the renewing of your mind" **Romans 12:2**

Always giving thanks for all things in the name of our Adon **OWYָּאֵל** (Yahusha) to אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), even the Father; **Ephesians 5:20**

1 Chronicles 16:8 Oh give thanks (Todah) to אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), call upon His name; Make known His deeds among the peoples.

Psalms 103:1-5 Barak (Bless) אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), O my soul, And all that is within me, barak (bless) His

Kadosh (holy) name. Barak (Bless) **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah), O my soul, And forget none of His benefits; Who pardons all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases.

Attitudes Of Praise

Hebrews 13:15 Through Him then, let us continually offer up a sacrifice of Halal (praise) to **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah), that is, the fruit of lips that give thanks to His name.

Eternal Halal (praise) For they exchanged the truth of **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) for a lie, and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is Baruch (blessed) forever. Aman.

I Will Halal (Praise) You With Music

Psalm 104:33 I will sing to **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) as long as I live; I will sing Halal (praise) to my Aluah (God) while I have my being.

I Will Sing Praises

Psalm 51:14 Deliver me from bloodguiltiness, O **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah), the Aluah (God) of my salvation; Then my tongue will joyfully sing of Your righteousness.

Halal (Praise) אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) For His Benefits

Deuteronomy 8:10 "When you have eaten and are satisfied, you shall bark (bless) **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) your Aluah (God) for the good land which He has given you.

Halal (Praise) אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) With Music!

Jeremiah 20:13 Sing to **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah), Halal (praise) **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah)! For He has delivered the soul of the needy one From the hand of evildoers.

Halal (Praise) אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah)!

Psalm 105:45 So that they might keep His statutes And observe His laws, Halal (praise) **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah)!

Halal (Praise) To אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Is Fitting

Psalm 145:3 Great is **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah), and highly to be praised, And His greatness is unsearchable.

Halal (Praise), Examples

Genesis 14:18-20 And Melchizedek king of Salem brought out bread and wine; now he was a priest of **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) Most High.

Manner And Methods Of Halal (Praise)

Psalm 28:7 **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) is my strength and my shield; My heart trusts in Him, and I am helped; Therefore my heart exults, And with my song I shall thank Him.

Nature Of Halal (Praise)

2 Samuel 22:4 "I call upon אֱלֹהֵי (Yahuah), who is worthy to be praised, And I am saved from my enemies.

Reasons For Halal (Praise)

Psalm 68:32 Sing to אֱלֹהֵי (Yahuah), O kingdoms of the earth, Sing Zamar (praises) to אֱלֹהֵי (Yahuah), Selah.

Offered By Praise

Psalm 47:7 For אֱלֹהֵי (Yahuah) is the King of all the earth; Sing Zamar (praises) with a skillful psalm.

Prayer, As Praise And Thanksgiving

Philippians 4:6 Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to אֱלֹהֵי (Yahuah).

Showing Forth His Halal (Praise)

Isaiah 43:21 "The people whom I formed for Myself Will declare My Halal (praise).

The Ruach And Halal (Praise)

John 4:23-24 "But an hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in Ruach (spirit) and Torah (truth); for such people the Father seeks to be His worshipers.

Those Singing Halal (Praise)

Ezra 3:11 They sang, praising and Todah (giving thanks) to אֱלֹהֵי (Yahuah), saying, "For He is good, for His loving kindness is upon Israel forever." And all the people shouted with a great shout when they praised אֱלֹהֵי (Yahuah) because the foundation of the house of אֱלֹהֵי (Yahuah) was laid.

Psalm 35:28 And my tongue shall declare Your righteousness And Your praise all day long.

Psalm 96:1 Sing to אֱלֹהֵי (Yahuah) a new song; Sing to אֱלֹהֵי (Yahuah), all the earth.

Psalm 98:1 O sing to אֱלֹהֵי (Yahuah) a new song, For He has done wonderful things, His right hand and His Kadosh (holy) arm have gained the victory for Him.

James 5:13 Is anyone among you suffering? Then he must pray Is anyone cheerful? He is to sing Todah (praises).

Exodus 15:2 "אֱלֹהֵי (Yahuah) is my strength and song, And He has become my salvation; This is my Aluah (God), and I will Halal (praise) Him; My father's Aluah (God), and I will extol Him.

Deuteronomy 10:21 "He is your Halal (praise) and He is your Aluah (God), who has done these great and awesome things for you which your eyes have seen.

Judges 5:3 "Hear, O kings; give ear, O rulers! To אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), I will sing, I will sing Halal (praise) to אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), the Aluah (God) of Yisrael.

2 Samuel 22:50 "Therefore I will Todah (give thanks) to You, O אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), among the nations, And I will sing Zamar (praises) to Your name.

1 Chronicles 29:13 "Now therefore, our Aluah (God), we thank You (Todah), and Halal (praise) Your glorious name.

Psalm 35:18 I will give You thanks in the great congregation; I will Halal (praise) You among a mighty throng.

Psalm 35:28 And my tongue shall declare Your righteousness And Your Halal (praise) all day long.

Psalm 43:4 Then I will go to the altar of אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), To אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) my exceeding joy; And upon the lyre I shall halal (praise) You, O אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), my Aluah (God).

Psalm 92:1 It is good to give thanks to אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) And to sing Todah (praises) to Your name, O Most High;

Psalm 100:4 Enter His gates with thanksgiving And His courts with Halal (praise), Todah (Give thanks) to Him, barak (bless) His name.

Psalm 101:1 I will sing of lovingkindness and justice, To You, O אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), I will sing Zamar (praises).

Psalm 138:1 I will give You thanks with all my heart; I will sing Zamar (praises) to You before the Alahym (gods).

Jeremiah 17:14 Heal me, O אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), and I will be healed; Save me and I will be saved, For You are my Halal (praise).

Daniel 2:23 "To You, O Aluah (God) of my fathers, I Todah (give thanks) and Halal (praise), For You have given me wisdom and power; Even now You have made known to me what we requested of You, For You have made known to us the king's matter."

1 Peter 2:9 But you are a CHOSEN RACE, A ROYAL PRIESTHOOD, A KADOSH (HOLY) NATION, A PEOPLE FOR אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah)'s OWN POSSESSION, so that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;

Revelation 7:12 saying, "Aman, Barachah (blessing) and Esteem (glory) and wisdom and thanksgiving and honor and power and might, be to our Aluah (God) forever and ever Aman."

Exodus 15:11 "Who is like You among the Alahym (gods), O אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah)? Who is like You, majestic in Kadoshnes (holiness), Awesome in Zamar (praises), working wonders?"

2 Samuel 22:4 "I call upon אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), who is worthy to be praised, And I am saved from my enemies.

1 Chronicles 16:9 Sing to Him, sing Zamar (praises) to Him; Speak of all His wonders.

1 Chronicles 16:25 For great is אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), and greatly to be praised; He also is to be feared above all Alahym (gods).

1 Chronicles 16:34-36 O Todah (give thanks) to אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), for He is good; For His lovingkindness is everlasting. Then say, "Save us, O אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) of our salvation, And gather us and deliver us from the nations, To give thanks to Your Kadosh (holy) name, And glory in Your Halal (praise)." Barach (Blessed) be אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), the Aluah (God) of Israel, From everlasting even to everlasting Then all the people said, "Aman," and Halal (praise) אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah).

2 Chronicles 5:13-14 in unison when the trumpeters and the singers were to make themselves heard with one voice to Halal (praise) and to esteem (glorify) אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), and when they lifted up their voice accompanied by trumpets and cymbals and instruments of music, and when they praised אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) saying, "He indeed is good for His lovingkindness is everlasting," then the house, the house of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), was filled with a cloud, so that the priests could not stand to minister because of the cloud, for the esteem of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) filled the house of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah).

2 Chronicles 7:3 All the sons of Israel, seeing the fire come down and the esteem (glory) of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) upon the house, bowed down on the pavement with their faces to the ground, and they worshiped and gave Halal (praise) to אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), saying, "Truly He is good, truly His lovingkindness is everlasting."

Ezra 3:11 They sang, praising and giving thanks to אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), saying, "For He is good, for His lovingkindness is upon Yisrael forever." And all the people shouted with a great shout when they praised אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) because the foundation of the house of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) was laid.

Nehemiah 9:5 Then the Levites, **OWYָּאֵל** (Yahusha), Kadmiel, Bani, Hashabneiah, Sherebiah, Hodiah, Shebaniah and Pethahiah, said, "Arise, Barak (bless) אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) your Aluah (God) forever and ever! O may Your glorious name be Baruch (blessed) And exalted above all Baracah (blessing) and Halal (praise)!"

Psalms 2:11 Worship אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) with reverence And rejoice with trembling.

Psalms 7:17 I will Todah (give thanks) to אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) according to His righteousness And will sing Halal (praise) to the name of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) Most High.

Psalms 9:2 I will be glad and exult in You; I will sing Halal (praise) to Your name, O Most High.

Psalms 9:11 Sing Zamar (praises) to אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), who dwells in Zion; Declare among the peoples His deeds.

Psalms 18:3 I call upon אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), who is worthy to be praised, And I am saved from my enemies.

Psalms 18:49 Therefore I will Todah (give thanks) to You among the nations, O אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), And I will sing Zamar (praises) to Your name.

Psalms 21:13 Be exalted, O אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), in Your strength; We will sing and Halal (praise) Your power.

Psalms 22:22-23

I will tell of Your name to my brethren; In the midst of the assembly I will Halal (praise) You. You who fear אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), Halal (praise) Him; All you descendants of Yaqoob (Jacob), glorify Him, And stand in awe of Him, all you descendants of Yisrael.

Psalms 22:25-26 From You comes my Halal (praise) in the great assembly; I shall pay my vows before those who fear Him. The afflicted will eat and be satisfied; Those who seek Him will Halal (praise) אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) Let your heart live forever!

Psalms 30:4 Sing Halal (praise) to אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), you His righteous ones, And give thanks to His Kadosh (holy) name.

Psalms 30:11-12 You have turned for me my mourning into dancing; You have loosed my sackcloth and girded me with gladness, That my soul may sing Halal (praise) to You and not be silent O אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) my Aluah (God), I will give thanks to You forever.

Psalms 33:1-3 Sing for joy in אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), O you righteous ones; Halal (Praise) is becoming to the

upright. Todah (Give thanks) to אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) with the lyre; Sing Zamar (praises) to Him with a harp of ten strings. Sing to Him a new song; Play skillfully with a shout of joy.

Psalm 34:1-3 I will Barak (bless) אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) at all times; His Halal (praise) shall continually be in my mouth. My soul will make its boast in אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah); The humble will hear it and rejoice. O magnify אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) with me, And let us exalt His name together.

Psalm 40:3 He put a new song in my mouth, a song of Halal (praise) to our Aluah (God); Many will see and fear And will trust in אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah).

Psalm 42:5 Why are you in despair, O my soul? And why have you become disturbed within me? Hope in אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), for I shall again Halal (praise) Him For the help of His presence.

Psalm 42:11 Why are you in despair, O my soul? And why have you become disturbed within me? Hope in אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), for I shall yet Halal (praise) Him, The help of my countenance and my Aluah (God).

Psalm 47:6 Sing Zamar (praises) to אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), sing Zamar (praises); Sing Zamar (praises) to our King, sing Zamar (praises).

Psalm 48:1 Great is אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), and greatly to be praised, In the city of our Aluah (God), His Kadosh (holy) mountain.

Psalm 48:10 As is Your name, O אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), So is Your Halal (praise) to the ends of the earth; Your right hand is full of righteousness.

Psalm 51:15 O אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), open my lips, That my mouth may declare Your Halal (praise).

Psalm 56:4 In אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), whose word I Halal (praise), In אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) I have put my trust; I shall not be afraid What can mere man do to me?

Psalm 57:7 My heart is steadfast, O אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), my heart is steadfast; I will sing, yes, I will sing Zamar (praises)!

Psalm 57:9 I will give thanks to You, O אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), among the peoples; I will sing Zamar (praises) to You among the nations.

Psalm 59:17 O my strength, I will sing Zamar (praises) to You; For אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) is my stronghold, the Aluah (God) who shows me lovingkindness.

Psalm 61:8 So I will sing Halal (praise) to Your name forever, That I may pay my vows day by day.

Psalm 63:5 My soul is satisfied as with marrow and fatness, And my mouth offers Zamar (praises) with joyful lips.

Psalm 66:1-2

Shout joyfully to אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), all the earth; Sing the esteem (glory) of His name; Make His Halal (praise) glorious.

Psalm 66:4 "All the earth will worship You, And will sing praises to You; They will sing Zamar (praise)s to Your name." Selah.

Psalm 67:1-3 אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) be gracious to us and Barak (bless) us, And cause His face to shine upon us-- Selah. That Your way may be known on the earth, Your salvation among all nations. Let the peoples Halal (praise) You, O אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah); Let all the peoples Halal (praise) You.

Psalm 68:4 Sing to אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), sing Zamar (praises) to His name; Lift up a song for Him who rides through the deserts, Whose name is אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), and exult before Him.

Psalm 68:32 Sing to אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), O kingdoms of the earth, Sing Zamar (praises) to אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), Selah.

Psalm 69:30 I will Halal (praise) the name of אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) with song And magnify Him with thanksgiving.

Psalm 69:34 Let heaven and earth Halal (praise) Him, The seas and everything that moves in them.

Psalm 71:5-6 For You are my hope; O אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluah (God), You are my confidence from my youth. By You I have been sustained from my birth; You are He who took me from my mother's womb; My Halal (praise) is continually of You.

Psalm 71:8 My mouth is filled with Your Halal (praise) And with Your esteem (glory) all day long.

Psalm 71:14 But as for me, I will hope continually, And will Halal (praise) You yet more and more.

Psalm 74:21 Let not the oppressed return dishonored; Let the afflicted and needy Halal (praise) Your name.

Psalm 75:9 But as for me, I will declare it forever; I will sing praises to the Aluah (God) of Yaqoob (Jacob).

Psalm 78:4 We will not conceal them from their children, But tell to the generation to come the praises of אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), And His strength and His wondrous works that He has done.

Psalm 79:13 So we Your people and the sheep of Your pasture Will give thanks to You forever; To all generations we will tell of Your Halal (praise).

Psalm 89:5 The Shamyim (heavens) will Halal (praise) Your wonders, O אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah); Your faithfulness also in the assembly of the Kadosh (holy) ones.

Psalm 96:4 For great is אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) and greatly to be praised; He is to be feared above all Alahym (gods).

Psalm 98:4-5 Shout joyfully to אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), all the earth; Break forth and sing for joy and sing praises. Sing Zamar (praises) to אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) with the lyre, With the lyre and the sound of melody.

Psalm 99:3 Let them Halal (praise) Your great and awesome name; Kadosh (Holy) is He.

Psalm 102:18 This will be written for the generation to come, That a people yet to be created may Halal (praise) אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah).

Psalm 104:33 I will sing to אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) as long as I live; I will sing Halal (praise) to my Aluah (God) while I have my being.

Psalm 104:35 Let sinners be consumed from the earth And let the wicked be no more Barak (Bless) אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), O my soul Halal (Praise) אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah)!

Psalm 105:2 Sing to Him, sing Zamar (praises) to Him; Speak of all His wonders.

Psalm 106:1 Halal (Praise) אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah)! Oh give thanks to אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), for He is good; For His lovingkindness is everlasting.

Psalm 106:47-48 Save us, O אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) our Aluah (God), And gather us from among the nations, To give thanks to Your Kadosh (holy) name And glory in Your Halal (praise). Barauch (Blessed) be HWHY (Yahuah), the Aluah (God) of Yisrael, From everlasting even to everlasting. And let all the people say, "Aman." Halal (Praise) אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah)!

Psalm 107:32 Let them extol Him also in the congregation of the people, And praise Him at the seat of the elders.

Psalm 108:1 My heart is steadfast, O **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah); I will sing, I will sing Zamar (praises), even with my soul.

Psalm 108:3 I will Todah (give thanks) to You, O **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah), among the peoples, And I will sing Zamar (praises) to You among the nations.

Psalm 109:30 With my mouth I will give thanks abundantly to **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah); And in the midst of many I will Halal (praise) Him.

Psalm 111:1 Praise **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah)! I will give thanks to **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah) with all my heart, In the company of the upright and in the assembly.

Psalm 111:10 The fear (Reverence) of **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah) is the beginning of wisdom; A good understanding have all those who do His commandments; His Halal (praise) endures forever.

Psalm 112:1 Halal (Praise) **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah)! How Baruch (blessed) is the man who fears **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah), Who greatly delights in His commandments.

Psalm 113:1 Halal (Praise) **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah)! Halal (Praise), O servants of **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah), Halal (Praise) the name of **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah).

Psalm 113:3 From the rising of the sun to its setting The name of **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah) is to be praised.

Psalm 115:17-18 The dead do not Halal (praise) **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah), Nor do any who go down into silence; But as for us, we will Barak (bless) **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah) From this time forth and forever. Halal (Praise) **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah)!

Psalm 117:1-2 Halal (Praise) **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah), all nations; Laud Him, all peoples! For His lovingkindness is great toward us, And the truth of **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah) is everlasting. Halal (Praise) **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah)!

Psalm 119:164 (7) Seven times a day I Halal (praise) You, Because of Your righteous ordinances.

Psalm 119:171 Let my lips utter Halal (praise), For You teach me Your statutes.

Psalm 119:175 Let my soul live that it may Halal (praise) You, And let Your ordinances help me.

Psalm 135:1-3 Halal (Praise) **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah)! Halal (Praise) the name of **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah); Halal (Praise) Him, O servants of **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah), You who stand in the house of **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah), In the courts of the house of our Aluah (God)! Praise **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah), for **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah) is good; Sing praises to His name, for it is lovely.

Psalm 135:21 Baruch (Blessed) be **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah) from Zion, Who dwells in Jerusalem. Halal (Praise) **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah)!

Psalm 145:1-4 I will extol You, my Aluah (God), O King, And I will Barak (bless) Your name forever and ever. Every day I will Barak (bless) You, And I will Halal (praise) Your name forever and ever. Great is **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah), and highly to be praised, And His greatness is unsearchable.

Psalm 145:21 My mouth will speak the Halal (praise) of **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah), And all flesh will Barak (bless) His Kadosh (holy) name forever and ever.

Psalm 146:1-2 Halal (Praise) **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah)! Halal (Praise) **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah), O my soul! I will Halal (praise) **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah) while I live; I will sing praises to my Aluah (God) while I have my being.

Psalm 146:10 **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah) will reign forever, Your Aluah (God), O Zion, to all generations. Halal (Praise) **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah)!

Psalm 147:1 Praise **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahuah)! For it is good to sing Zamar (praises) to our Aluah (God); For it

is pleasant and Halal (praise) is becoming.

Psalm 148:1-5 Halal (Praise) אַיָּאָל (Yahuah)! Halal (Praise) אַיָּאָל (Yahuah) from the Shamyim (heavens); Halal (Praise) Him in the heights! Halal (Praise) Him, all His Malkym (angels); Halal (Praise) Him, all His hosts! Halal (Praise) Him, sun and moon; Halal (Praise) Him, all stars of light!

Psalm 148:7 Halal (Praise) אַיָּאָל (Yahuah) from the earth, Sea monsters and all deeps;

Psalm 148:13-14 Let them Halal (Praise) the name of אַיָּאָל (Yahuah), For His name alone is exalted; His esteem (glory) is above earth and Shamyim (heavens). And He has lifted up a horn for His people, Halal (Praise) for all His righteous ones; Even for the sons of Israel, a people near to Him. Halal (Praise) אַיָּאָל (Yahuah)!

Psalm 149:1 Halal (Praise) אַיָּאָל (Yahuah)! Sing to אַיָּאָל (Yahuah) a new song, And His Halal (Praise) in the congregation of the righteous ones.

Psalm 149:3 Let them Halal (Praise) His name with dancing; Let them sing praises to Him with timbrel and lyre.

Psalm 149:6 Let the high praises of אַיָּאָל (Yahuah) be in their mouth, And a two-edged sword in their hand,

Psalm 150:1-6 Halal (Praise) אַיָּאָל (Yahuah)! Halal (Praise) אַיָּאָל (Yahuah) in His sanctuary; Halal (Praise) Him in His mighty expanse. Halal (Praise) Him for His mighty deeds; Halal (Praise) Him according to His excellent greatness. Halal (Praise) Him with trumpet sound; Halal (Praise) Him with harp and lyre.

Isaiah 25:1 O אַיָּאָל (Yahuah), You are my Aluah (God); I will exalt You, I will Todah (give thanks) to Your name; For You have worked wonders, Plans formed long ago, with perfect faithfulness.

Isaiah 42:8 "I am אַיָּאָל (Yahuah)D, that is My name; I will not give My esteem (glory) to another, Nor My Halal (praise) to graven images.

Isaiah 42:10 Sing to אַיָּאָל (Yahuah) a new song, Sing His Halal (praise) from the end of the earth! You who go down to the sea, and all that is in it You islands, and those who dwell on them.

Isaiah 43:21 "The people whom I formed for Myself Will declare My Halal (praise).

Jeremiah 20:13 Sing to אַיָּאָל (Yahuah), Halal (praise) אַיָּאָל (Yahuah)! For He has delivered the soul of the needy one From the hand of evildoers.

Jeremiah 31:7 For this says אַיָּאָל (Yahuah), "Sing aloud with gladness for Jacob, And shout among the chief of the nations; Proclaim, give Halal (praise) and say, 'O אַיָּאָל (Yahuah), save Your people, The remnant of Yisrael.'

Joel 2:26 "You will have plenty to eat and be satisfied And Halal (praise) the name of אַיָּאָל (Yahuah) your Aluah (God), Who has dealt wondrously with you; Then My people will never be put to shame.

Acts 16:25-26 But about midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns of Halal (praise) to אַיָּאָל (Yahuah), and the prisoners were listening to them; and suddenly there came a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison house were shaken; and immediately all the doors were opened and everyone's chains were unfastened.

Hebrews 2:12 saying, "I WILL PROCLAIM YOUR NAME TO MY BRETHREN, IN THE MIDST

Revelation 19:5-6 And a voice came from the throne, saying, "Give Halal (praise) to our Aluah (God), all you His bond-servants, you who fear Him, the small and the great." Then I heard something like the voice of a great multitude and like the sound of many waters and like the sound of mighty peals of

thunder, saying, "HalaluYah! For יהוה (Yahuah) our Aluah (God), the Almighty, reigns.
