Do you Believe Scripture (The Bible) is True?

If so, why do you disregard what it says, the warning it gives and follow after those things which it tells us to avoid?

Every word of אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) proves True. **Proverbs 30:5**

For the word of אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) holds true, and we can trust everything he says. **Psalms 33:4**

Set the Apart them by the truth; your word is truth. **John 17:17**

So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; It shall not return to Me void, But it shall accomplish what I please, And it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it. **Isaiah 55:11**

Do you Believe Alahym (God) ever changes?

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) is not a man, that He should lie, Nor a son of man, that He should repent. Has He said, and will He not do? Or has He spoken, and will He not do as he has said? **Numbers 23:19**

In whose eyes a vile person is despised, But he honors those who fear אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), He *who* swears to his own hurt and “**Does Not Change**”! **Psalms 15:4**

Every good act of giving and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father who made the heavenly lights; with him there is neither Change nor darkness caused by Changing. **James 1:17**

Do you Believe Alahym (God) gave us his Name?

Hebrew Scripture has given us his Name as אֱלֹהִים 7000 times, which transliterates as Yahuah!

If so, why do we disregard his given name and say it does not matter what we call him? Why do you choose to call him The Lord (Baal) when he told us to not call him Baal (The Lord)? Man changed and removed his given Name over 7000 times from אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) to the Lord.

How long will this continue in the hearts of these lying prophets, who prophesy the delusions of their own minds? 27 They think the dreams they tell one another will make my people forget My Name, just as their ancestors forgot My Name through **Baal (The Lord/Jesus)** worship. **Jeremiah 23:26,27**

And in that day, declares אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), you will call me ‘My Husband,’ and no longer will you call me **Baal ‘The Lord.’** For I will remove the names of the **Baals** from her mouth, and they shall be remembered by name no more. **Hosea 2:16-17**

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) has explicitly spoken to us, by the above verses of Scripture, not to mention the name of the other mighty ones, even to the point that they not be heard coming out of our lips. So אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) would not be pleased if we called Him by the name of any other mighty one! So אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) would not be pleased if we called Him Baal in the bad sense.

But, how is it that we can call Him Baal (The Lord) in a good sense and be right, but yet use the same word, and it be in a wrong sense, causing **אֱלֹהִים**'s (Yahuah's) anger to burn against us? What is the answer to this apparent contradiction of **אֱלֹהִים**'s (Yahuah's) word?

There were many variations in which **BAAL** is known, such as the **Sun God (Sunday God)**, the **God** of fertility (**Easter**), and **Beelzebub**, or **the lord** of flies".

Baal is a Christian demon. According to Christian demonology, Baal was ranked as the first and principal king in Hell, ruling over the East. According to some authors Baal is a Duke, with (66) sixty-six legions of demons under his command. The term "Baal" is used in various ways in the Old Testament, with the usual meaning of Lord, Master, or Owner. It came to sometimes mean the local pagan god of a particular people, and at the same time all of the idols of the land. It is also found in several places in the plural Baalim, or Baals. **Judges 2:11, 10:10.**

Queen of Heaven (Moon & Sun goddess): Mother of God (and child), The Great Mother, Ashtaroth, Artemis, Aphrodite, Juno, Lilith, Minerva, Columbia, Nike, Astarte, Athena, Beltis, Diana, Isis (Horus), Anahita, Inanna, Tanat, Ishtar, Cybele, Mylitta, Hathor, Kali

Leviathan: Neptune, Poseidon, Tiamet, King of Children of Pride

Baal Zebubuwb or Beelzeboul

#1176 Baal Zebuwb, bah'al zeb-oob; from 1168 and 2070; Baal of (the) fly; Baal-zebub, a special deity of the Ekronites: Baal-Zebub. **A Name of Satan**

Remember when the Pharisees called **וְיָהוּשָׁע** (Yahusha) the Messiah Beelzebub (Mat. 10:25) and claimed that He cast out the demons by the prince of demons (**Mat. 12:24, 27; Mk. 3:22; Lk. 11:15, 18, 19**). Well, now go to Strong's Greek #954 and be ready for a shock!

#954 (Greek) Beelzeboul, beh-el-zeb-ool'; of Chald. Or. [by parody upon 1176]; dung-god; Beelzebub, **A Name of Satan:** Beelzebub.

Do you Believe אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), gave us the Name of his Messiah?

BEHOLD THE MAN WHOSE NAME IS THE BRANCH

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) predicted what His Son's name would be, so we have something we can look to for clarification. In the book of Zechariah, it states: Then the word of **אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah)** came to me, saying: "Take the silver and gold, make an elaborate crown, and set it on the head **וְיָהוּשָׁע (Yahusha)** the son of Yahutsadak (Jehozadak), the high priest. 12 "Then speak to him, saying, `Thus says **אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah)** of hosts, saying: "Behold, the Man whose name is the **BRANCH!** From His place He shall branch out, And He shall build the temple of **Yahuah**; 13 Yes, He shall build the temple of **אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah)**. He

shall bear the glory, And shall sit and rule on His throne; So He shall be a priest on His throne, And the counsel of peace shall be between them both." **Zechariah 6:11-13**

"The Branch" is a prophetic reference to the coming Messiah who would be a Priest and King (Compare **Psalms 110, Isaiah 9:6**).

So, Zechariah was instructed to take a crown and place it on the head of **Yahusha** (in the Hebrew is **וְיֵשׁוּעַ** (**Josua**) the son of **Yahutsadak**. **Yahutsadak** means: **יְהוּאֵל** (**Yahuah**) is righteous". When placing the crown on the head of **וְיֵשׁוּעַ** /**Joshua** the High Priest, Zechariah was told to proclaim: "Behold the man whose NAME is the BRANCH" This High Priest **וְיֵשׁוּעַ** /**Joshua** had the same name as the coming Messiah who would reign as a priest on His throne. He had the NAME of the Messiah, and **יְהוּאֵל** (**Yahuah**) predicted and revealed what the Messiah's name would be. So why not call Him by that name?

וְיֵשׁוּעַ /Joshua: "Take the silver and gold and make a crown, and set it on the head of the high priest, **וְיֵשׁוּעַ** (**Josua**) the son of **Yahutsadak** (**Jehozadak**). Tell him this is what **יְהוּאֵל** (**Yahuah**) Almighty says: "Here is the man whose name is the BRANCH, and he will branch out from his place and build the temple of **יְהוּאֵל** (**Yahuah**). It is he who will build the temple of **יְהוּאֵל** (**Yahuah**), and he will be clothed with majesty and will sit and rule on his throne. And he will be a priest on his throne."
Zechariah 6:11-13

Do you Believe The Name Jesus is the True Name of the Messiah?

There is not a single authoritative reference source which gives the name **Jesus** or **Iesous** as the original name given in the Tanakh (Old Testament) Scripture. The original form of the Name which was given throughout the Tanakh (Old Testament) translated as **Joshua** was the Name **וְיֵשׁוּעַ**, which transliterates as **Yahusha**.

The Name of **Jesus** that has been written through out the New Testament of the Bible is not a Translation or even a Transliteration of the Hebrew name **Yahusha** given **216** times in the Tanakh (Old Testament), this Name **Jesus** comes from the translation of the Aramaic name **Yeshua**, which came out the time of Babylonian captivity for the Hebrews, this Aramaic Name contains the Hebrew root word **YESHU**, which means: to blot his Name out or "May his name and memory be obliterated", This Name was then translated into Greek, which came out a Feminine Name **Iesoua**, **Iesoua**, which was then changed to **Iesous** to make it masculine, then translated into Latin under the Name **Iesus** (King James 1611 version), which was later changed again into the Name **Jesus** about 500 years ago when the letter "J" entered the English Language, which the Letter "J" did not exist in Ancient Hebrew and still does not exist in Hebrew today!

Our Heavenly Father did not leave us without witness' of this "grave" error. The Greek form of "**Jesus**" being **Iesous**, is pronounced "hey-soos" and can be found in the Hebrew writings! **Heysoos** is a legitimate Hebrew word! "**Jesus**" transliterated into Hebrew is "hey-soos", Hey" in Hebrew means "Look, Reveal or Breath", "Soos" in Hebrew means "Horse". (Strong's #5483) **Beast**

A **horse** is a false hope for Salvation; Nor does it deliver anyone by its great strength. **Psalms 33:17**

He delight's not in the strength of the horse (**Jesus**): he takes no pleasure in the legs (works) of a man. **Psalms 147:10**

The Latin Name "**Je-SUS**" pronounced **Gee-SOOCE** and this is from the Latin word/name "**Ie-SUS**" pronounced **Ee-SOOCE**. The suffix is the same as the latin word for "**PIG**". "**SUS**": A swine, hog, pig, boar, sow: (According to the dictionary this word SWINE can also mean a CONTEMPTIBLE Person a Beast)!

Do you Believe the Messiah is our Savior? Or אַיָּהּ (Yahuah)

They abandoned the Alahym (God) who made them and rejected the Rock their **Savior**. **Deuteronomy 32:15**

my Alahym (God) is my rock, in whom I take refuge, my shield and the horn of my Salvation. He is my stronghold, my refuge and my **Savior**. **2 Samuel 22:3**

“**אַיָּהּ (Yahuah)** lives! Praise be to my Rock! Exalted be my Alahym (God), the Rock, my **Savior**! **2 Samuel 22:47**

You have forgotten Alahym (God) your **Savior**. **Isaiah 17:10**

For I am **אַיָּהּ (Yahuah)** your God, the Kadosh (Holy) One of Israel, your **Savior**. **Isaiah 43:3**

to the only Alahym (God) our **Savior** be glory, majesty, power and authority. **Jude 1:25**

and my spirit rejoices in Alahym (God) my **Savior**. **Luke 1:47**

by the command of Alahym (God) our **Savior** and of **וַיָּהוּשָׁא (Yahusha)** our hope, **1 Timothy 1:1**

This is good, and pleases Alahym (God) our **Savior**. **1 Timothy 2:3**

and not to steal from them, but to show that they can be fully trusted, so that in every way they will make the teaching about Alahym (God) our **Savior** attractive. **Titus 2:10**

Do you Believe the Messiah, וַיָּהוּשָׁא (Yahusha) is אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) our Alahym (God)?

Has not the **one** Alahym (God) made you? You belong to him in body and spirit. And what does the **one** Alahym (God) seek? Godly offspring. **Malachi 2:15**

since there is only one Alahym (God), who will justify the circumcised by faith and the uncircumcised through that same faith. **Romans 3:30**

yet for us there is but one Alahym (God), the Father, from whom all things came and for whom we live; and there is but one Messiah, **וַיָּהוּשָׁא (Yahusha)**. **1 Corinthians 8:6**

one Alahym (God) and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all. **Ephesians 4:6**

For there is **one** Alahym (God) and one mediator between Alahym (God) and mankind, the man **וַיָּהוּשָׁא (Yahusha)**. **1 Timothy 2:5**

OWYAZL (Yahusha) said: If you loved me, you would be glad that I am going to the Father, for the **Father is greater** than I. **John 14:28**

Very truly I tell you, no servant is **greater** than his master, nor is a messenger **greater** than the one who sent him. **John 13:16**

OWYAZL (Yahusha) said, “When you have lifted up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am he and that **I do nothing** on my own, but speak just what the Father **AYAZL (Yahuah)** has taught me. **John 8:28**

Do you Believe Scripture declares that we are not to be found with another God's Name on our lips?

“Pay attention to all that I have said to you, and make no mention of the names of other gods, nor let it be heard on your lips. **Exodus 23:13**

Don't ever mention the names of other gods or swear an oath to them. Don't ever serve these gods or bow down to them. **Joshua 23:7**

Do you believe AYAZL (Yahuah) (GOD) gave Mankind His 10 Commandments?

Do you Believe they are Relevant today and that you are to obey them as they were originally written?

1. I am AYAZL (Yahuah) your Alahym, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery. You shall have no other gods besides me. The First Commandment is about Loyalty.

The first words from the Creator is “I am AYAZL (Yahuah) your Alahym.” This means that He is clearly telling you what His Name is and he is the Alahym (God). He is ready to deliver you out of misery (current and future misery) and deliver you out of the bondage of sin and asks us to demonstrate our love for Him by having no other God's.

The First Commandment is the first of a series of four that define our relationship with our Heavenly Father. Establishing, developing and maintaining that personal relationship with the true and living Alahym is the most important commitment we can ever make.

That is the primary focus of the first of the (10) Ten Commandments, *You shall have no other Alahym's (gods) before Me.* We should love, honor and respect Him so much that He alone is the supreme authority and model in our lives. He alone is AYAZL (Yahuah).

We should allow nothing to prevent us from serving and obeying Him. You have to repent of having other Alahym's (gods) before him. Examples of other Alahym's (gods) before your face are: Jehovah, Yahweh, The Lord (Baal), Jesus(Baal), Iesus, Allah, Buddah, Krishna, Money, Careers, People (including Husbands, Wives, Children, Mother, Father, Brother, Sister, Relatives, Friends, Employers, Co-Workers, etc.), Holidays that are of pagan origin (including Christmas, which is “Sun-god Worship,” and Easter, which is “Fertility goddess” worship, and any other thing which you put before AYAZL (Yahuah) the Creator and Alahym (God) is sin.

2. You shall not carve for yourself an image, the likeness of anything in the heavens above or the earth below, or in the waters under the earth. You shall not worship them or serve them, for I יְהוָה (Yahuah) your Alahym am a Jealous Alahym, inflicting the sins of the parents upon their children, upon the third and fourth generations of those who hate Me, but showing steadfast love to those who love me and keep my commandments.

The Second Commandments is about Worship. The one and only true Alahym (God) loves us so much that He is jealous of our love and does not want to share our love with any images, symbol representing our faith, including bowing down, kissing or acknowledging these meaningless idols. The Second Commandment goes to the heart of our relationship with our Creator. It deals with several crucial questions. How do we perceive יְהוָה (Yahuah)? How do we explain Him to ourselves and to others? Above all, what is the proper way to worship the only true Alahym (God)? The Second Commandment is a constant reminder that only we, of all created things, are made in the image of יְהוָה (Yahuah). Only we can be transformed into the spiritual image **וְיִשׁוּעָה (Yahusha)**, who came in the flesh as the perfect spiritual image of our heavenly Father. This Commandment protects our special relationship with our Creator, who made us in His likeness and is still molding us into his image.

3. You do not bring the Name of יְהוָה (Yahuah) Your Alahym to naught, for יְהוָה (Yahuah) does not leave the one unpunished who brings His Name to naught.

The Third Commandment is about Reverence. יְהוָה (Yahuah) asks us to respect His Kadosh (Holy) Name and not to use it in vain. The Hebrew name for “vain” is “shav” and means Vanity, Falsehood, Iniquity, Nothingness, Worthlessness and Emptiness. Simply summed up, “shav” means showing disrespect by replacing it with other Names, hiding the Name, so it is not known by his people. Saying it does not matter what Name we call him is taking his Most High, Set Apart Name in vain.

Now that you know Alahym's (God's) Name is יְהוָה (Yahuah), you must not treat it as meaningless and useless. It is through His Name that provides the gateway to come into His presence.

4. Remember the Sabbath day and keep it Kadosh (holy). Six days shall you labor and do all your work, but the seventh day is a Sabbath day of יְהוָה (Yahuah) your Alahym: you shall do no work - you, your son or daughter, your servants, your domestic animals, or the stranger in the community. For in six days יְהוָה (Yahuah) made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that is in them; then He rested on the seventh day. Therefore יְהוָה (Yahuah) blessed the Sabbath day and called it Kadosh (holy).

The Fourth Commandment is about Sanctification and Relationship. יְהוָה (Yahuah) starts off the fourth Commandment with the word “Remember”. This is because He knew we would forget it. יְהוָה (Yahuah) asks that we keep it set apart for Kadosh purposes, so we can draw nearer to Him. The Fourth Commandment to remember the Sabbath concludes the section of the (10) Ten Commandments that specifically helps define a proper relationship with יְהוָה (Yahuah), יְהוָה (Yahuah) worship and relate to Him. It explains why and when we need to take special time to draw closer to our Creator. It is also a special sign between us and יְהוָה (Yahuah). The Sabbath, the seventh day of the week was set apart by יְהוָה (Yahuah) as a time of rest and spiritual rejuvenation, it is very simple. Just rest, teach your family about and focus on יְהוָה (Yahuah) on the day that He has said is set-apart and you will be Baruch (blessed)! On our calendar the Sabbath day begins at sunset Friday evening and ends at sunset Saturday evening.

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah)'s 10 Commandments, and the (2) Two great Commandments spoken by **וְיָשָׁא** (Yahusha) our Messiah wraps up the 10 Commandments into (2) Two categories (see MatithYAHU-Matthew 22:37).

1. “You shall love אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) your Alahym with all your heart, and with all your mind, and with all your strength (resources).”

This Great Commandment is broken down within the first 4 of the 10 Commandments. If you learn to obey the first 4 Commandments, you will fulfill this commandment.

2. “You shall love your neighbor as yourself.”

This Great Commandment is broken down within the last 6 of the 10 Commandments. If you learn to obey the last 6 Commandments, you will fulfill this commandment.

אֱלֹהִים (YAHUAH) is well pleased for his righteousness' sake; he will magnify the Torah (Instruction/law), and make it honorable **Isaiah 42:21**

Scripture mentions obeying His Commandments 159 times, 128 times in the Tanakh (Old Testament) and 31 times in the B'riyt HaHhadashah (New Testament).

Messiah said: Do not think that I have come to abolish the Torah (Instruction/law) or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish (Do away) them but to fulfill them. **18** For truly I tell you, until **Heaven** and **Earth** disappear, so much as a yud or a stroke will pass from the Torah (Instruction/law) not until everything that must happen has happened. **19** So whoever disobeys the least of the Torah (Instruction/law) until everything is accomplished. **19** Therefore anyone who sets aside one of the least of these commandments and teaches others accordingly will be called least in the kingdom of heaven, but whoever practices and teaches these commandments will be called great in the kingdom of heaven. **20** For I tell you that unless your righteousness surpasses that of the Pharisees and the teachers of the Torah (Instruction/ law), you will certainly not enter the kingdom of heaven. **Matthew 5:17-19**

The Law of Moses is not the Same as the Commandments of **אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah)**, so even if you believe the Law is done away (abolished) with, the 10 Commandments never were mentioned, they were written in Stone and are forever, these are what **אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah)** will use to Judge us.

Do you Believe the Sabbath is relevant today or has been Changed to Sunday, the Lord's (Baal's) Day?

observe the **Sabbath**, celebrating it for the generations to come as a lasting covenant. **Exodus 31:16**

It is a day of **sabbath** rest, and you must deny yourselves; it is a lasting ordinance. **Leviticus 16:31**

Then they went home and prepared spices and perfumes. But they rested on the **Sabbath** in obedience to the commandment. **Luke 23:56**

For the law of Moses has been preached in every city from the earliest times and is read in the synagogues on every **Sabbath**.” **Acts 15:21**

[**A Sabbath**-Rest for the People of **אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah)**] Therefore, since the promise of entering his rest still stands, let us be careful that none of you be found to have fallen short of it. **Hebrews 4:1**

There remains, then, a **Sabbath**-rest for the people of **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah); **Hebrews 4:9**

Do you believe our Messiah is our Passover (Not Easter) Lamb and also our Sabbath?

Now on the first day of Unleavened Bread, when they killed the **Passover lamb**, His disciples said to Him, “Where do You want us to go and prepare, that You may eat the Passover?” **Mark 14:12**

Then came the Day of Unleavened Bread, when the Passover must be killed **Luke 22:7**

Matthew 26:2 states, “You know that after two days is the feast of the passover, and the Son of man is betrayed to be crucified

וְיֵשׁוּעַ (Yahusha) (The Messiah) our passover is sacrificed for us.” John the Baptist called **וְיֵשׁוּעַ (Yahusha)** “the Lamb of **Yahuah**, which takes away the sin of the world” (**John 1:29**).

Do you Believe Scripture declared that The Messiah (Yahusha) Rose “the 3rd Day? or 1 ½ days as from Good Friday until Resurrection Sunday?

For as Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of a huge fish, so the Son of Man will be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth. **Matthew 12:40-41**

John 2:19-21 states, “ **וְיֵשׁוּעַ (Yahusha)** answered and said unto them, Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up...But He spoke of the temple of His body.” Clearly, the use of the phrase “in three days” means that **וְיֵשׁוּעַ (Yahusha)**’s time in the tomb could not exceed 72 hours three-days and 3 nights period.

and will hand him over to the Gentiles to be mocked and flogged and crucified. On the **third day** he will be raised to life!” **Matthew 20:19**

He told them, “This is what is written: The Messiah will suffer and rise from the dead on the **third day**. **Luke 24:46**

According to Scripture He was Crucified on the Passover (Wednesday), placed in the tomb before sundown and Rose exactly 3 Days later on the Sabbath (Saturday) before Sundown, exactly 3 Days and 3 Nights just as Scripture declared!

Which Was the Day of the Resurrection?

Do you Believe the Messiah’s Resurrection was on Sunday? What does Scripture say about this? Is this

a Tradition of Man (Roman Catholic Church/Christianity)?

John 20:1 says, “The first day of the week (Sunday) comes Mary Magdalene early, when it was yet dark, unto the sepulchre, and sees the stone taken away from the sepulchre.” Compare this verse with **Mark 16:2** and **Luke 24:1**.

It is now very early Sunday morning (it is still dark) and the tomb is open. Do these verses supply the supposed proof for the Sunday resurrection tradition? Do they support “Easter sunrise services”? A problem already presents itself. **OWYAZL (Yahusha)** is gone from the tomb before sunrise!

Now notice **Luke 24:6**. Mary Magdalene, and the others with her, are described as finding two angels standing before them. These angels stated plainly to these women, “He is not here, but is **Risen**.” Also see **Mark 16:6** and **Matthew 28:5-6**.

Since the Messiah is our Sabbath Rest, does it not make more sense that eh would Rise on the Sabbath as the Master of the Sabbath as Scripture declares?

Do you honor and observe the Feats Days (The Set Apart Days) of אַיָּאָל (YAHUAH) as Commanded to observe them FOREVER? Of do you Observe Man's Traditions?

Speak unto the children of Yisrael (Israel), and say unto them, Concerning the feasts of אַיָּאָל (Yahuah), which you shall proclaim to be (Kadosh) holy convocations, even these are my feasts. **Leviticus 23:2**

These are the feasts of אַיָּאָל (Yahuah), even Kadosh (holy) convocations, which you shall proclaim in their seasons. **Leviticus 23:4**

And to offer all burnt sacrifices unto אַיָּאָל (Yahuah) in the Sabbaths, in the new moons, and on the set feasts, by number, according to the order commanded unto them, continually before אַיָּאָל (Yahuah). **1 Chronicles 23:31**

Behold upon the mountains the feet of him that bringeth good tidings, that publisheth peace! O Yahudah (Judah), keep thy solemn feasts, perform thy vows: for the Lawless (Wicked) shall no more pass through thee; he is utterly cut off. **Nahum 1:15**

You have let go of the commandments of אַיָּאָל (Yahuah) and are holding on to human Traditions (Christmas, Good Friday, Easter).” **Mark 7:8**

And he continued, “You have a fine way of setting aside the commandments of אַיָּאָל (Yahuah) in order to observe your own Traditions (Christmas, Good Friday, Easter)! **Mark 7:9**

Do you Believe your Name must be written in the Lambs Book of Life and Have the Name of the Father and Son written upon you?

Then I looked, and there before me was the Lamb, standing on Mount Zion, and with him 144,000 who had his name **וַיְהוֹשָׁע** (Yahusha) and his Father's name **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) written on their foreheads.

Revelation 14:1

And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before **יְהוָה** (Yahuah); and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the **book of life**: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books (Torah = Instructions/Law), according to their works. **Revelation**

20:12

See that you do all I command (Commandments and Sabbaths) you; do not add to it or take away from it. **Deuteronomy 12:32**

If any man shall take away from the words (Names) of the book of this prophecy, **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city (Heaven), and from the things which are written in this book. **Revelation 22:19**

After reading these questions, have your beliefs changed? Follow Scripture and not Man. Now you know the truth of Scripture, you are now responsible!
