

Promises with Instructions

Activated Promises turn into Covenants and Covenants turn into Spiritual Laws.

I see the Scriptures (Tanakh and the Brit Hadashah) as instructions with Promises, guidelines and directions on how we are to live according to אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah)'s Will, which are instructions and Promises if we obey and follow (Barachah)'s or become cursed if we disobey and do not follow.

He has remembered his covenant forever, the word (Promiese) he Commanded for a thousand generations. 9 Which covenant he made with Abraham, and his oath unto (Yitshaq) Isaac; 10 And confirmed the same unto Ya'aqob (Jacob) for a law, and to Yisrael for an everlasting covenant. **Psalm 105:8-10**

He remembers his covenant forever, the word (promise) he made, for a thousand generations, 16 the covenant he made with Abraham, the oath he swore to (Yitshaq) Isaac. 17 He confirmed it to Ya'aqob (Jacob) as a decree, to Yisra'el as an everlasting covenant. **1 Chronicles 16:15-17**

Promise (Black) / Instruction (Red)

אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) himself goes before you and will be with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged.

Deuteronomy 31:8

Call upon me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you will honor me.
Psalm 50:15

Come near to אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) and he will come near to you." James 4:8

I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you and watch over you."9 Do not be like the horse or like the mule, Which have no understanding, Which must be harnessed with bit and bridle, Else they will not come near you. Psalm 32:8-9

"When OWYָּהוָה (Yahusha) spoke again to the people, he said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." John 8:12

If any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah), who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to him. James 1:5

Humble yourselves before אַיָּהּ (Yahuah), and he will lift you up. James 4:10

This is the confidence we have in approaching אַיָּהּ (Yahuah): that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. And if we know that he hears us-- whatever we ask-- we know that we have what we asked of him. John 5:14-15

In the day of my trouble I will call upon You: for You will answer me. Psalm 86:7

He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him and honor him. Psalm 91:15

Then they cried to אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) in their trouble, and He delivered them out of their distresses. Psalm 107:6

Ask and it shall be given you; seek and you shall find; knock and it shall be opened to you: For everyone that asks receives; and he that seeks finds; and to him that knocks it shall be opened. Matthew 7:7,8

Again I say to you, that if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of My Father which is in heaven. Matthew 18:19

And all things, whatsoever you shall ask in prayer, believing, you shall receive. Matthew 21:22

And whatsoever you shall ask in My Name (וַיָּהוּשָׁא (Yahusha), that will I do, that the Father (אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) may be glorified in the Son (וַיָּהוּשָׁא (Yahusha). If you shall ask any thing in My Name, I will do it. John 14:13,14

But without Amuanah (faith) it is impossible to please אַיָּהּ (Yahuah): for he that comes to אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him. Hebrews 11:6

And this is the confidence that we have in Him, that, if we ask any thing according to His will, He hears us: And if we know that He hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of Him. 1 John 5:14,15

And he believed in אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) and He accounted it to him for righteousness Genesis 15:6

Hear me, O אֲדָמָה (Yahudah) and you inhabitants of Yerushalayim (Jerusalem): **Believe in אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) your Aluahym, and you shall be established; believe His prophets, and you shall prosper.**" 2 Chronicles 20:20

אֲחִישָׁא (Yahusha) said to him, **"If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes."** Mark 9:23

For assuredly, I say to you, **whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says.** Mark 11:23

Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them. Mark 11:24

He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned. Mark 16:16

Keep His decrees and commands, which I am giving you today, so that it may go well with you and your children after you and that you may live long in the land **AYAZL (Yahuah)** your Aluahym gives you for all time. Deuteronomy 4:40

AYAZL (Yahuah) remembers us and will Barach (bless) us... he will Barach (bless) those who **fear AYAZL (Yahuah)** - small and great alike. May **AYAZL (Yahuah)** make you increase, both you and your children. May you be Baruch (blessed) by **AYAZL (Yahuah)**, the Maker of Shamyim (heavens) and earth. Psalm 115:12-15

He who fears AYAZL (Yahuah) has a secure fortress, and for his children it will be a refuge. Proverbs 14:26

He shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that brings forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatever he does shall prosper. Psalm 1:1,2,3

Baruch (Blessed) is the people that know the joyful sound: they shall walk, O Lord, in the light of Your countenance. In Your Name shall they rejoice all the day: and in Your righteousness shall they be exalted. For You are the glory of their strength: and in Your favor our horn shall be exalted. For אֲיָאֵל (Yahuah) is our defense; and the Kadosh (Holy) One (1) of Yisrael אֲיָאֵל (Yahuah) is our king. Psalm 89:15,16,17,18

Go your way, eat your bread with joy, and drink your wine with a merry heart; for אֲיָאֵל (Yahuah) now accepts your works. Ecclesiastes 9:7

Behold אֲיָאֵל (Yahuah)h is my salvation; I will trust, and not be afraid: for אֲיָאֵל (Yahuah) is my strength and my song; He also is become my salvation. Therefore with joy shall you draw water out of the wells of salvation. Isaiah 12:2,3

Let your gentleness be known to all men. אֲיָאֵל (Yahuah) is at hand. 6. Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with

thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to יָהוָה (Yahuah); 7. and the Shalum (Peace) of יָהוָה (Yahuah), which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through OYָהוּשָׁה (Yahusha) Philippians 4:5-7

These signs shall follow them that believe; in My Name they shall cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; they shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover. Mark 16:17,18

Verily, verily, I say to you, He that believes on Me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go to My Father. John 14:12

This is the assurance we have in approaching יָהוָה (Yahuah); that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us." 1 John 5:14

But I call to יָהוָה (Yahuah), and יָהוָה (Yahuah) saves me. Evening, Morning and Noon I cry out in distress, and he hears my voice. Psalm 55:16,17

And when you pray, do not be like the hypocrites, for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and on the street corners to be seen by men. I tell you the truth, they have received their reward in full. But when you pray, go into your room, close the door and pray to your Father who is unseen. Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you. Matthew 6:5,6

And when you pray, do not keep on babbling like pagans, for they think they will be heard because of their many words. Do not be like them, for your Father knows what you need before you ask him. Matthew 6:7,8

Let us then approach the throne of umerited favor (grace) with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find unmerited favor (grace) to help us in our time of need. Hebrews 4:16

But whoever listens to me will live in safety and be at ease, without fear of harm. Proverbs 1:33

Trust in יָהוָה (Yahuah) and do good; dwell in the land and enjoy safe pasture. Delight yourself in יָהוָה (Yahuah) and He will give you the desires of your heart. Psalm 37:3-4

Discretion will protect you, and **understanding** will guard you. **Wisdom** will save you from the ways of wicked men. Proverbs 2:11-12

And Abraham called the name of that place **יְרֵחַ (Yahuah)-Yireh**: as it is said to this day, “In the mount of **יְרֵחַ (Yahuah)** it shall be seen.” **יְרֵחַ (Yahuah)-Yireh** means **יְרֵחַ (Yahuah)** will provide. Genesis 22:14

Therefore you shall keep the commandments of יְרֵחַ (Yahuah) your Aluahym, to walk in His ways, and to fear Him. For **יְרֵחַ (Yahuah)** your Aluahym brings you into a good land, a land of brooks of water, of fountains and depths that spring out of valleys and hills; a land of wheat, and barley, and vines, and fig trees, and pomegranates; a land of olive oil, and honey; a land wherein you shall eat bread without scarceness, you shall not lack anything in it; a land whose stones are iron, and out of whose hills you may dig brass. When you have eaten and are full, then you shall brach (bless) **יְרֵחַ (Yahuah)** your Aluahym for the good land which He has given you. **Beware that you forget not יְרֵחַ (Yahuah) your Aluahym, in not keeping His Commandments, and His judgments, and His statutes, which I command you this day.** Deuteronomy 8:6-11

But you shall remember יְרֵחַ (Yahuah) your Aluahym: for it is He that gives you power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day. Genesis 22::18

And it shall come to pass, **if you shall listen diligently to the voice of יְרֵחַ (Yahuah) your Aluahym, to observe and to do all His Commandments** which I command you this day, that **יְרֵחַ (Yahuah) your Aluahym** will set you on high above all nations of the earth: and all these Barachah (Blessings) shall come on you, and overtake you. Deuteronomy 28:1,2

Baruch (Blessed) is the man..... his delight is in the Torah of יְרֵחַ (Yahuah); and in his law, he meditates day and night. And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that brings forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he does shall prosper. Psalm 1:1,2,3

Baruch (Blessed) is the man that fears יְרֵחַ (Yahuah), that delights greatly in His Commandments. His seed shall be mighty upon earth: the generation of the upright shall be Baruch (Blessed). Wealth and riches shall be in his house. Psalm 112:1,2,3

You bring all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in My house, and prove Me now, says **יְרֵחַ (Yahuah)** of Hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour out a Barachah (Blessing) to you, that there shall not be room enough to receive it. Malachai 3:10

Seek first (1st) the kingdom of יְרֵחַ (Yahuah), and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added to you. Matthew 6:33

Give, and it shall be given to you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give to you. For with the same measure that you measure, it shall be measured to you again. Luke 6:38

You will not *need* to fight in this battle. **Position yourselves, stand still and see the salvation of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah), who is with you, O אֲדָיָהּ (Yahudah) and Yerusalem! Do not fear or be dismayed; tomorrow go out against them, for אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) is with you.**” 2 Chronicles 20:17

So they said, **“Believe on Oוְיָהוּשָׁא (Yahusha) HaMashaich (the Messiah) and you will be saved, you and your household.”** Acts 16:31

that if you confess with your mouth Oוְיָהוּשָׁא (Yahusha) is Mashiach (Messiah) and believe in your heart that אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. Romans 10:9

For **“whoever calls on the name of Oוְיָהוּשָׁא (Yahusha) shall be saved.** Romans 10:13

But they that wait upon אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint. Isaiah 40:31

Have not I Comanded? **Be strong and of a good courage, be not afraid, neither be dismayed: for אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) your Aluahym is with you wherever you go.** Joshua 1:9

This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success. Joshua 1:8

“Trust in אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make your paths straight.” Proverbs 3: 5,6

Commit your way to אַיָּהּ (Yahuah), Trust also in Him, And He shall bring it to pass. Psalm 37:5

Trust in אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; ⁶ In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths. Proverbs 3:5-6

For I will surely deliver you, and you shall not fall by the sword; but your life shall be as a prize to you, because you have put your trust in Me,” says אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah). Jeremiah 39:18

אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) is good, A stronghold in the day of trouble; And He knows those who trust in Him. Nahum 1:7

Now it shall come to pass, if you diligently obey the voice of אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) your Aluahym, to observe carefully all His commandments which I command you today, that אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) your Aluahym will set you high above all nations of the earth. Deuteronomy 28:1

“And אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) will make you the head and not the tail; you shall be above only, and not be beneath, if you heed the Commandments of אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) your Aluahym, which I Command you today, and are careful to observe them and to do them.” Deuteronomy 28:13

Have not I Commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) your Aluahym is with you wherever you go. Joshua 1:9

Then Oוַיָּהוָה (Yahusha/Joshua) said to them, “Fear not, nor be dismayed; be strong and of good courage, for thus אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) will do to all your enemies against whom you fight. Joshua 10:24,25

When I cry unto You, then shall my enemies turn back: this I know; for אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) is for me. Psalm 56:9

But thanks be to אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah), who gives us the victory through our Mashiach (Messiah) Oוַיָּהוָה (Yahusha). Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah), knowing that your labor is not in vain in אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah). 1 Corinthians 15:57,58

For אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) gives wisdom; From His mouth come knowledge and understanding; ⁷ He stores up sound wisdom for the upright; He is a shield to those who walk uprightly; ⁸ He guards the paths of justice, And preserves the way of His Chosen. Proverbs 2:6-8

When pride comes, then comes shame; But with the humble is wisdom. Proverbs 11:2

If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah), who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him. James 1:5

For if we Sin willfully after we have received the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins, ²⁷ but a certain fearful expectation of judgment, and fiery indignation which will devour the

adversaries. ²⁸ **Anyone who has rejected Mosheh (Moses)'s law dies without mercy on the testimony of two (2) or three (3) witnesses.** ²⁹ Of how much worse punishment, do you suppose, will he be thought worthy who has trampled the Son of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) (Yahusha) underfoot, counted the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified a common thing, and insulted the Ruach (Spirit) of grace? ³⁰ For we know Him who said, "Vengeance is Mine, I will repay," says אַיָּהּ (Yahuah). And again, "אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) will judge His people. Hebrews 10:26

Baruch (Blessed) is the man that walks not in the counsel of the unrighteous, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of the scornful. But his delight is in the law of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah); and in His law does he meditate day and night. And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that brings forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he does shall prosper. The unrighteous are not so: but are like the chaff which the wind drives away. Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous. For אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) knows the way of the righteous: but the way of the unrighteous shall perish. Psalm 1:6

For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Ruach (Spirit), the things of the Ruach (Spirit). **For to be carnally minded is death: but to be spiritually minded is life and Shalum (Peace).** For if you live after the flesh, you shall die: but if you through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, you shall live. For as many as are led by the Ruach (Spirit) of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah), they are the sons of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah). Romans 8:5,6,13,14

Be not wise in your own eyes: fear אַיָּהּ (Yahuah), and depart from evil. It shall be health to your navel, and marrow to your bones. Honor אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) with your substance, and with the first fruits of all your increase: so shall your barns be filled with plenty, and your presses will burst out with new wine. Proverbs 3:7-10

Then you shall call, and אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) will answer; You shall cry, and He will say, 'Here I am.' If you take away the yoke from your midst, The pointing of the finger, and speaking wickedness, 10 If you extend your soul to the hungry And satisfy the afflicted soul, Then your light shall dawn in the darkness, And your darkness shall be as the noonday. 11 אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) will guide you continually, And satisfy your soul in drought, And strengthen your bones; you shall be like a watered garden, And like a spring of water, whose waters do not fail. Isaiah 58:9-11

He who made the Pleiades and Orion, who turns blackness into dawn and darkens day into night, who calls for the waters of the sea and pours them out over the face of the land- אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) is His Name- He flashes destruction on the stronghold and brings the fortified city to ruin. **Seek good, not evil,** that you may live. אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) Aluahym Almighty will be

with you, just as you say He is. **Hate evil, love good; maintain justice in the courts.** Perhaps אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) Aluahym Almighty will have mercy on the remnant of Yoseph. Amos 5:8,9,14,15

But whoso looks into the perfect law of liberty, and continues therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be baruch (blessed) in his deed. James 1:25

Beloved, if our heart condemn us not, then have we confidence toward אַיָּהּ (Yahuah). And whatsoever we ask, we receive of Him, because we keep His Commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in His sight. And this is His Commandment, "that we should believe on the name of His son OUYָּהּ (Yahusha), and love one another, as He gave us Commandment." 1 John 3:21-23

And this is the confidence that we have in Him, that, if we ask any thing according to His will, He hears us: and if we know that He hears us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of Him. 1 John 5:14,15

And he that overcomes, and keeps My works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of My Father. Revelation 2:26,28

He that overcomes, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before My Father, and before His malakym (angels). Revelation 3:5

For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Ruach (Spirit), the things of the Ruach (Spirit). For to be carnally minded is death: but to be spiritually minded is life and shalum (peace). Because the carnal mind is enmity against אַיָּהּ (Yahuah): for it is not subject to the Torah of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah), neither indeed can be. But your are not in the flesh, but in the Ruach (Spirit), if so be that the Ruach (Spirit) of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Ruach (Spirit) of OUYָּהּ (Yahusha), he is none of His. Romans 8:5-7,9

But this I say, "He which sows sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which sows bountifully shall reap also bountifully. Every man according as he purposes in his heart, so let him give: not grudgingly, or of necessity: for אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) loves a cheerful giver. And אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) is able to make all grace abound toward you; that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work." 2 Corinthians 9:6-8

Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister unmerited favor (grace) unto the hearers. Ephesians 4:29

And grieve not the Ruach Ha Kodesh of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah), whereby you are sealed unto the day of redemption. Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger,

and clamor, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice: and be you kind one to another, tender-hearted, forgiving one another, even as אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) for Oוַיָּאֵל (Yahusha)'s sake has forgiven you. Ephesians 4:30-32

Do all things without murmurings and disputings, that you may be blameless and harmless, the sons of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom you shine as lights in the world; holding forth the word of life. Philippians 2:14-16

Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah); 7 and the Shalum (Peace) of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Mashiach (Messiah) Oוַיָּאֵל (Yahusha). Philippians 4:6-7

pray that you may be active in sharing your Amunah (Faith), so that you will have a full understanding of every good thing we have in Oוַיָּאֵל (Yahusha). Philemon 6

For I know the thoughts that I think toward you", says אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), "thoughts of Shalum (Peace), and not of evil, to give you an expected end. Then shall you call upon Me, and you shall go and pray unto Me, and I will hearken unto you. And you shall seek Me, and find Me, when you shall search for Me with all your heart. Jeremiah 29:11-13

Baruch (Blessed) is the man that endures temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) has promised to them that love Him. James 1:12

Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), that He may exalt you in due time: casting all your care upon Him; for He cares for you. Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary Hasatan (the devil), as a roaring lion, walks about, seeking whom he may devour. 1 Peter 5:6-8

Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. And the world passes away, and the lust thereof: but he that does the will of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) abides forever. 1 John 2:15-17

For this is the Ahabah (love) of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), that we keep His Commandments: and His Commandments are not grievous. For whatsoever is born of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) overcomes the world: and this is the victory that overcomes the world, even our faith. 1 John 5:3,4

The hand of our Aluahym is upon all them for good that seek Him; but His power and His wrath is against all them that forsake Him. Ezra 8:22

OWYʼAʼL (Yahusha) answered and said unto him, **"If a man love Me, he will keep My words: and My Father will love him, and We will come unto him, and make our abode with him."** John 14:23

Therefore being justified by Amuanah (Faith), we have Shalum (Peace) with ʼYAʼL (Yahuah) through our Mashiach (Messiah) OWYʼAʼL (Yahusha). Romans 5:1

Know you not that you are the temple of ʼYAʼL (Yahuah), and that the Ruach (Spirit) of ʼYAʼL (Yahuah) dwells in you? **If any man defile the temple of ʼYAʼL (Yahuah), him shall ʼYAʼL (Yahuah) destroy; for the temple of ʼYAʼL (Yahuah) is Kadosh (Holy), which temple you are...** Know you not that your body is the temple of the Ruach ha Kodesh, which is in you, which you have of ʼYAʼL (Yahuah), and you are not your own? For you are bought with a price: therefore glorify ʼYAʼL (Yahuah) in your body, and in your ruach (spirit), which are ʼYAʼL (Yahuah)'s. 1 Corinthians 3:16,17; 6:19,20

If we confess our Sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our Sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we say that we have not Sinned, we make Him a liar, and His word is not in us. My little children, these things write I unto you, that you sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father ʼYAʼL (Yahuah), OWYʼAʼL (Yahusha) the righteous: and He is the propitiation for our Sins: and not for ours only, but also for the Sins of the whole world (those that believe). 1 John 1:9-2:2

Finally, brethren, **whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things. Those things, which you have both learned, and received, and heard, and seen in me, do: and the ʼYAʼL (Yahuah) of shalum (peace) shall be with you.** Philippians 4:8,9
