

יְהוָה (Yahuah) Aluah (God)

For who is Aluah (God), but יְהוָה (Yahuah)? And who is a Rock, except Aluhênū (our God)? **Psalm 18:31**

Tremble, O earth, at the presence of יְהוָה (Yahuah), at the presence of Aluah (The God) of Yaaqob (Jacob), **Psalm 114:7**

Genesis 2:4 These are the generations of the Shamyim (Heavens) and of the earth when they were created, in the day that יְהוָה (Yahuah) Aluahym (God) made the Earth and the Shamyim (Heavens), 5 And every plant of the field before it was in the Earth, and every herb of the field before it grew: for יְהוָה (Yahuah) Aluahym (God) had not caused it to rain upon the earth, and there was not a man to till the ground.

Genesis 2:7 And יְהוָה (Yahuah) Aluahym (God) formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul. 8 And יְהוָה (Yahuah) Aluahym (God) planted a Garden Eastward in Eden; and there he put the man whom he had formed. 9 And out of the ground made יְהוָה (Yahuah) Aluahym (God) to grow every tree that is pleasant to the sight, and good for food; the tree of life also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of knowledge of good and evil.

Genesis 2:15 And יְהוָה (Yahuah) Aluahym (God) took the man, and put him into the garden of Eden to dress it and to keep it. 16 And יְהוָה (Yahuah) Aluahym (God) Commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the Garden You may freely eat:

Genesis 2:18 And יְהוָה (Yahuah) Aluahym (God) said, It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make for him a help meet. 19 And out of the ground יְהוָה (Yahuah) Aluahym (God) formed every beast of the field, and every fowl of the air; and brought them unto Adam to see what he would call them: and whatsoever Adam called every living creature, that was the name thereof.

Genesis 2:21 And יְהוָה (Yahuah) Aluahym (God) caused a deep sleep to fall upon Adam, and he slept: and he took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh instead thereof; 22 And the rib, which יְהוָה (Yahuah) Aluahym (God) had taken from man, he made a woman, and brought her unto the man.

Genesis 3:1 Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which יְהוָה (Yahuah) Aluahym (God) had made. And he said unto the woman, has Aluahym (God) said, You shall not eat of every tree of the Garden?

Genesis 3:8 And they heard the voice of יְהוָה (Yahuah) Aluahym (God) walking in the Garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of יְהוָה (Yahuah) Aluahym (God) amongst the trees of the Garden. 9 And יְהוָה (Yahuah) Aluahym (God) called unto Adam, and said unto him, Where are you?

Genesis 3:13 And יְהוָה (Yahuah) Aluahym (God) said unto the woman, What is this that you have done? And the woman said, The serpent deceived me, and I did eat. 14 And יְהוָה (Yahuah) Aluahym (God) said unto the serpent, Because you have done this, you are cursed above all cattle, and above every beast of the field; upon

your belly shall you go, and dust shall you eat all the days of your life:

Genesis 3:21 Unto Adam also and to his wife did אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluahym (God) make coats of skins, and clothed them. 22 And אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluahym (God) said, Behold, the man is become as one of us, to know good and evil: and now, lest he put forth his hand, and take also of the tree of life, and eat, and live for ever: 23 Therefore אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluahym (God) sent him out from the garden of Eden, to till the ground from where he was taken.

Genesis 9:26 And he said, Baruch (Blessed) be אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Shem; and Canaan shall be his servant.

Genesis 24:7 אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Shamyim (Heavens), which took me from my father's house, and from the land of my kindred, and which spoke to me, and that swore unto me, saying, Unto your seed will I give this land; he shall send his Malak (Angel) before you, and you shall take a wife unto my son from there.

Genesis 24:27 And he said, Baruch (Blessed) be אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of my master Abraham, who has not left destitute my master of his mercy and his truth: I being in the way, אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) led me to the house of my master's brethren.

Genesis 24:48 And I bowed down my head, and Worshipped אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), and Baruch (Blessed) אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of my master Abraham, which had led me in the right way to take my master's brother's daughter unto his son.

Genesis 28:13 And, behold, אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) stood above it, and said, I am אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhe (God) of Abraham your father, and Aluhe (The God) of Yishaq (Isaac): the land whereon you lie, I will give to you and to your offspring.

Exodus 3:15 And Aluahym (God) said moreover unto Moses, This shall you say unto the children of Yisrael, אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhe (God) of your fathers, the Aluhe (God) of Abraham, Aluhe (The God) of Yishaq (Isaac), and Aluhe (The God) of Ya'aqob (Jacob), has sent me unto you: this is my name for ever, and this is my memorial unto all generations. 16 Go, and gather the elders of Yisrael together, and say unto them, אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of your fathers, Aluhe (The God) of Abraham, of Yishaq (Isaac), and of Ya'aqob (Jacob), appeared unto me, saying, I have surely visited you, and seen that which is done to you in Mitsrayim (Egypt):

Exodus 3:18 And they will listen to your voice, and you and the elders of Yisrael shall go to the king of Mitsrayim (Egypt) and say to him, אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluah (God) of the Hebrews, has met with us; and now, please let us go a three (3) days' journey into the wilderness, that we may sacrifice to אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluah (God).'

Exodus 4:5 That they may believe that אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluah (God) of their fathers, Aluhe (the God) of Abraham, Aluhe (the God) of Yishaq (Isaac), and Aluhe (the God) of Ya'aqob (Jacob), has appeared unto you.

Exodus 5:1 And afterward Moshe (Moses) and Aaron went in, and told Pharaoh, This says אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, Let my people go, that they may hold a feast unto me in the wilderness.

Exodus 7:16 And you shall say unto him, אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of the Hebrews has sent me to you, saying, "Let my people go, that they may serve me in

the wilderness.” But so far, you have not obeyed.

Exodus 9:1 Then אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) said unto Moshe (Moses), Go in unto Pharaoh, and tell him, This says אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of the Hebrews, Let my people go, that they may serve me.

Exodus 9:13 And אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) said unto Moshe (Moses), Rise up early in the morning, and stand before Pharaoh, and say unto him, This says אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of the Hebrews, Let my people go, that they may serve me.

Exodus 9:30 But as for you and your servants, I know that you will not yet fear אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluahym (God).

Exodus 10:3 And Moshe (Moses) and Aaron came in unto Pharaoh, and said unto him, This says אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of the Hebrews, How long will you refuse to humble yourself before me? let my people go, that they may serve me.

Exodus 23:17 Three (3) times in the year all your males shall appear before Adonai אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah).

Exodus 32:27 And he said unto them, This says אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, Put every man his sword by his side, and go in and out from gate to gate throughout the camp, and slay every man his brother, and every man his companion, and every man his neighbour.

Exodus 34:6 And אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) passed by before him, and proclaimed, אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Al/El (God), merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth,

Exodus 34:23 Three (3) times in the year shall all your men children appear before Adonai אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), the Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael.

Deuteronomy 1:11 אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of your fathers make you a thousand times so many more as you are, and Baruch (Bless) you, as he has promised you!

Deuteronomy 1:21 Behold, אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluheka (Your God) has set the land before you: go up and possess it, as אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of your fathers has said unto you; fear not, neither be discouraged.

Deuteronomy 4:1 Now therefore hearken, O Yisrael, unto the statutes and unto the judgments, which I teach you, for to do them, that you may live, and go in and possess the land which אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of your fathers gives you.

Deuteronomy 6:3 Hear therefore, O Yisrael, and observe to do it; that it may be well with you, and that you may increase mightily, as אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of your fathers has promised you, in the land that flows with milk and honey.

Deuteronomy 12:1 These are the Statutes and Judgments, which you shall observe to do in the land, which אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of your fathers gives you to possess it, all the days that you live upon the earth.

Deuteronomy 26:7 And when we cried unto אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of our fathers, אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) heard our voice, and looked on our affliction, and our labour, and our oppression:

Deuteronomy 27:3 And you shall write upon them all the words of this Torah (law), when you are passed over, that you may go in unto the land which אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) Aluheka (your God) gives you, a land that flows with milk and honey; as אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of you fathers has promised you.

Deuteronomy 29:25 Then men shall say, Because they have forsaken the Covenant of אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) Aluah (God) of their fathers, which he made with them when he brought them forth out of the land of Mitsrayim (Egypt):

Joshua 7:13 Get up! Consecrate (Sanctify) the people and say, ‘Consecrate yourselves for tomorrow; for this says אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, “There are devoted things in your midst, O Yisrael. You cannot stand before your enemies until you take away the devoted things from among you.”

Sanctify the people, and say, Sanctify yourselves against to morrow: for this says אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, There is an accursed thing in the midst of you, O Yisrael: you can not stand before your enemies, until you take away the accursed thing from among you.

Joshua 7:19 And OWHָשׁוּעַ (Yahusha/Joshua) said unto Achan, My son, give, I pray you, esteem (glory) to אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, and make confession unto him; and tell me now what you have done; hide it not from me.

Joshua 7:20 And Achan answered OWHָשׁוּעַ (Yahusha/Joshua), and said, Indeed I have sinned against אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, and this I have done:

Joshua 8:30 Then OWHָשׁוּעַ (Yahusha/Joshua) built an altar unto אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael in mount Ebal,

Joshua 9:18 And the children of Yisrael smote them not, because the princes of the congregation had sworn unto them by אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael. And all the congregation murmured against the princes.

Joshua 9:19 But all the princes said unto all the congregation, We have sworn unto them by אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael: now therefore we may not touch them.

Joshua 10:40 So OWHָשׁוּעַ (Yahusha/Joshua) smote all the country of the hills, and of the south, and of the vale, and of the springs, and all their kings: he left none remaining, but utterly destroyed all that breathed, as אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael commanded.

Joshua 10:42 And all these kings and their land did OWHָשׁוּעַ (Yahusha/Joshua) take at one (1) time, because אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael fought for Yisrael.

Joshua 13:14 Only unto the tribe of Levi he gave no inheritance; the sacrifices of אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael made by fire are their inheritance, as he said unto them.

Joshua 13:33 But unto the tribe of Levi Moshe (Moses) gave no inheritance: אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael was their inheritance, as he said unto them.

Joshua 14:14 Hebron therefore became the inheritance of Caleb the son of Yephunneh the Kenezite unto this day, because that he wholly followed אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael.

Joshua 18:3 So OWYAZL (Yahusha/Joshua) said to the people of Israel, “How long will you put off going in to take possession of the land, which AYAZL (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of your fathers, has given you?”

Joshua 22:22 AYAZL (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Alahym (gods), AYAZL (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Alahym (gods), he knows, and Yisrael he shall know; if it be in rebellion, or if in transgression against AYAZL (Yahuah), (save us not this day)

Joshua 22:24 And if we have not rather done it for fear of this thing, saying, In time to come your children might speak unto our children, saying, What have you to do with AYAZL (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael?

Joshua 24:2 And OWYAZL (Yahusha/Joshua) said unto all the people, This says AYAZL (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, Your fathers dwelt on the other side of the flood in old time, even Terah, the father of Abraham, and the father of Nachor: and they served other Aluahym (gods).

Joshua 24:23 Now therefore put away, said he, the strange Aluahym (gods) which are among you, and incline your heart unto AYAZL (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael.

Judges 2:12 And they forsook AYAZL (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of their fathers, which brought them out of the land of Mitsrayim (Egypt), and followed other Aluahym (gods), of the Aluahym (gods) of the people that were round about them, and bowed themselves unto them, and provoked AYAZL (Yahuah) to anger.

Judges 4:6 She sent and summoned Barak the son of Abinoam from Kedesh-naphtali and said to him, “Has not AYAZL (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael Commanded, saying, Go, gather your men at Mount Tabor, taking 10,000 from the people of Naphtali and the people of Zebulun.

Judges 5:3 Hear, O you kings; give ear, O you princes; I, even I, will sing unto AYAZL (Yahuah); I will sing Hallu (Praise) to AYAZL (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael.

Judges 5:5 The mountains melted from before AYAZL (Yahuah), even that Sinai from before AYAZL (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael.

Judges 6:8 That AYAZL (Yahuah) sent a prophet unto the children of Yisrael, which said unto them, This says AYAZL (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, I brought you up from Mitsrayim (Egypt), and brought you forth out of the house of bondage;

Judges 11:21 And AYAZL (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael delivered Sihon and all his people into the hand of Yisrael, and they smote them: so Yisrael possessed all the land of the Amorites, the inhabitants of that country.

Judges 11:23 So now AYAZL (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael has dispossessed the Amorites from before his people Yisrael, and should you possess it?

Ruth 2:12 AYAZL (Yahuah) recompense your work, and a full reward be given you of AYAZL (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, under whose wings you have come to trust.

1 Samuel 2:30 Wherefore AYAZL (Yahuah) Aluah (God) of Yisrael says, I said indeed that your house, and the house of your father, should walk before me for ever: but now AYAZL (Yahuah) says, Be it far from me; for them that honour me I will honour,

and they that despise me shall be lightly esteemed.

1 Samuel 10:18 And said unto the children of Yisrael, This says יהוה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, I brought up Yisrael out of Egypt, and delivered you out of the hand of the Mitrayim (Egyptians), and out of the hand of all kingdoms, and of them that oppressed you:

1 Samuel 14:41 Therefore Saul said unto יהוה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, Give a perfect lot. And Saul and Yonathan were taken: but the people escaped.

1 Samuel 25:32 And David said to Abigail, Baruch (Blessed) be יהוה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, which sent you this day to meet me:

1 Samuel 25:34 For as surely as יהוה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, lives, who has restrained me from hurting you, unless you had hurried and come to meet me, truly by morning there had not been left to Nabal so much as one (1) male.”

2 Samuel 5:10 And David went on, and grew great, and יהוה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of hosts was with him.

2 Samuel 12:7 And Nathan said to David, You are the man. This says יהוה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, I anointed you king over Yisrael, and I delivered you out of the hand of Saul;

1 Kings 1:30 Even as I swear unto you by יהוה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, saying, Assuredly Solomon your son shall reign after me, and he shall sit upon my throne in my stead; even so will I certainly do this day.

1 Kings 1:36 And Benaiah the son of Yehoiada answered the king, and said, Aman: יהוה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of my Adon (lord) the king say so too.

1 Kings 1:48 And also this said the king, Baruch (Blessed) be יהוה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, which has given one (1) to sit on my throne this day, mine eyes even seeing it.

1 Kings 2:26 And unto Abiathar the priest said the king, Get you to Anathoth, unto your own fields; for you are worthy of death: but I will not at this time put you to death, because you barest the ark of יהוה (Yahuah) Aluah (God) before David my father, and because you have been afflicted in all wherein my father was afflicted.

1 Kings 8:15 And he said, Baruch (Blessed) be יהוה (Yahuah) Aluah (God) of Yisrael, which spake with his mouth unto David my father, and has with his hand fulfilled it, saying,

1 Kings 8:17 And it was in the heart of David my father to build an house for the name of יהוה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael.

1 Kings 8:20 And יהוה (Yahuah) has performed his word that he spoke, and I am risen up in the room of David my father, and sit on the throne of Yisrael, as יהוה (Yahuah) promised, and have built an house for the name of יהוה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael.

1 Kings 11:9 And יהוה (Yahuah) was angry with Solomon, because his heart was turned from יהוה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, which had appeared unto him two (2) times,

1 Kings 14:7 Go, tell Yeroboam, This says **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, Forasmuch as I exalted you from among the people, and made you prince over my people Yisrael,

1 Kings 14:13 And all Yisrael shall mourn for him, and bury him: for he only of Yeroboam shall come to the grave, because in him there is found some good thing toward **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael in the house of Yeroboam.

1 Kings 15:30 Because of the Sins of Yeroboam (idol worship) which he Sinned, and which he made Yisrael Sin, by his provocation wherewith he provoked **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael to anger.

1 Kings 16:13 For all the Sins of Baasha, and the Sins of Elah his son, by which they Sinned, and by which they made Yisrael to Sin, in provoking **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael to anger with their vanities.

1 Kings 16:26 For he walked in all the way of Yeroboam the son of Nebat, and in his Sin wherewith he made Yisrael to Sin, to provoke **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael to anger with their vanities.

1 Kings 16:33 And Ahab made a grove; and Ahab did more to provoke **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael to anger than all the kings of Yisrael that were before him.

1 Kings 17:1 And EliYah the Tishbite, who was of the inhabitants of Gilead, said unto Ahab, As **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael lives, before whom I stand, there shall not be dew nor rain these years, but according to my word.

1 Kings 17:14 For this says **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, The barrel of meal shall not waste, neither shall the cruse of oil fail, until the day that **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) sends rain upon the earth.

1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), hear me, that this people may know that you are **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluahym (God), and that you have turned their heart back again.

1 Kings 19:10 He said, "I have been very jealous for **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of hosts. For the people of Yisrael have forsaken your covenant, thrown down your altars, and killed your prophets with the sword, and I, even I only, am left, and they seek my life, to take it away."

1 Kings 19:14 He said, "I have been very jealous for **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of hosts. For the people of Yisrael have forsaken your Covenant, thrown down your altars, and killed your prophets with the sword, and I, even I only, am left, and they seek my life, to take it away."

1 Kings 22:53 For he served Baal (The Lord), and Worshipped him, and provoked to anger **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, according to all that his father had done.

2 Kings 2:14 And he took the mantle of EliYah that fell from him, and smote the waters, and said, Where is **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of EliYah? And when he had struck the water, the water was parted to the one side and to the other, and Elisha went over.

2 Kings 9:6 And he arose, and went into the house; and he poured the oil on his head, and said unto him, This says **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, I have anointed you king over the people of **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), even over Yisrael.

2 Kings 10:31 But Yahu took no heed to walk in the Torah (law) of **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael with all his heart: for he departed not from the Sins of Yeroboam (idol worship), which made Yisrael to Sin.

2 Kings 14:25 He restored the coast of Yisrael from the entering of Hamath unto the sea of the plain, according to the Word of **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, which he spake by the hand of his servant Yonah, the son of Amittai, the prophet, which was of Gathhepher.

2 Kings 18:5 He trusted in **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael; so that after him was none like him among all the kings of Yahudah (Judah), nor any that were before him.

2 Kings 19:19 Now therefore, O **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhenu (Our God) I 'm Praying that you will save us out of his hand, that all the kingdoms of the earth may know that you are **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluahym (God), alone.

2 Kings 19:20 Then Yeshayahu the son of Amoz sent to Hezekiah, saying, “Thus says **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael: Your prayer to me about Sennacherib king of Assyria I have heard

2 Kings 21:12 Therefore this says **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, Behold, I am bringing such evil upon Yerushalayim (Jerusalem) and Yahudah (Judah), that whosoever hears of it, both his ears shall tingle.

2 Kings 21:22 And he forsook **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of his fathers, and walked not in the way of **יְהוָה** (Yahuah).

2 Kings 22:15 And she said unto them, This says **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, Tell the man that sent you to me,

2 Kings 22:18 But to the king of Yahudah (Judah) which sent you to enquire of **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), this shall you say to him, This says **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, As touching the words which you have heard; 19 because your heart was penitent, and you humbled yourself before **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), when you heard how I spoke against this place and against its inhabitants, that they should become a desolation and a curse, and you have torn your clothes and wept before me, I also have heard you, declares **יְהוָה** (Yahuah).

1 Chronicles 15:12 And said unto them, You are the chief of the fathers of the Levites: sanctify yourselves, both you and your brethren, that you may bring up the ark of **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael unto the place that I have prepared for it.

1 Chronicles 15:14 So the priests and the Levites sanctified themselves to bring up the ark of **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael.

1 Chronicles 16:4 And he appointed certain of the Levites to minister before the ark of **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), and to record, and to give Yadah (thanks) and Halu (Praise) unto **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael:

1 Chronicles 16:36 Baruch (Blessed) be אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael for ever and ever. And all the people said, Aman, and Hallu (Praised) אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah).

1 Chronicles 22:1 Then David said, This is the house of אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) Aluahym (God), and this is the altar of the burnt offering for Yisrael.

1 Chronicles 22:6 Then he called for Solomon his son, and charged him to build an house for אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael.

1 Chronicles 22:19 Now set your heart and your soul to seek אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) Aluhekem (our God); arise therefore, and build you the sanctuary of אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) Aluahym (God), to bring the ark of the covenant of אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah), and the Kadosh (Holy) vessels of Aluahym (God), into the house that is to be built in the Name of אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah).

1 Chronicles 23:25 For David said, אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael has given rest unto his people, that they may dwell in Yerusalem for ever:

1 Chronicles 24:19 These were the orderings of them in their service to come into the house of אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah), according to their manner, under Aaron their father, as אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael had commanded him.

1 Chronicles 28:4 Howbeit אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) Aluah (God) of Yisrael chose me before all the house of my father to be king over Yisrael for ever: for he has chosen Yahudah (Judah) to be the ruler; and of the house of Yahudah (Judah), the house of my father; and among the sons of my father he liked me to make me king over all Yisrael:

1 Chronicles 28:20 And David said to Solomon his son, Be strong and of good courage, and do it: fear not, nor be dismayed: for אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God), even Aluhay (My God), will be with you; he will not fail you, nor forsake you, until you have finished all the work for the service of the house of אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah).

1 Chronicles 29:1 Furthermore David the King said unto all the congregation, Solomon my son, whom alone Aluahym (God) has chosen, is yet young and tender, and the work is great: for the palace is not for man, but for אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) Aluahym (God).

1 Chronicles 29:20 And David said to all the congregation, Now Barach (Bless) אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) Aluhekem (Our God). And all the congregation Baruch (Blessed) אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of their fathers, and bowed down their heads, and worshipped אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah), and the King.

2 Chronicles 2:12 Hiram said moreover, Baruch (Blessed) be אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, that made Shamyim (Heavens) and earth, who has given to David the King a wise son, endued with prudence and understanding, that might build an house for אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah), and an house for his kingdom.

2 Chronicles 6:4 And he said, Baruch (Blessed) be אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, who has with his hands fulfilled that which he spake with his mouth to my father David, saying,

2 Chronicles 6:7 Now it was in the heart of David my father to build an house for the name of אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael.

2 Chronicles 6:10 יהוה (Yahuah) therefore has performed his word that he has spoken: for I am risen up in the room of David my father, and am set on the throne of Yisrael, as יהוה (Yahuah) promised, and have built the house for the Name of יהוה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael.

2 Chronicles 7:22 And it shall be answered, Because they forsook יהוה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of their fathers, which brought them forth out of the land of Mitsrayim (Egypt), and laid hold on other Aluahym (gods), and Worshipped them, and Served them: therefore has he brought all this Evil upon them.

2 Chronicles 11:16 And after them out of all the tribes of Yisrael such as set their hearts to seek יהוה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael came to Yerusalem, to sacrifice unto יהוה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of their fathers.

2 Chronicles 13:5 Ought you not to know that יהוה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael gave the kingdom over Yisrael to David for ever, even to him and to his sons by a covenant of salt?

2 Chronicles 13:12 And, behold, Aluahym (God) himself is with us for our captain, and his priests with sounding Shofars (trumpets) to cry alarm against you. O children of Yisrael, fight not against יהוה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of your fathers; for you shall not prosper.

2 Chronicles 13:18 Thus the children of Yisrael were brought under at that time, and the children of Yahudah (Judah) prevailed, because they relied upon יהוה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of their fathers.

2 Chronicles 14:4 And Commanded Yahudah (Judah) to seek יהוה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of their fathers, and to do the Torah (law) and the Commandment.

2 Chronicles 15:4 but when in their distress they turned to יהוה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Israel, and sought him, he was found by them.

2 Chronicles 15:12 And they entered into a Covenant to seek יהוה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of their fathers with all their Heart and with all their Soul;

2 Chronicles 15:13 That whosoever would not seek יהוה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael should be put to death, whether small or great, whether man or woman.

2 Chronicles 17:4 But sought יהוה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of his father, and walked in his Commandments, and not after the doings of Yisrael.

2 Chronicles 19:4 And Yehoshaphat dwelt at Yerusalem: and he went out again through the people from Beersheba to mount Ephraim, and brought them back unto יהוה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of their fathers.

2 Chronicles 20:19 And the Levites, of the children of the Kohathites, and of the children of the Korhites, stood up to Hallu (Praise) יהוה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael with a loud voice on high.

2 Chronicles 21:10 So the Edomites revolted from under the hand of Yahudah (Judah) unto this day. The same time also did Libnah revolt from under his hand; because he had forsaken יהוה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of his fathers.

2 Chronicles 21:12 And there came a writing to him from EliYah the prophet, saying, This say יהוה (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of David your father, Because you

have not walked in the ways of Yehoshaphat your father, nor in the ways of Asa king of Yahudah (Judah),

2 Chronicles 24:18 And they left the house of אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of their fathers, and served groves and idols: and wrath came upon Yahudah (Judah) and Yerusalem for this their trespass.

2 Chronicles 24:24 For the army of the Syrians came with a small company of men, and אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) delivered a very great host into their hand, because they had forsaken אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of their fathers. So they executed judgment against Yoash.

2 Chronicles 26:18 and they withstood King Uzziah and said to him, “It is not for you, Uzziah, to burn incense to אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), but for the priests, the sons of Aaron, who are consecrated to burn incense. Go out of the sanctuary, for you have done wrong, and it will bring you no honor from אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluahym (God).”

2 Chronicles 28:6 For Pekah the son of Remaliah slew in Yahudah (Judah) an hundred (100) and twenty (20) thousand (000) in one (1) day, which were all valiant men; because they had forsaken אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of their fathers.

2 Chronicles 28:9 But a prophet of אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) was there, whose name was Oded, and he went out to meet the army that came to Samaria and said to them, “Behold, because אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of your fathers, was angry with Yahudah (Judah), he gave them into your hand, but you have killed them in a rage that has reached up to Shamyim (Heavens).

2 Chronicles 28:25 And in every several city of Yahudah (Judah) he made high places to burn incense unto other Aluahym (gods), and provoked to anger אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluah (God) of his fathers.

2 Chronicles 29:5 And said unto them, Hear me, you Levites, sanctify now yourselves, and sanctify the house of אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluah (God) of your fathers, and carry forth the filthiness out of the Kadosh (holy) place.

2 Chronicles 29:10 Now it is in mine heart to make a Covenant with אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, that his fierce wrath may turn away from us.

2 Chronicles 30:1 And Hezekiah sent to all Ysrael and Yahudah (Judah), and wrote letters also to Ephraim and Manasseh, that they should come to the house of אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) at Yerusalem, to keep the passover unto אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael.

2 Chronicles 30:5 So they established a decree to make proclamation throughout all Yisrael, from Beersheba even to Dan, that they should come to keep Pesach (the passover) unto אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael at Yerusalem: for they had not done it of a long time in such sort as it was written.

2 Chronicles 30:6 So the posts went with the letters from the King and his Princes throughout all Yisrael and Yahudah (Judah), and according to the Commandment of the King, saying, You children of Yisrael, turn again unto אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Abraham, Yitshaq (Isaac), and Yisrael, and he will return to the remnant of you, that are escaped out of the hand of the kings of Assyria.

2 Chronicles 30:7 And be not like your fathers, and like your brethren, which

trespassed against **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluah (God) of their fathers, who therefore gave them up to desolation, as you see.

2 Chronicles 30:19 That prepare his heart to seek Aluahym (God), **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of his fathers, though he be not cleansed according to the purification of the sanctuary.

2 Chronicles 30:22 And Hezekiah spake comfortably unto all the Levites that taught the good knowledge of **יְהוָה** (Yahuah): and they did eat throughout the feast seven (7) days, offering Shalum (Peace) offerings, and making confession to **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of their fathers.

2 Chronicles 32:16 And his servants spoke yet more against **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluahym (God), and against his servant Hezekiah.

2 Chronicles 32:17 He wrote also letters to rail on **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, and to speak against him, saying, As the Aluahym (gods) of the nations of other lands have not delivered their people out of mine hand, so shall not Aluhe (The God) of Hezekiah deliver his people out of mine hand.

2 Chronicles 33:16 And he repaired the altar of **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), and sacrificed thereon Shalum (Peace) offerings and thank offerings, and Commanded Yahudah (Judah) to serve **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael.

2 Chronicles 33:18 Now the rest of the acts of Manasseh, and his prayer unto Aluha (his God), and the words of the seers that spoke to him in the name of **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, behold, they are written in the book of the Kings of Yisrael.

2 Chronicles 34:23 And she answered them, This says **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, Tell the man that sent you to me, Thus says **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), Behold, I will bring disaster upon this place and upon its inhabitants, all the curses that are written in the book that was read before the King of Yahudah (Judah).

2 Chronicles 34:26 And as for the King of Yahudah (Judah), who sent you to enquire of **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), so shall you say unto him, This says **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael concerning the words which you have heard; because your heart was tender and you humbled yourself before Aluahym (God) when you heard his words against this place and its inhabitants, and you have humbled yourself before me and have torn your clothes and wept before me, I also have heard you, declares **יְהוָה** (Yahuah).

2 Chronicles 36:13 And he also rebelled against king Nebuchadnezzar, who had made him swear by Aluahym (God): but he stiffened his neck, and hardened his heart from turning unto **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael.

2 Chronicles 36:15 And **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of their fathers, sent persistently to them by his messengers, because he had compassion on his people and on his dwelling place.

2 Chronicles 36:23 This says Cyrus king of Persia, All the kingdoms of the earth has **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Shamyim (Heavens) given me; and he has charged me to build him an house in Yerusalem (Jerusalem), which is in Yahudah (Judah). Who is there among you of all his people? **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluha (his God)

be with him, and let him go up.

Ezra 1:2 This says Cyrus king of Persia, אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Shamyim (Heavens) has given me all the kingdoms of the earth; and he has charged me to build him an house at Yerusalem, which is in Yahudah (Judah).

Ezra 1:3 Who is there among you of all his people? His Aluahym (God) be with him, and let him go up to Yerusalem, which is in Yahudah (Judah), and build the house of אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, which is in Yerusalem.

Ezra 4:1 Now when the adversaries of Yahudah (Judah) and Benjamin heard that the returned exiles were building a temple to אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael,

Ezra 4:3 But Zerubbabel, and Yeshua, and the rest of the chief of the fathers of Yisrael, said unto them, You have nothing to do with us to build an house unto Aluhenu (our God); but we ourselves together will build unto אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, as king Cyrus the king of Persia has Commanded us.

Ezra 6:21 It was eaten by the people of Ysrael who had returned from exile, and also by every one who had joined them and separated himself from the uncleanness of the peoples of the land to worship אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisra'el.

Ezra 7:6 This Ezra went up from Babylon; and he was a ready scribe in the Torah (law) of Moshe (Moses), which אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael had given: and the king granted him all his request, according to the hand of אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) his Aluahym (God) upon him.

Ezra 7:27 Baruch (Blessed) be אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of our fathers, which has put such a thing as this in the King's heart, to beautify the house of אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) which is in Yerusalem:

Ezra 8:28 And I said unto them, You are Kadosh (Holy) unto אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah); the vessels are Kadosh (Holy) also; and the silver and the gold are a freewill offering unto אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of your fathers.

Ezra 10:11 Now therefore make confession unto אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of your fathers, and do his pleasure: and separate yourselves from the people of the land, and from the strange wives.

Psalms 41:13 Baruch (Blessed) be אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael from everlasting, and to everlasting. Aman, and Aman.

Psalms 68:18 You have ascended on high, you have led captivity captive: you have received gifts for men; for the rebellious also, that אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) Aluahym (God) might dwell among them.

Psalms 71:16 I will go in the strength of the Adonai אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah): I will make mention of your Righteousness, even of yours only.

Psalms 72:18 Baruch (Blessed) be אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) Aluahym (God), Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, who only does wondrous things.

Psalms 73:28 But it is good for me to draw near to Aluahym (God): I have put my trust in Adonai אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah), that I may declare all you works.

Psalms 84:11 For אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluahym (God) is a Sun and Shield: אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) will give unmerited favor (grace) and esteem (glory): no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly.

Psalms 106:48 Baruch (Blessed) be אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael from everlasting to everlasting: and let all the people say, Aman. Hallu (Praise) you אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah).

Isaiah 3:15 What do you mean by crushing my people, by grinding the face of the poor?" declares Adonai אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) of hosts.

Isaiah 7:7 This says Adonai אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), It shall not stand, neither shall it come to pass.

Isaiah 10:23 For Adonai אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) of hosts shall make a consumption, even determined, in the midst of all the land.

Isaiah 10:24 Therefore this says Adonai אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) of hosts, O my people that dwellest in Zion, be not afraid of the Assyrian: he shall smite you with a rod, and shall lift up his staff against you, after the manner of Mitrayim (Egypt).

Isaiah 17:6 Yet gleaning grapes shall be left in it, as the shaking of an olive tree, two (2) or three (3) berries in the top of the uppermost bough, four (4) or five (5) in the outmost fruitful branches thereof, says אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael.

Isaiah 21:17 And the residue of the number of archers, the mighty men of the children of Kedar, shall be diminished: for אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael has spoken it.

Isaiah 22:5 For it is a day of trouble, and of treading down, and of perplexity by Adonai אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) of hosts in the valley of vision, breaking down the walls, and of crying to the mountains.

Isaiah 22:12 And in that day did Adonai אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) of hosts call to weeping, and to mourning, and to baldness, and to girding with sackcloth:

Isaiah 22:14 And it was revealed in my ears by Adonai אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) of hosts, Surely this iniquity shall not be purged from you till you die, says Adonai אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) of hosts.

Isaiah 24:15 Therefore in the east give glory to אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah); in the coastlands of the sea, give glory to the Name of אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael.

Isaiah 25:8 He will swallow up death in victory; and Adonai אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) will wipe away tears from off all faces; and the rebuke of his people shall he take away from off all the earth: for אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) has spoken it.

Isaiah 28:16 Therefore this says Adonai אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), Behold, I lay in Zion for a foundation a stone, a tried stone, a precious corner stone, a sure foundation: he that believes shall not be in haste.

Isaiah 28:22 Now therefore do not scoff, lest your bonds be made strong; for I have heard a decree of destruction from Adonai אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) of hosts against the whole Earth.

Isaiah 30:15 For this says Adonai אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), the Kadosh (Holy) One (1) of

Yisrael, "In returning and rest you shall be Saved; in quietness and in trust shall be your strength." But you were unwilling.

Isaiah 37:21 Then Yeshayahu (Isaiah) the son of Amoz sent to Hezekiah, saying, "This says **יהוה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God of Yisrael: Because you have prayed to me concerning Sennacherib king of Assyria,

Isaiah 40:10 Behold, Adonai **יהוה** (Yahuah) will come with strong hand, and his arm shall rule for him: behold, his reward is with him, and his work before him.

Isaiah 48:16 Draw near to me, hear this: from the beginning I have not spoken in secret, from the time it came to be I have been there." And now Adonai **יהוה** (Yahuah) has sent me, and his Ruach (Spirit).

Isaiah 49:22 This says Adonai **יהוה** (Yahuah), Behold, I will lift up mine hand to the Gentiles, and set up my standard to the people: and they shall bring your sons in their arms, and your daughters shall be carried upon their shoulders.

Isaiah 50:4 Adonai **יהוה** (Yahuah) has given me the tongue of the learned, that I should know how to speak a word in season to him that is weary: he wakens morning by morning, he wakens my ear to hear as the learned.

Isaiah 50:5 Adonai **יהוה** (Yahuah) has opened my ear, and I was not rebellious; I turned not backward.

Isaiah 50:7 But Adonai **יהוה** (Yahuah) helps me; therefore I have not been disgraced; therefore I have set my face like a flint, and I know that I shall not be put to shame.

Isaiah 50:9 Behold, Adonai **יהוה** (Yahuah) will help me; who is he that shall condemn me? lo, they all shall wax old as a garment; the moth shall eat them up.

Isaiah 52:4 For this says Adonai **יהוה** (Yahuah), My people went down afore time into Mitsrayim (Egypt) to sojourn there; and the Assyrian oppressed them without cause.

Isaiah 56:8 Adonai **יהוה** (Yahuah) which gathers the outcasts of Yisrael says, Yet will I gather others to him, beside those that are gathered unto him.

Isaiah 61:1 The Ruach (Spirit) of Adonai **יהוה** (Yahuah) is upon me; because **יהוה** (Yahuah) has anointed me to declare good tidings unto the meek; he has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound;

Isaiah 61:11 For as the earth brings forth her bud, and as the garden causes the things that are sown in it to spring forth; so Adonai **יהוה** (Yahuah) will cause Righteousness and Hallu (Praise) to spring forth before all the nations.

Isaiah 65:13 Therefore this says Adonai **יהוה** (Yahuah), Behold, my servants shall eat, but you shall be hungry: behold, my servants shall drink, but you shall be thirsty: behold, my servants shall rejoice, but you shall be ashamed:

Isaiah 65:15 And you shall leave your name for a curse unto my chosen: for Adonai **יהוה** (Yahuah) shall slay you, and call his servants by another Name:

Jeremiah 2:19 Your own wickedness shall correct you, and your backslidings shall

reprove you: know therefore and see that it is an evil thing and bitter, that you have forsaken **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) your Aluahym (God), and that my fear is not in you, say Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) of hosts.

Jeremiah 2:22 Though you wash yourself with lye and use much soap, the stain of your guilt is still before me, declares Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah).

Jeremiah 5:14 Wherefore this says Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) of hosts, Because you speak this Word, behold, I will make my Words in your mouth fire, and this people wood, and it shall devour them.

Jeremiah 7:20 Therefore this says Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah); Behold, mi anger and my fury shall be poured out upon this place, upon man, and upon beast, and upon the trees of the field, and upon the fruit of the ground; and it shall burn, and shall not be quenched.

Jeremiah 11:3 And say this unto them, This says **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael; Cursed be the man that does not obey the Words of this Covenant,

Jeremiah 13:12 Therefore you shall speak unto them this Word; This says **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, Every bottle shall be filled with wine: and they shall say unto you, Do we not certainly know that every bottle shall be filled with wine?

Jeremiah 21:4 This says **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael; Behold, I will turn back the weapons of war that are in your hands, wherewith you fight against the king of Babylon, and against the Chaldeans, which besiege you without the Walls, and I will assemble them into the midst of this city.

Jeremiah 23:2 Therefore this says **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael against the pastors that feed my people; You have scattered my flock, and driven them away, and have not visited them: behold, I will visit upon you the evil of your doings, says **יְהוָה** (Yahuah).

Jeremiah 25:15 For this says **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael unto me; Take the wine cup of this fury at my hand, and cause all the nations, to whom I send you, to drink it.

Jeremiah 30:2 This speaks **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael, saying, Write all the words that I have spoken unto you in a book.

Jeremiah 35:17 Therefore this says **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of hosts, **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of Yisrael; Behold, I will bring upon Yahudah (Judah) and upon all the inhabitants of Yerusalem all the evil that I have pronounced against them: because I have spoken unto them, but they have not heard; and I have called unto them, but they have not answered.

Jeremiah 44:26 Therefore hear the word of **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), all Yahudah (Judah) that dwell in the land of Egypt; Behold, I have sworn by My Great Name, says **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), that My Name shall no more be Named in the mouth of any man of Yahudah (Judah) in all the land of Egypt, saying, Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) lives.

Jeremiah 46:10 That day is the day of Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) of hosts, a day of vengeance, to avenge himself on his foes. The sword shall devour and be sated and drink its fill of their blood. For Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) of hosts holds a sacrifice in

the north country by the river Euphrates.

Jeremiah 49:5 Behold, I will bring terror upon you, declares Adonai יהוה (Yahuah) of hosts, from all who are around you, and you shall be driven out, every man straight before him, with none to gather the fugitives.

Jeremiah 50:25 יהוה (Yahuah) has opened his armoury, and has brought forth the weapons of his indignation: for this is the work of Adonai יהוה (Yahuah) of hosts in the land of the Chaldeans.

Jeremiah 50:31 Behold, I am against you, O you most proud, says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah) of hosts: for your day is come, the time that I will visit you.
