The Coming of the Kingdom

As he sat on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to him privately, saying, "Tell us, when will these things be, and what will be the sign of your coming and of the end of the age?" 4 And Yahusha answered them, "See that no one leads you astray. 5 For many will come in my name, saying, 'I am the Messiah (Christ),' and they will lead many astray. 6 And you will hear of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not alarmed, for this must take place, but the end is not yet. 7 For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom, and there will be famines and earthquakes in various places. 8 All these are but the beginning of the birth pains. 9 "Then they will deliver you up to tribulation and put you to death, and you will be hated by all nations for my name's sake. 10 And then many will fall away and betray one another and hate one another. 11 And many false prophets will arise and lead many astray. 12 And because lawlessness will be increased, the love of many will grow cold. Matthew 24:3-12

Daniel 12:1-13 "At that time shall arise Michael, the great prince who has charge of your people. And there shall be a time of trouble, such as never has been since there was a nation till that time. But at that time your people shall be delivered, everyone whose name shall be found written in the book. And many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt. And those who are wise shall shine like the brightness of the sky above; and those who turn many to righteousness, like the stars forever and ever. But you, Daniel, shut up the words and seal the book, until the time of the end. Many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall increase."

Matthew 24:21-22 For then there will be great tribulation, such as has not been from the beginning of the world until now, no, and never will be. And if those days had not been cut short, <u>no</u> human being would be saved. <u>But</u> for the sake of the <u>chosen</u> (**elect**) those days will be cut short.

Titus 2:13 Waiting for our blessed hope, the appearing of the glory of our great Alahym and Savior Yahusha Ha Mashiach,

Hebrews 9:28 Mashiach (Messiah), having been offered once to **bear the sins** of <u>many</u>, will appear a second (2nd) time, not to deal with **Sin** <u>but</u> to **Save** <u>those who are eagerly waiting for him</u>.

Colossians 3:4 When Masiach (Messiah) **who is your life** appears, then **you** also <u>will appear with him</u> in **glory**.

Mark 13:5-23 And Yahusha began to say to them, "See that no one leads you astray. Many will come in my name, saying, 'I am he!' and they will lead many astray. And when you hear of wars and rumors of wars, do not be alarmed. This must take place, but the end is not yet. For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. There will be earthquakes in various places; there will be famines. These are but the beginning of the birth pains. "But be on your guard. For they will deliver you over to councils, and you will be beaten in synagogues, and you will stand before governors and kings for my sake, to bear witness before them.

Mark 13:32 "But concerning that day or that hour, no one knows, not even the Malakym (angels) in Shamym (Heavens), <u>nor</u> the Son, but <u>only</u> the Father.

Matthew 24:24-28 For false messiahs (christs) and false prophets will arise and perform great signs and wonders, so as to lead astray, if possible, even the **chosen** (**elect**). 25 See, I have told you beforehand. 26 So, if they say to you, 'Look, he is in the wilderness,' do not go out. If they say, 'Look, he is in the inner rooms,' do not believe it. 27 For as the lightning comes from the east and shines as far as the west, so will be the coming of the **Son** of Man. 28 Wherever the corpse is, there the vultures will gather. 29 "Immediately after the tribulation of those days the **sun** will be darkened, and the **moon** will not give its **light**, and the **stars** will fall from Shamym (Heaven), and the powers of the Shamym (Heavens) will be shaken. 30 Then will appear in Shamym (Heaven) the sign of the Son of Man, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of Shamym (Heavens) with Power and great Glory. 31 And he will send out his Malakym (Angels) with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather his **chose**n (**elect**) from the four winds, from one end of Shamym (Heavens) to the other.

Matthew 24:34-50 Truly, I say to you, this generation will not pass away until all these things take place. 35 Shamym (Heavens) and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away. 36 "But concerning that day and hour no one knows, not even the Malakym (Angels) of Shamym (Heaven), nor the Son, but the **Father** only. 37 For as were the days of Noah, so will be the coming of the **Son of Man**. 38 For <u>as in</u> those days before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the **day** when Noah entered the ark, 39 and they were <u>unaware</u> until the flood came and <u>swept (taken)</u> them all away, <u>so will be</u> the coming of the **Son of Man**. 40 Then two (2) men will be in the field; one (1) will be taken and one (1) left. 41 Two (2) women will be grinding at the mill; one (1) will be taken and one (1) left. 42 Therefore, stay awake, for you do not know on what day your Adonai (Master) is coming. 43 But know this, that if the master of the house had known in what part of the night the thief was coming, he would have stayed awake and would not have let his house be broken into. 44 Therefore you also must be <u>ready</u>, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect. 45 "Who then is the faithful and wise servant, whom his master has set over his household, to give them their food at the proper time? 46 Baruck (Blessed) is that servant whom his master will find doing so when he comes. 47 Truly, I say to you, he will set him over all his possessions. 48 But if that wicked servant says to himself, 'My master is **delayed**,' 49 and begins to beat his fellow servants and eats and drinks with drunkards, 50 the master of that servant will come on a **day** when he does not expect him and at an **hou**r he does not know 51 and will cut him in pieces and put him with the **hypocrites**. In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Luke 21:34-36 "But <u>watch yourselves</u> lest your hearts be <u>weighed down</u> (<u>Burdened</u>) with **dissipation** (the act of breaking up and scattering or spreading widely or wasteful or thoughtless spending or activity) and **drunkenness** and **cares of this life**, and <u>that</u> **day** come upon you suddenly like a trap. For <u>it will come upon</u> **all** who dwell on the face of the whole earth. But **stay awake at all times**, **praying** <u>that</u> you may have <u>strength</u> to <u>escape all these things</u> that <u>are going</u> to take place, and to <u>stand</u> <u>before</u> the **Son of Man**."

2 Thessalonians 2:5-10 Do you not remember that when I was still with you I told you these things? 6 And you know what is restraining him now so that he may be revealed in his time. 7 For the mystery of lawlessness is

already at work. Only he who now restrains it will do so until he is out of the way. 8 And then the lawless one will be revealed, whom the Adon Yahusha will kill with the breath of his mouth and bring to nothing by the appearance of his coming. 9 The coming of the lawless one is by the activity of HaSatan with all power and false signs and wonders, 10 and with all wicked deception for those who are perishing, because they refused to love the truth (Torah) and so be saved.

Matthew 22:1-13 And again Yahusha spoke to them in parables, saying, 2 "The Kingdom of Shamym (Heavens) may be compared to a king who gave a wedding feast for his son, 3 and sent his servants to call those who were invited to the wedding feast, but they would not come. 4 Again he sent other servants, saying, 'Tell those who are invited, "See, I have prepared my dinner, my oxen and my fat calves have been slaughtered, and everything is ready. Come to the wedding feast." 5 But they paid no attention and went off, one to his farm, another to his business, 6 while the rest seized his servants, treated them shamefully, and killed them. 7 The king was angry, and he sent his troops and destroyed those murderers and burned their city. 8 Then he said to his servants, 'The wedding feast is ready, but those invited were not worthy. 9 Go therefore to the main roads and invite to the wedding feast as many as you find.' 10 And those servants went out into the roads and gathered all whom they found, both bad and good. So the wedding hall was filled with guests. 11 "But when the king came in to look at the guests, he saw there a man who had no wedding garment. 12 And he said to him, 'Friend, how did you get in here without a wedding garment?' And he was speechless. 13 Then the king said to the attendants, 'Bind him hand and foot and **cast (take)** him into **the outer darkness**. In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.'

Matthew 25:1 "Then the Kingdom of Shamym (Heavens) will be like ten (10) virgins who took their lamps and went to meet the bridegroom. 2 Five (5) of them were foolish, and five (5) were wise. 3 For when the foolish took their lamps, they took no oil with them (Complacency), 4 but the wise took flasks of oil with their lamps. 5 As the bridegroom was delayed, they all became drowsy and slept. 6 But at midnight there was a cry, 'Here is the bridegroom! Come out to meet him.' 7 Then all those virgins rose and trimmed their lamps. 8 And the foolish said to the wise, 'Give us some of your oil, for our lamps are going out.' 9 But the wise answered, saying, 'Since there will not be enough for us and for you, go rather to the dealers

and buy for yourselves.' 10 And while they were going to buy, the bridegroom came, and those who were ready went in with him to the Marriage Feast, and the Door was Shut. 11 Afterward the other virgins came also, saying, 'Adon (Master/Lord), Adon (Master/Lord), open to us.' 12 But he answered, 'Truly, I say to you, I do not know you.

- 1 Thessalonians 4:16-18 For Yahusha himself will descend from Shamym (Heavens) with a Cry of Command, with the Voice of an archangel, and with the Sound of the trumpet of Alahym. And the dead in Mashiach (Messiah) will rise first (1st). Then we who are alive, who are left, will be caught up (seized, snatched away) at once a cloud meeting Adon (the Master/Lord) in breath (respire, air), and thus (in this way) we will always be with Adon (the Master/Lord). Therefore encourage one another with these words.
- 1 Corinthians 15:50-55 I tell you this, brothers: flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of Alahym, nor does the perishable inherit the imperishable. 51 Behold! I tell you a mystery. We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, 52 in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we shall be changed. 53 For this perishable body must put on the imperishable, and this mortal body must put on immortality. 54 When the perishable puts on the imperishable, and the mortal puts on immortality, then shall come to pass the saying that is written: "Death is swallowed up in victory." 55 "O death, where is your victory? O death, where is your sting?

Matthew 7:21-23 "Not everyone who says to me, 'Adon (Master/Lord), Adon (Master/Lord),' will enter the kingdom of Shamym (Heavens), but the one who does the will of my Father who is in Shamym (Heavens). 22 On that day many will say to me, 'Adon (Master/Lord), Adon (Master/Lord), did we not prophesy in your name, and cast out demons in your name, and do many mighty works in your name?' 23 And then will I declare to them, 'I never knew you; Depart from me, you workers of Turahlessness (lawlessness).'

Matthew 25:31-46 "When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the Malakym (angels) with him, then he will sit on his glorious throne. 32 Before him will be gathered all the nations, and he will separate people one (1) from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats. 33 And

he will place the **sheep** on his **right**, but the goats on the left. 34 Then the King will say to those on his **right**, 'Come, you who are Baruck (Blessed) by my **Father**, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world. 35 For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me, 36 I was naked and you clothed me, I was sick and you visited me, I was in prison and you came to me.' 37 Then the righteous will answer him, saying, 'Adon (Master/Lord), when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you drink? 38 And when did we see you as a stranger and welcome you, or naked and clothe you? 39 And when did we see you sick or in prison and visit you?' 40 And the King will answer them, 'Truly, I say to you, as you did it to one of the <u>least</u> of these <u>my brothers</u>, you did it to me.' 41 "Then he will say to those on his left, 'Depart from me, you cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for HaSatan (the Devil) and his malakym (angels). 42 For I was hungry and you gave me no food, I was thirsty and you gave me no drink, 43 I was a stranger and you did not welcome me, naked and you did not clothe me, sick and in prison and you did not visit me.' 44 Then they also will answer, saying, 'Adonai (Master/Lord), when did we see you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison, and did not minister to you?' 45 Then he will answer them, saying, 'Truly, I say to you, as you did not do it to one of the <u>least</u> of these, you did not do it to me.' 46 And these will **be taken away** into eternal punishment (2nd Death), but the Righteous into eternal life."

Matthew 5:5 Baruck (Blessed) are the meek (mild, gentle), for they will inherit the earth.

Psalm 37:11 But the meek (poor, afflicted, humble) shall <u>inherit the earth</u>, And shall delight themselves in the abundance of Shalum (peace).

Revelation 5:9-10 And they sang a new song, saying: 'You are worthy to take the scroll, And to open its seals; For You were slain, And have redeemed us to Yahuah by Your blood Out of <u>every tribe</u> and <u>tongue</u> and <u>people</u> and <u>nation</u>, And have made us **kings** and **priests** to <u>our Alahym</u>; And <u>we shall reign on the earth</u>.'

Revelation 11:15-19 The seventh Malak (angel) sounded his trumpet, and there were loud voices in Shamym (Heaven), which said: "The kingdom of

the world has become the Kingdom of our Alahym and of his Mashiach, and he will reign for ever and ever."

Psalm 2:6-8 "Yet I have set My King On My Qadosh (Holy) hill of Zion." "I will declare the decree: Yahuah has said to Me, 'You are My Son, Today I have begotten You. Ask of Me, and I will give You The <u>nations</u> for Your inheritance, And the <u>ends of the earth</u> for **Your possession**.

Zechariah 14:9-11 And Yahuah shall be **King over all the earth**. In that day it shall be—" Yahuah is echad (one)," And His Name echad (one).

Isaiah 2:2 Now it shall come to pass in the latter days That the mountain of Yahuah's house Shall be established on the top of the mountains, And shall be exalted above the hills; And all nations shall flow to it.

Zechariah 14:16-19 And it shall come to pass that everyone who is left of all the nations which came against Yarusalym (Jerusalem) shall go up from year to year to worship the King, Yahuah of hosts, and to keep the Feast of Tabernacles. And it shall be that whichever of the families of the earth do not come up to Jerusalem to worship the King, Yahuah of hosts, on them there will be no rain. If the family of Mitsrym (Egypt) will not come up and enter in, they shall have no rain; they shall receive the plague with which Yahuah strikes the nations who do not come up to keep the Feast of Tabernacles. This shall be the punishment of Mytsrym (Egypt) and the punishment of all the nations that do not come up to keep Sukkot (the Feast of Tabernacles).

- **2 Peter 3:3-4** Knowing this first (1st) of all, that <u>scoffers will come</u> in the <u>last days with scoffing</u>, following their own <u>sinful desires</u>. They will say, "**Where is the promise of his coming**? For ever since the fathers fell asleep, all things are continuing as they were from the beginning of creation."
- **1 Timothy 4:1** Now the Ruach (Spirit) expressly says that in later times some will <u>depart</u> from the faith by devoting themselves to deceitful spirits and teachings of demons,
- **2 Corinthians 11:13-15** For such men are false apostles, deceitful workmen, disguising themselves as apostles of Messiah. And no wonder, for even HaSatan disguises himself as an Malak (angel) of light. So it is no

surprise if his servants, also, disguise themselves as servants of righteousness. Their end will correspond to their deeds.

- **2 Timothy 3:1-5** But understand this, that in the last days there will come times of difficulty. For people will be lovers of self, lovers of money, proud, arrogant, abusive, disobedient to their parents, ungrateful, unholy, heartless, unappeasable, slanderous, without self-control, brutal, not loving good, treacherous, reckless, swollen with conceit, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of Alahym, having the appearance of godliness, but denying its power. Avoid such people.
- **Luke 21:36** But **stay awake at all times**, <u>praying</u> that you <u>may have</u> **strength to escape** <u>all these things that are going to take place</u>, and to stand before the Son of Man."
- **Luke 21:11** There will be great earthquakes, and in various places famines and pestilences. And there will be terrors and great signs from Shamym (Heavens).
- **1 John 2:18** Children, it is the last hour, and as you have heard that antiMessiah is coming, so now many antiMessiahs have come. Therefore we know that it is the last hour.
- Joel 2:28-32 "And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my Ruach (Spirit) on all flesh; your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, and your young men shall see visions. Even on the male and female servants in those days I will pour out my Ruach (Spirit). "And I will show wonders in the Shamym (Heavens) and on the earth, blood and fire and columns of smoke. The sun shall be turned to darkness, and the moon to blood, before the great and awesome day of Yahuah comes. And it shall come to pass that everyone who calls on the name of Yahuah shall be saved. For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there shall be those who escape, as Yahuah has said, and among the survivors shall be those whom Yahuah calls.

Proverbs 1:32 For the simple are killed by their turning away, and the complacency of fools destroys them;

Proverbs 13:4 The soul of the sluggard craves and gets nothing, while the soul of the diligent is richly supplied.

Zephaniah 1:12 At that time I will search Yarusalym with lamps, and I will punish the men who are complacent, those who say in their hearts, 'Yahuah will not do good, nor will he do ill.'

2 Kings 19:28 Because you have raged against me and your complacency has come into my ears, I will put my hook in your nose and my bit in your mouth, and I will turn you back on the way by which you came.

TO THE ASSEMBLIES

Revelation 2:2-7 "I know your works, your toil and your patient endurance, and how you cannot bear with those who are evil, but have tested those who call themselves apostles and are not, and found them to be false. **3** I know you are enduring patiently and bearing up for my name's sake, and you have not grown weary. **4** But I have this against you, that you have abandoned the love you had at first. **5** Remember therefore from where you have fallen; repent, and do the works you did at first (1st). If not, I will come to you and remove your lampstand from its place, unless you repent. **6** Yet this you have: you hate the works of the Nicolaitans (Seduced Yasharal into eating meat offered to idols and into acts of fornication) which I also hate. **7** He who has an ear, let him hear what the Ruach (Spirit) says to the Assemblies. To the one (1) who conquers I will grant to eat of the tree of life, which is in the paradise of Alahym.'

Revelation 2:9-11 "I know your **tribulation** and your **poverty** (but you are rich) and the slander of those who say that they are Hebrews and are not, but are a synagogue of HaSatan. **10** Do not fear what you are about to suffer. Behold, HaSatan (the devil) is about to throw some of you into prison, that you may be tested, and for ten (10) days you will have **tribulation**. Be faithful unto death, and I will give you the crown of life. **11** He who has an ear, let him hear what the Ruach (Spirit) says to the Assemblies. The one (1) who conquers will not be hurt by the second (2nd) death.'

Revelation 2:16-17 Therefore repent. If not, I will come to you soon and war against them with the sword of my mouth. **17** He who has an ear, let him hear what the Ruach (Spirit) says to the Assemblies. To the one (1) who

<u>conquers</u>, I will give some of the hidden manna, and I will give him a white stone, with a new name written on the stone that no one knows except the one (1) who receives it.'

Revelation 2:19-29 "I know your works, your love and Amunah (faith) and service and patient endurance, and that your latter works exceed the first. **20** But I have this against you, that you tolerate that woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess and is teaching and seducing my servants to practice sexual immorality and to eat food sacrificed to idols. 21 I gave her time to repent, but she refuses to repent of her sexual immorality. 22 Behold, I will throw her onto a sickbed, and those who commit adultery with her I will throw into great tribulation, unless they repent of her works, 23 and I will strike her children dead. And all the Assemblies will know that I am he who searches **mind** and **heart**, and I will give to each of you according to your works. **24** But to the rest of you in Thyatira, who do not hold this teaching, who have not learned what some call the deep things of HaSatan, to you I say, I do not lay on you any other burden. 25 Only hold fast what you have until I come. **26** The one (1) who conquers and who keeps my works until the end, to him I will give authority over the nations, **27** and he will rule them with a rod of iron, as when earthen pots are broken in pieces, even as I myself have received authority from my Father. 28 And I will give him the morning star. **29** He who has an ear, let him hear what the Ruach (Spirit) says to the Assemblies.'

Revelation 3:1-6 "I know your works. You have the reputation of being alive, but you are dead. 2 Wake up, and strengthen what remains and is about to die, for I have not found your works complete in the sight of my Alahym. 3 Remember, then, what you received and heard. Keep it, and repent. If you will not wake up, I will come like a thief, and you will not know at what hour I will come against you. 4 Yet you have still a few names in Sardis, people who have not soiled their garments, and they will walk with me in white, for they are worthy. 5 The one (1) who conquers will be clothed thus in white garments, and I will never blot his name out of the book of life. I will confess his name before my Father and before his Malakym (Angels). 6 He who has an ear, let him hear what the Ruach (Spirit) says to the Assemblies.'

Revelation 3:8-13 The words of the Qadosh (Holy) one (1), the true one (1), who has the key of David, who opens and no one will shut, who shuts and no one opens. "I **know your works**. Behold, I have set before you an

open door, which no one is able to shut. I know that you have but little power, and yet you have kept my word and have not denied my name. 9 Behold, I will make those of the synagogue of HaSatan who say that they are Hebrews and are not, but lie—behold, I will make them come and bow down before your feet, and they will learn that I have loved you. 10 Because you have kept my word about patient endurance, I will keep you from the hour of trial that is coming on the whole world, to try those who dwell on the earth. 11 I am coming soon. Hold fast what you have, so that no one may seize your crown. 12 The one who conquers, I will make him a pillar in the temple of my Alahym. Never shall he go out of it, and I will write on him the name of my Alahym, and the name of the city of my Alahym, the new Yarusalym, which comes down from my Alahym out of Shamym (Heavens), and my own new name. 13 He who has an ear, let him hear what the Ruach (Spirit) says to the Assemblies.'

Revelation 3:15-22 "I know your works: you are neither cold nor hot. Would that you were either cold or hot! **16** So, because you are lukewarm, and neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of my mouth. **17** For you say, I am rich, I have prospered, and I need nothing, not realizing that you are wretched, pitiable, poor, blind, and naked. **18** I counsel you to buy from me gold refined by fire, so that you may be rich, and white garments so that you may clothe yourself and the shame of your nakedness may not be seen, and salve to anoint your eyes, so that you may see. **19** Those whom I love, I reprove and discipline, so be zealous and repent. **20** Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and eat with him, and he with me. **21 The one who conquers, I** will grant him to sit with me on my throne, as I also conquered and sat down with my Father on his throne. **22** He who has an ear, let him hear what the Ruach (Spirit) says to the Assemblies."

Revelation 20:4-5 And I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was committed to them. Then I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for their witness to Yahusha and for the word of Yahuah, who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received his mark on their foreheads or on their hands. And they <u>lived and reigned</u> with **Mashiach** for a thousand years. But the rest of the dead <u>did not live again</u> until <u>the thousand years were finished</u>. This is the first resurrection.

Revelation 21:1-3 Now I saw a new Shamym (Heavens) and a new earth, for the first Shamym (Heavens) and the first earth had passed away. Also there was no more sea. Then I, Yahukannon (John), saw the Qadosh (holy) city, New Yarusalym (Jerusalem), coming down out of Shamym (Heaven) from Yahuah, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. And I heard a loud voice from Shamym (Heaven) saying, 'Behold, the tabernacle of Alahym

is with men, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people. Yahuah Himself will be with them and be their Alahym.

John 14:1-3 "Let not your hearts be troubled. Believe in Yahuah; believe also in me. In my Father's house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, **I will come again** and will **take you to myself**, that where I am you may be also.

Acts 17:30-31 The times of ignorance Yahuah overlooked, but now he commands all people everywhere to repent, because he has fixed **a day** on which he will judge the world in righteousness by a man whom he has appointed; and of this he has given assurance to all by raising him from the dead."
