

יְהוָה (Yahuah) Aluah (God) - continued

Jeremiah 51:56 for a destroyer has come upon her, upon Babylon; her warriors are taken; their bows are broken in pieces, for Adonai יְהוָה (Yahuah) is Al/El (God) of recompense; he will surely repay.

Ezekiel 2:4 The descendants also are impudent and stubborn: I send you to them, and you shall say to them, 'Thus says Adonai יְהוָה (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 3:11 And go to the exiles, to your people, and speak to them and say to them, 'Thus says Adonai יְהוָה (Yahuah),' whether they hear or refuse to hear."

Ezekiel 3:27 But when I speak with you, I will open your mouth, and you shall say to them, 'Thus says Adonai יְהוָה (Yahuah).' He who will hear, let him hear; and he who will refuse to hear, let him refuse, for they are a rebellious house.

Ezekiel 5:5 "Thus says Adonai יְהוָה (Yahuah): This is Yerusalem. I have set her in the center of the nations, with countries all around her.

Ezekiel 5:7 Therefore thus says Adonai יְהוָה (Yahuah): Because you are more turbulent than the nations that are all around you, and have not walked in my statutes or obeyed my rules, and have not even acted according to the rules of the nations that are all around you,

Ezekiel 5:8 therefore thus says Adonai יְהוָה (Yahuah): Behold, I, even I, am against you. And I will execute judgments in your midst in the sight of the nations.

Ezekiel 5:11 Therefore, as I live, declares Adonai יְהוָה (Yahuah), surely, because you have defiled my sanctuary with all your detestable things and with all your abominations, therefore I will withdraw. My eye will not spare, and I will have no pity.

Ezekiel 6:3 and say, You mountains of Yisrael, hear the word of Adonai יְהוָה (Yahuah)! Thus says Adonai יְהוָה (Yahuah) to the mountains and the hills, to the ravines and the valleys: Behold, I, even I, will bring a sword upon you, and I will destroy your high places.

Ezekiel 6:11 Thus says Adonai יְהוָה (Yahuah): "Clap your hands and stamp your foot and say, Alas, because of all the evil abominations of the house of Yisrael, for they shall fall by the sword, by famine, and by pestilence.

Ezekiel 7:2 "And you, O son of man, thus says Adonai יְהוָה (Yahuah) to the land of Yisrael: An end! The end has come upon the four (4) corners (N, S, E W) of the land.

Ezekiel 7:5 "Thus says Adonai יְהוָה (Yahuah): Disaster after disaster! Behold, it comes.

Ezekiel 8:1 In the sixth (6th)(year, in the sixth (6th) month, on the fifth (5th) day of the month, as I sat in my house, with the elders of Yahudah (Judah) sitting before me, the hand of Adonai יְהוָה (Yahuah) fell upon me there.

Ezekiel 11:7 Therefore thus says Adonai יְהוָה (Yahuah): Your slain whom you have laid in the midst of it, they are the meat, and this city is the cauldron, but you shall be brought out of the midst of it.

Ezekiel 11:8 You have feared the sword, and I will bring the sword upon you, declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 11:16 Therefore say, 'Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): Though I removed them far off among the nations, and though I scattered them among the countries, yet I have been a sanctuary to them for a while in the countries where they have gone.'

Ezekiel 11:17 Therefore, 'Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): I will gather you from the peoples and assemble you out of the countries where you have been scattered, and I will give you the land of Yisrael.'

Ezekiel 11:21 But as for those whose heart goes after their detestable things and their abominations, I will bring their deeds upon their own heads, declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah)."

Ezekiel 12:10 Say to them, 'Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): This oracle concerns the prince in Yerusalem and all the house of Yisrael who are in it.'

Ezekiel 12:19 And say to the people of the land, Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah) concerning the inhabitants of Yerusalem in the land of Yisrael: They shall eat their bread with anxiety, and drink water in dismay. In this way her land will be stripped of all it contains, on account of the violence of all those who dwell in it.

Ezekiel 12:23 Tell them therefore, 'Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): I will put an end to this proverb, and they shall no more use it as a proverb in Yisrael.' But say to them, The days are near, and the fulfillment of every vision.

Ezekiel 12:25 For I am אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah); I will speak the Word that I will speak, and it will be performed. It will no longer be delayed, but in your days, O rebellious house, I will speak the Word and perform it, declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah)."

Ezekiel 12:28 Therefore say to them, Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): None of my Words will be delayed any longer, but the Word that I speak will be performed, declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah)."

Ezekiel 13:3 Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah), Woe to the foolish prophets who follow their own Ruach (Spirit), and have seen nothing!

Ezekiel 13:8 Therefore thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): "Because you have uttered falsehood and seen lying visions, therefore behold, I am against you, declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 13:9 My hand will be against the prophets who see false visions and who give lying divinations. They shall not be in the council of my people, nor be enrolled in the register of the house of Yisrael, nor shall they enter the land of Yisrael. And you shall know that I am Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 13:13 Therefore thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): I will make a stormy wind break out in my wrath, and there shall be a deluge of rain in my anger, and great hailstones in wrath to make a full end.

Ezekiel 13:16 the prophets of Yisrael who prophesied concerning Yerusalem and saw visions of Shalum (Peace) for her, when there was no Shalum (Peace), declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 13:18 and say, Thus says Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah): Woe to the women who sew magic bands upon all wrists, and make veils for the heads of persons of every stature, in the hunt for souls! Will you hunt down souls belonging to my people and keep your own souls alive?

Ezekiel 13:20 “Therefore thus says Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah): Behold, I am against your magic bands with which you hunt the souls like birds, and I will tear them from your arms, and I will let the souls whom you hunt go free, the souls like birds.

Ezekiel 14:4 Therefore speak to them and say to them, Thus says Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah): Any one of the house of Yisrael who takes his idols into his heart and sets the stumbling block of his iniquity before his face, and yet comes to the prophet, I Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) will answer him as he comes with the multitude of his idols,

Ezekiel 14:6 “Therefore say to the house of Yisrael, Thus says Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah): Repent and turn away from your idols, and turn away your faces from all your abominations.

Ezekiel 14:11 that the house of Yisrael may no more go astray from me, nor defile themselves anymore with all their transgressions, but that they may be my people and I may be their Aluahym (God), declares Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah).”

Ezekiel 14:14 even if these three (3) men, Noah, Daniel, and Job, were in it, they would deliver but their own lives by their righteousness, declares Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 14:16 even if these three (3) men were in it, as I live, declares Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), they would deliver neither sons nor daughters. They alone would be delivered, but the land would be desolate.

Ezekiel 14:18 though these three (3) men were in it, as I live, declares Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), they would deliver neither sons nor daughters, but they alone would be delivered.

Ezekiel 14:20 even if Noah, Daniel, and Job were in it, as I live, declares Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), they would deliver neither son nor daughter. They would deliver but their own lives by their righteousness.

Ezekiel 14:21 “For thus says Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah): How much more when I send upon Yerusalem my four (4) disastrous acts of judgment, sword, famine, wild beasts, and pestilence, to cut off from it man and beast!

Ezekiel 14:23 They will console you, when you see their ways and their deeds, and you shall know that I have not done without cause all that I have done in it, declares Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah).”

Ezekiel 15:6 Therefore thus says Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah): Like the wood of the vine among the trees of the forest, which I have given to the fire for fuel, so have I given up the inhabitants of Yerusalem.

Ezekiel 15:8 And I will make the land desolate, because they have acted faithlessly, declares Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah).”

Ezekiel 16:3 and say, Thus says Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) to Yerusalem: Your origin and your birth are of the land of the Canaanites; your father was an Amorite and

your mother a Hittite.

Ezekiel 16:8 “When I passed by you again and saw you, behold, you were at the age for love, and I spread the corner of my garment over you and covered your nakedness; I made my vow to you and entered into a covenant with you, declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah), and you became mine.

Ezekiel 16:14 And your renown went forth among the nations because of your beauty, for it was perfect through the splendor that I had bestowed on you, declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 16:19 Also my bread that I gave you—I fed you with fine flour and oil and honey—you set before them for a pleasing aroma; and so it was, declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 16:23 “And after all your wickedness (woe, woe to you! declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 16:30 “How sick is your heart, declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah), because you did all these things, the deeds of a brazen prostitute,

Ezekiel 16:36 Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah), Because your lust was poured out and your nakedness uncovered in your whorings with your lovers, and with all your abominable idols, and because of the blood of your children that you gave to them.

Ezekiel 16:43 Because you have not remembered the days of your youth, but have enraged me with all these things, therefore, behold, I have returned your deeds upon your head, declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah). Have you not committed lewdness in addition to all your abominations?

Ezekiel 16:48 As I live, declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah), your sister Sodom and her daughters have not done as you and your daughters have done.

Ezekiel 16:59 “For thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): I will deal with you as you have done, you who have despised the oath in breaking the covenant.

Ezekiel 16:63 that you may remember and be confounded, and never open your mouth again because of your shame, when I atone for you for all that you have done, declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah).”

Ezekiel 17:3 say, Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): A great eagle with great wings and long pinions, rich in plumage of many colors, came to Lebanon and took the top of the cedar.

Ezekiel 17:9 “Say, Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): Will it thrive? Will he not pull up its roots and cut off its fruit, so that it withers, so that all its fresh sprouting leaves wither? It will not take a strong arm or many people to pull it from its roots.

Ezekiel 17:16 “As I live, declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah), surely in the place where the king dwells who made him king, whose oath he despised, and whose covenant with him he broke, in Babylon he shall die.

Ezekiel 17:19 Therefore thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): As I live, surely it is my oath that he despised, and my covenant that he broke. I will return it upon his head.

Ezekiel 17:22 Thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): “I myself will take a sprig from the lofty top of the cedar and will set it out. I will break off from the topmost of its young twigs a tender one, and I myself will plant it on a high and lofty mountain.

Ezekiel 18:3 As I live, declares Adonai יהוה (Yahuah), this proverb shall no more be used by you in Yisrael.

Ezekiel 18:9 walks in my statutes, and keeps my rules by acting faithfully—he is righteous; he shall surely live, declares Adonai יהוה (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 18:23 Have I any pleasure in the death of the wicked, declares Adonai יהוה (Yahuah), and not rather that he should turn from his way and live?

Ezekiel 18:30 “Therefore I will judge you, O house of Yisrael, every one according to his ways, declares Adonai יהוה (Yahuah). Repent and turn from all your transgressions, lest iniquity be your ruin.

Ezekiel 18:32 For I have no pleasure in the death of anyone, declares Adonai יהוה (Yahuah); so turn, and live.”

Ezekiel 20:3 “Son of man, speak to the elders of Yisrael, and say to them, Thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah), Is it to inquire of me that you come? As I live, declares Adonai יהוה (Yahuah), I will not be inquired of by you.

Ezekiel 20:5 and say to them, Thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): On the day when I chose Yisrael, I swore to the offspring of the house of Yaqoob (Jacob), making myself known to them in the land of Mitsryim (Egypt); I swore to them, saying, I am יהוה (Yahuah) your Aluahym (God).

Ezekiel 20:27 “Therefore, son of man, speak to the house of Yisrael and say to them, Thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): In this also your fathers blasphemed me, by dealing treacherously with me.

Ezekiel 20:30 “Therefore say to the house of Yisrael, Thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): Will you defile yourselves after the manner of your fathers and go whoring after their detestable things?

Ezekiel 20:31 When you present your gifts and offer up your children in fire, you defile yourselves with all your idols to this day. And shall I be inquired of by you, O house of Yisrael? As I live, declares Adonai יהוה (Yahuah), I will not be inquired of by you.

Ezekiel 20:33 “As I live, declares Adonai יהוה (Yahuah), surely with a mighty hand and an outstretched arm and with wrath poured out I will be king over you.

Ezekiel 20:36 As I entered into judgment with your fathers in the wilderness of the land of Mitsryim (Egypt), so I will enter into judgment with you, declares Adonai יהוה (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 20:39 “As for you, O house of Yisrael, thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): Go serve every one of you his idols, now and hereafter, if you will not listen to me; but my Kadosh (Holy) name you shall no more profane with your gifts and your idols.

Ezekiel 20:40 “For on my Kadosah (Holy) mountain, the mountain height of Yisrael, declares Adonai יהוה (Yahuah), there all the house of Yisrael, all of them, shall serve me in the land. There I will accept them, and there I will require your

contributions and the choicest of your gifts, with all your sacred offerings.

Ezekiel 20:44 And you shall know that I am **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), when I deal with you for my Name's sake, not according to your evil ways, nor according to your corrupt deeds, O house of Yisrael, declares Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah).”

Ezekiel 20:47 Say to the forest of the Negeb, Hear the word of **יְהוָה** (Yahuah): Thus says Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), Behold, I will kindle a fire in you, and it shall devour every green tree in you and every dry tree. The blazing flame shall not be quenched, and all faces from south to north shall be scorched by it.

Ezekiel 21:7 And when they say to you, ‘Why do you groan?’ you shall say, ‘Because of the news that it is coming. Every heart will melt, and all hands will be feeble; every Ruach (Spirit) will faint, and all knees will be weak as water. Behold, it is coming, and it will be fulfilled,’” declares Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 21:13 For it will not be a testing—what could it do if you despise the rod?” declares Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 21:24 “Therefore thus says Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah): Because you have made your guilt to be remembered, in that your transgressions are uncovered, so that in all your deeds your Sins appear—because you have come to remembrance, you shall be taken in hand.

Ezekiel 21:26 thus says Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah): Remove the turban and take off the crown. Things shall not remain as they are. Exalt that which is low, and bring low that which is exalted.

Ezekiel 21:28 “And you, son of man, prophesy, and say, Thus says Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) concerning the Ammonites and concerning their reproach; say, A sword, a sword is drawn for the slaughter. It is polished to consume and to flash like lightning

Ezekiel 22:3 You shall say, Thus says Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah): A city that sheds blood in her midst, so that her time may come, and that makes idols to defile herself!

Ezekiel 22:12 In you they take bribes to shed blood; you take interest and profit and make gain of your neighbors by extortion; but me you have forgotten, declares **יְהוָה** (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 22:19 Therefore thus says Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah): Because you have all gone aside, therefore, behold, I will gather you into the midst of Yerusalem.

Ezekiel 22:28 And er prophets have smeared whitewash for them, seeing false visions and divining lies for them, saying, ‘Thus says Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah),’ when **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) has not spoken.

Ezekiel 22:31 Therefore I have poured out my indignation upon them. I have consumed them with the fire of my wrath. I have returned their way upon their heads, declares Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah).”

Ezekiel 23:22 Therefore, O Oholibah, thus says Adonai **יְהוָה** (Yahuah): “Behold, I will stir up against you your lovers from whom you turned in disgust, and I will bring them against you from every side.

Ezekiel 23:28 “For thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): Behold, I will deliver you into the hands of those whom you hate, into the hands of those from whom you turned in disgust

Ezekiel 23:32 Thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah):“You shall drink your sister's cup that is deep and large; you shall be laughed at and held in derision, for it contains much;

Ezekiel 23:34 you shall drink it and drain it out, and gnaw its shards, and tear your breasts; for I have spoken, declares Adonai יהוה (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 23:35 Therefore thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): Because you have forgotten me and cast me behind your back, you yourself must bear the consequences of your lewdness (the quality of being very sexual or lustful in an offensive way) and whoring.”

Ezekiel 23:46 For thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): “Bring up a vast host against them, and make them an object of terror and a plunder.

Ezekiel 23:49 And they shall return your lewdness upon you, and you shall bear the penalty for your sinful idolatry, and you shall know that I am Adonai יהוה (Yahuah).”

Ezekiel 24:3 And utter a parable to the rebellious house and say to them, Thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah):“Set on the pot, set it on; pour in water also; 4 put in it the pieces of meat, all the good pieces, the thigh and the shoulder; fill it with choice bones.

Ezekiel 24:6 “Therefore thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): Woe to the bloody city, to the pot whose corrosion is in it, and whose corrosion has not gone out of it! Take out of it piece after piece, without making any choice.

Ezekiel 24:9 Therefore thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): Woe to the bloody city! I also will make the pile great.

Ezekiel 24:14 I am יהוה (Yahuah). I have spoken; it shall come to pass; I will do it. I will not go back; I will not spare; I will not relent; according to your ways and your deeds you will be judged, declares Adonai יהוה (Yahuah).”

Ezekiel 24:21 ‘Say to the house of Yisrael, Thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): Behold, I will profane my sanctuary, the pride of your power, the delight of your eyes, and the yearning of your soul, and your sons and your daughters whom you left behind shall fall by the sword.

Ezekiel 24:24 Thus shall Ezekiel be to you a sign; according to all that he has done you shall do. When this comes, then you will know that I am Adonai יהוה (Yahuah).’

Ezekiel 25:3 Say to the Ammonites, Hear the word of Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): Thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah), Because you said, ‘Aha!’ over my sanctuary when it was profaned, and over the land of Yisrael when it was made desolate, and over the house of Yahudah (Judah) when they went into exile,

Ezekiel 25:6 For thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): Because you have clapped your hands and stamped your feet and rejoiced with all the malice within your soul

against the land of Yisrael,

Ezekiel 25:8 “Thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): Because Moab and Seir said, ‘Behold, the house of Yahudah (Judah) is like all the other nations,’

Ezekiel 25:12 “Thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): Because Edom acted revengefully against the house of Yahudah (Judah) and has grievously offended in taking vengeance on them,

Ezekiel 25:13 therefore thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah), I will stretch out my hand against Edom and cut off from it man and beast. And I will make it desolate; from Teman even to Dedan they shall fall by the sword.

Ezekiel 25:14 And I will lay my vengeance upon Edom by the hand of my people Yisrael, and they shall do in Edom according to my anger and according to my wrath, and they shall know my vengeance, declares Adonai יהוה (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 25:15 “Thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): Because the Philistines acted revengefully and took vengeance with malice of soul to destroy in everlasting hostility.

Ezekiel 25:16 therefore thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah), Behold, I will stretch out my hand against the Philistines, and I will cut off the Cherethites and destroy the rest of the seacoast.

Ezekiel 26:3 therefore thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): Behold, I am against you, O Tyre, and will bring up many nations against you, as the sea brings up its waves.

Ezekiel 26:5 She shall be in the midst of the sea a place for the spreading of nets, for I have spoken, declares Adonai יהוה (Yahuah). And she shall become plunder for the nations,

Ezekiel 26:7 “For thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): Behold, I will bring against Tyre from the north Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, king of kings, with horses and chariots, and with horsemen and a host of many soldiers.

Ezekiel 26:14 I will make you a bare rock. You shall be a place for the spreading of nets. You shall never be rebuilt, for I am יהוה (Yahuah); I have spoken, declares Adonai יהוה (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 26:15 “Thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah) to Tyre: Will not the coastlands shake at the sound of your fall, when the wounded groan, when slaughter is made in your midst?

Ezekiel 26:19 “For thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): When I make you a city laid waste, like the cities that are not inhabited, when I bring up the deep over you, and the great waters cover you,

Ezekiel 26:21 I will bring you to a dreadful end, and you shall be no more. Though you be sought for, you will never be found again, declares Adonai יהוה (Yahuah).”

Ezekiel 27:3 and say to Tyre, who dwells at the entrances to the sea, merchant of the peoples to many coastlands, thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): “O Tyre, you have said, I am perfect in beauty.’

Ezekiel 28:2 “Son of man, say to the prince of Tyre, Thus says Adonai יהוה

(Yahuah): “Because your heart is proud, and you have said, ‘I am a Aluahym (god), I sit in the seat of the Aluahym (gods), in the heart of the seas,’ yet you are but a man, and no Aluahym (god), though you make your heart like the heart of a Aluahym (god).

Ezekiel 28:6 therefore thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): Because you make your heart like the heart of a Auahym (god).

Ezekiel 28:10 You shall die the death of the uncircumcised by the hand of foreigners; for I have spoken, declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah).”

Ezekiel 28:12 “Son of man, raise a lamentation over the king of Tyre, and say to him, Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): “You were the signet of perfection, full of wisdom and perfect in beauty.

Ezekiel 28:22 and say, Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): “Behold, I am against you, O Sidon, and I will manifest my glory in your midst. And they shall know that I am אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah) when I execute judgments in her and manifest my Kadoshness (Holiness) in her;

Ezekiel 28:24 “And for the house of Yisrael there shall be no more a brier to prick or a thorn to hurt them among all their neighbors who have treated them with contempt. Then they will know that I am Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 28:25 “Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): When I gather the house of Yisrael from the peoples among whom they are scattered, and manifest my Kadoshness (Holiness) in them in the sight of the nations, then they shall dwell in their own land that I gave to my servant Yaqoob (Jacob).

Ezekiel 29:3 speak, and say, Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): “Behold, I am against you, Pharaoh king of Mitsriym (Egypt), the great dragon that lies in the midst of his streams, that says, ‘My Nile is my own; I made it for myself.’

Ezekiel 29:8 Therefore thus says the Lord God: Behold, I will bring a sword upon you, and will cut off from you man and beast,

Ezekiel 29:13 “For thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): At the end of forty (40) years I will gather the Egyptians from the peoples among whom they were scattered,

Ezekiel 29:16 And it shall never again be the reliance of the house of Yisrael, recalling their iniquity, when they turn to them for aid. Then they will know that I am Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah).”

Ezekiel 29:19 Therefore thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): Behold, I will give the land of Mitsriym (Egypt) to Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon; and he shall carry off its wealth and despoil it and plunder it; and it shall be the wages for his army.

Ezekiel 29:20 I have given him the land of Mitsriym (Egypt) as his payment for which he labored, because they worked for me, declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 30:2 “Son of man, prophesy, and say, Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): “Wail, ‘Alas for the day!’

Ezekiel 30:6 “Thus says אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): Those who support Mitsriym (Egypt) shall fall, and her proud might shall come down; from Migdol to Syene they shall fall within her by the sword, declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 30:10 “Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): “I will put an end to the wealth of Mitsriym (Egypt), by the hand of Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon.

Ezekiel 30:13 “Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): “I will destroy the idols and put an end to the images in Memphis; there shall no longer be a prince from the land of Mitsriym (Egypt); so I will put fear in the land of Mitsriym (Egypt).

Ezekiel 30:22 Therefore thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): Behold, I am against Pharaoh king of Mitsriym (Egypt) and will break his arms, both the strong arm and the one that was broken, and I will make the sword fall from his hand.

Ezekiel 31:10 “Therefore thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): Because it[towered high and set its top among the clouds, and its heart was proud of its height,

Ezekiel 31:15 “Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): On the day the cedar went down to Sheol I caused mourning; I closed the deep over it, and restrained its rivers, and many waters were stopped. I clothed Lebanon in gloom for it, and all the trees of the field fainted because of it.

Ezekiel 31:18 “Whom are you thus like in glory and in greatness among the trees of Eden? You shall be brought down with the trees of Eden to the world below. You shall lie among the uncircumcised, with those who are slain by the sword. “This is Pharaoh and all his multitude, declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah).”

Ezekiel 32:3 Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): I will throw my net over you with a host of many peoples, and they will haul you up in my dragnet.

Ezekiel 32:8 All the bright lights of Shamyim (Heavens) will I make dark over you, and put darkness on your land, declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 32:11 “For thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): The sword of the king of Babylon shall come upon you.

Ezekiel 32:14 Then I will make their waters clear, and cause their rivers to run like oil, declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 32:16 This is a lamentation that shall be chanted; the daughters of the nations shall chant it; over Mitsriym (Egypt), and over all her multitude, shall they chant it, declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah).”

Ezekiel 32:31 “When Pharaoh sees them, he will be comforted for all his multitude, Pharaoh and all his army, slain by the sword, declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 32:32 For I spread terror in the land of the living; and he shall be laid to rest among the uncircumcised, with those who are slain by the sword, Pharaoh and all his multitude, declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah).”

Ezekiel 33:11 Say to them, As I live, declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah), I have no pleasure in the death of the wicked, but that the wicked turn from his way and live; turn back, turn back from your evil ways, for why will you die, O house of Yisrael?

Ezekiel 33:25 Therefore say to them, Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): You eat flesh with the blood and lift up your eyes to your idols and shed blood; shall you then possess the land?

Ezekiel 33:27 Say this to them, Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): As I live, surely

those who are in the waste places shall fall by the sword, and whoever is in the open field I will give to the beasts to be devoured, and those who are in strongholds and in caves shall die by pestilence.

Ezekiel 34:2 “Son of man, prophesy against the shepherds of Yisrael; prophesy, and say to them, even to the shepherds, Thus says Adonai **אֲדֹנָי** (Yahuah): Ah, shepherds of Yisrael who have been feeding yourselves! Should not shepherds feed the sheep?

Ezekiel 34:8 As I live, declares Adonai **אֲדֹנָי** (Yahuah), surely because my sheep have become a prey, and my sheep have become food for all the wild beasts, since there was no shepherd, and because my shepherds have not searched for my sheep, but the shepherds have fed themselves, and have not fed my sheep, 9 therefore, you shepherds, hear the word of **אֲדֹנָי** (Yahuah):

Ezekiel 34:10 Thus says Adonai **אֲדֹנָי** (Yahuah), Behold, I am against the shepherds, and I will require my sheep at their hand and put a stop to their feeding the sheep. No longer shall the shepherds feed themselves. I will rescue my sheep from their mouths, that they may not be food for them.

Ezekiel 34:11 “For thus says Adonai **אֲדֹנָי** (Yahuah): Behold, I, I myself will search for my sheep and will seek them out.

Ezekiel 34:15 I myself will be the shepherd of my sheep, and I myself will make them lie down, declares Adonai **אֲדֹנָי** (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 34:17 “As for you, my flock, thus says Adonai **אֲדֹנָי** (Yahuah): Behold, I judge between sheep and sheep, between rams and male goats.

Ezekiel 34:20 “Therefore, thus says Adonai **אֲדֹנָי** (Yahuah) to them: Behold, I, I myself will judge between the fat sheep and the lean sheep.

Ezekiel 34:30 And they shall know that I am **אֲדֹנָי** (Yahuah) their Aluahym (God) with them, and that they, the house of Yisrael, are my people, declares Adonai **אֲדֹנָי** (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 34:31 And you are my sheep, human sheep of my pasture, and I am your Aluahym (God), declares Adonai **אֲדֹנָי** (Yahuah).”

Ezekiel 35:3 and say to it, Thus says Adonai **אֲדֹנָי** (Yahuah): Behold, I am against you, Mount Seir, and I will stretch out my hand against you, and I will make you a desolation and a waste.

Ezekiel 35:6 therefore, as I live, declares Adonai **אֲדֹנָי** (Yahuah), I will prepare you for blood, and blood shall pursue you; because you did not hate bloodshed, therefore blood shall pursue you.

Ezekiel 35:11 therefore, as I live, declares Adonai **אֲדֹנָי** (Yahuah), I will deal with you according to the anger and envy that you showed because of your hatred against them. And I will make myself known among them, when I judge you.

Ezekiel 35:14 Thus says Adonai **אֲדֹנָי** (Yahuah): While the whole earth rejoices, I will make you desolate.

Ezekiel 36:2 Thus says Adonai **אֲדֹנָי** (Yahuah): Because the enemy said of you, ‘Aha!’ and, ‘The ancient heights have become our possession,

Ezekiel 36:3 therefore prophesy, and say, Thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): Precisely because they made you desolate and crushed you from all sides, so that you became the possession of the rest of the nations, and you became the talk and evil gossip of the people,

Ezekiel 36:4 therefore, O mountains of Yisrael, hear the word of Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): Thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah) to the mountains and the hills, the ravines and the valleys, the desolate wastes and the deserted cities, which have become a prey and derision to the rest of the nations all around,

Ezekiel 36:5 therefore thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): Surely I have spoken in my hot jealousy against the rest of the nations and against all Edom, who gave my land to themselves as a possession with wholehearted joy and utter contempt, that they might make its pasturelands a prey.

Ezekiel 36:6 Therefore prophesy concerning the land of Yisrael, and say to the mountains and hills, to the ravines and valleys, Thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): Behold, I have spoken in my jealous wrath, because you have suffered the reproach of the nations.

Ezekiel 36:7 Therefore thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): I swear that the nations that are all around you shall themselves suffer reproach.

Ezekiel 36:13 Thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): Because they say to you, 'You devour people, and you bereave your nation of children,'

Ezekiel 36:14 therefore you shall no longer devour people and no longer bereave your nation of children, declares Adonai יהוה (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 36:15 And I will not let you hear anymore the reproach of the nations, and you shall no longer bear the disgrace of the peoples and no longer cause your nation to stumble, declares Adonai יהוה (Yahuah)."

Ezekiel 36:22 "Therefore say to the house of Yisrael, Thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): It is not for your sake, O house of Yisrael, that I am about to act, but for the sake of my Kadosh (Holy) name, which you have profaned among the nations to which you came.

Ezekiel 36:23 And I will vindicate the Kadoshness (Holiness) of my Great Name, which has been profaned among the nations, and which you have profaned (treat (something sacred) with irreverence or disrespect) among them. And the nations will know that I am יהוה (Yahuah), declares Adonai יהוה (Yahuah), when through you I vindicate my Kadoshness (Holiness) before their eyes.

Ezekiel 36:32 It is not for your sake that I will act, declares Adonai יהוה (Yahuah); let that be known to you. Be ashamed and confounded for your ways, O house of Yisrael.

Ezekiel 36:33 "Thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): On the day that I cleanse you from all your iniquities, I will cause the cities to be inhabited, and the waste places shall be rebuilt.

Ezekiel 36:37 "Thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): This also I will let the house of Yisrael ask me to do for them: to increase their people like a flock.

Ezekiel 37:5 Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah) to these bones: Behold, I will cause breath to enter you, and you shall live.

Ezekiel 37:9 Then he said to me, “Prophecy to the breath; prophecy, son of man, and say to the breath, Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): Come from the four (4) winds, O breath, and breathe on these slain, that they may live.”

Ezekiel 37:12 Therefore prophecy, and say to them, Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): Behold, I will open your graves and raise you from your graves, O my people. And I will bring you into the land of Yisrael.

Ezekiel 37:19 say to them, Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): Behold, I am about to take the stick of Yoseph (that is in the hand of Ephraim) and the tribes of Yisrael associated with him. And I will join with it the stick of Yahudah (Judah), and make them one (1) stick, that they may be one (1) in my hand.

Ezekiel 37:21 then say to them, Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): Behold, I will take the people of Yisrael from the nations among which they have gone, and will gather them from all around, and bring them to their own land.

Ezekiel 38:3 and say, Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): Behold, I am against you, O Gog, chief prince of Meshech and Tubal.

Ezekiel 38:10 “Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): On that day, thoughts will come into your mind, and you will devise an evil scheme

Ezekiel 38:14 “Therefore, son of man, prophecy, and say to Gog, Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): On that day when my people Yisrael are dwelling securely, will you not know it?

Ezekiel 38:17 “Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): Are you he of whom I spoke in former days by my servants the prophets of Yisrael, who in those days prophesied for years that I would bring you against them?

Ezekiel 38:18 But on that day, the day that Gog shall come against the land of Yisrael, declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah), my wrath will be roused in my anger.

Ezekiel 38:21 I will summon a sword against Gog on all my mountains, declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah). Every man's sword will be against his brother.

Ezekiel 39:1 “And you, son of man, prophecy against Gog and say, Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): Behold, I am against you, O Gog, chief prince of Meshech and Tubal.

Ezekiel 39:5 You shall fall in the open field, for I have spoken, declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 39:8 Behold, it is coming and it will be brought about, declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah). That is the day of which I have spoken.

Ezekiel 39:10 so that they will not need to take wood out of the field or cut down any out of the forests, for they will make their fires of the weapons. They will seize the spoil of those who despoiled them, and plunder those who plundered them, declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 39:13 All the people of the land will bury them, and it will bring them

renown on the day that I show my glory, declares Adonai יהוה (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 39:17 “As for you, son of man, thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): Speak to the birds of every sort and to all beasts of the field: ‘Assemble and come, gather from all around to the sacrificial feast that I am preparing for you, a great sacrificial feast on the mountains of Yisrael, and you shall eat flesh and drink blood.

Ezekiel 39:20 And you shall be filled at my table with horses and charioteers, with mighty men and all kinds of warriors,’ declares Adonai יהוה (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 39:25 “Therefore thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): Now I will restore the fortunes of Yaaqob (Jacob) and have mercy on the whole house of Yisrael, and I will be jealous for my Kadosh (Holy) Name.

Ezekiel 39:29 And I will not hide my face anymore from them, when I pour out my Ruach (Spirit) upon the house of Yisrael, declares Adonai יהוה (Yahuah).”

Ezekiel 43:18 And he said to me, “Son of man, thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): These are the ordinances for the altar: On the day when it is erected for offering burnt offerings upon it and for throwing blood against it,

Ezekiel 43:19 you shall give to the Levitical priests of the family of Zadok, who draw near to me to minister to me, declares Adonai יהוה (Yahuah), a bull from the herd for a Sin offering.

Ezekiel 43:27 And when they have completed these days, then from the eighth (8th) day onward the priests shall offer on the altar your burnt offerings and your Shalum (Peace) offerings, and I will accept you, declares Adonai יהוה (Yahuah).”

Ezekiel 44:6 And say to the rebellious house, to the house of Yisrael, Thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): O house of Yisrael, enough of all your abominations,

Ezekiel 44:9 “Thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): No foreigner, uncircumcised in heart and flesh, of all the foreigners who are among the people of Yisrael, shall enter my sanctuary.

Ezekiel 44:12 Because they ministered to them before their idols and became a stumbling block of iniquity to the house of Yisrael, therefore I have sworn concerning them, declares Adonai יהוה (Yahuah), and they shall bear their punishment.

Ezekiel 44:15 “But the Levitical priests, the sons of Zadok, who kept the charge of my sanctuary when the people of Yisrael went astray from me, shall come near to me to minister to me. And they shall stand before me to offer me the fat and the blood, declares Adonai יהוה (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 44:27 And on the day that he goes into the Kadosh (Holy) Place, into the inner court, to minister in the Kadosh (Holy) Place, he shall offer his Sin offering, declares Adonai יהוה (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 45:9 “Thus says Adonai יהוה (Yahuah): Enough, O princes of Yisrael! Put away violence and oppression, and execute justice and righteousness. Cease your evictions of my people, declares Adonai יהוה (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 45:15 And one (1) sheep from every flock of two (200) hundred, from the watering places of Yisrael for grain offering, burnt offering, and Shalum (Peace)

offerings, to make atonement for them, declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 45:18 “Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): In the first (1st) month, on the first (1st) day of the month, you shall take a bull from the herd without blemish, and purify the sanctuary.

Ezekiel 46:1 “Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): The gate of the inner court that faces east shall be shut on the six (6) working days, but on the Sabbath day it shall be opened, and on the day of the new moon it shall be opened.

Ezekiel 46:16 “Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): If the prince makes a gift to any of his sons as his inheritance, it shall belong to his sons. It is their property by inheritance.

Ezekiel 47:13 Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): “This is the boundary by which you shall divide the land for inheritance among the twelve (12) tribes of Yisrael.

Ezekiel 47:23 In whatever tribe the sojourner resides, there you shall assign him his inheritance, declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah).

Ezekiel 48:29 This is the land that you shall allot as an inheritance among the tribes of Yisrael, and these are their portions, declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah).

Daniel 9:3 Then I turned my face to Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah), seeking him by prayer and pleas for mercy with fasting and sackcloth and ashes.

Hosea 12:5 אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah), Aluhe (The God) of hosts, אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah) is his memorial name:

Amos 1:8 I will cut off the inhabitants from Ashdod, and him who holds the scepter from Ashkelon; I will turn my hand against Ekron, and the remnant of the Philistines shall perish,” says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah).

Amos 3:7 “For Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah) does nothing without revealing his secret to his servants the prophets.

Amos 3:8 The lion has roared; who will not fear? Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah) has spoken; who can but prophesy?”

Amos 3:11 Therefore thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): “An adversary shall surround the land and bring down your defenses from you, and your strongholds shall be plundered.”

Amos 3:13 “Hear, and testify against the house of Yaaqob (Jacob),” declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah), Aluhe (The God) of hosts.

Amos 4:2 Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah) has sworn by his Kadoshness (Holiness) that, behold, the days are coming upon you, when they shall take you away with hooks, even the last of you with fishhooks.

Amos 4:5 offer a sacrifice of thanksgiving of that which is leavened, and proclaim freewill offerings, publish them; for so you love to do, O people of Yisrael!” declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah).

Amos 5:3 For thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah): “The city that went out a thousand shall have a hundred left, and that which went out a hundred shall have ten left to the house of Ysrael.”

Amos 5:15 Hate the evil, and love the good, and establish judgment in the gate: it may be that Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah) of hosts will be gracious unto the remnant of Yoseph.

Amos 6:8 Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah) has sworn by himself, declares אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah), Aluhe (The God) of hosts: “I abhor the pride of Yaaqob (Jacob) and hate his strongholds, and I will deliver up the city and all that is in it.”

Amos 7:1 This is what Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah) showed me: behold, he was forming locusts when the latter growth was just beginning to sprout, and behold, it was the latter growth after the king’s mowings.

Amos 7:4 This is what Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah) showed me: behold, Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah) was calling for a judgment by fire, and it devoured the great deep and was eating up the land.

Amos 7:6 אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah) relented concerning this: “This also shall not be,” said Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah).

Amos 8:1 This is what Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah) showed me: behold, a basket of summer fruit.

Amos 8:3 The songs of the temple shall become wailings in that day,” declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah). “So many dead bodies!” “They are thrown everywhere!” “Silence!”

Amos 8:9 “And on that day,” declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah), “I will make the sun go down at noon and darken the earth in broad daylight.

Amos 8:11 “Behold, the days are coming,” declares Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah), “when I will send a famine on the land— not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the Words of אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah).

Amos 9:5 אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah) Aluhe (The God) of hosts, he who touches the earth and it melts, and all who dwell in it mourn, and all of it rises like the Nile, and sinks again, like the Nile of Mitsriym (Egypt);

Amos 9:8 Behold, the eyes of Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah) are upon the sinful kingdom, and I will destroy it from the surface of the ground, except that I will not utterly destroy the house of Yaaqob (Jacob),” declares אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah).

Obadiah 1:1 The vision of Obadiah. Thus says Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah) concerning Edom: We have heard a report from אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah), and a messenger has been sent among the nations: “Rise up! Let us rise against her for battle!”

Jonah 4:6 Now Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah) appointed a plant and made it come up over Yonah, that it might be a shade over his head, to save him from his discomfort. So Yonah was exceedingly glad because of the plant.

Micah 1:2 Hear, you peoples, all of you; pay attention, O earth, and all that is in it, and let Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah) be a witness against you, אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah) from his Kadosh (Holy) temple.

Habakkuk 3:19 אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah) Adonai, is my strength; he makes my feet like the deer’s; he makes me tread on my high places.

Zephaniah 1:7 Be silent before Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah)! For the day of אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah) is near; אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah) has prepared a sacrifice and consecrated his guests.

Zechariah 9:14 Then אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah) will appear over them, and his arrow will go forth like lightning; Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah) will sound the Shofar (trumpet) and will march forth in the whirlwinds of the south.

Luke 1:32 He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. And Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah) will give to him the throne of his father David,

Luke 1:68 “Baruch (Blessed) be Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah) of Yisrael, for he has visited and redeemed his people

1 Peter 3:15 but in your hearts honor Mashiach Adon as Kadosh (Holy), always being prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you; yet do it with gentleness and respect,

Revelation 18:8 For this reason her plagues will come in a single day, death and mourning and famine, and she will be burned up with fire; for mighty is Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah) who has judged her.”

Revelation 19:6 Then I heard what seemed to be the voice of a great multitude, like the roar of many waters and like the sound of mighty peals of thunder, crying out, “HalluYah! For אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah) our Aluah (God) the Almighty reigns.

Revelation 21:22 And I saw no temple in the city, for its temple is Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah) the Almighty and the Lamb.

Revelation 22:5 And night will be no more. They will need no light of lamp or sun, for Adonai אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah) will be their light, and they will reign forever and ever.

Revelation 22:6 And he said to me, “These words are trustworthy and true. And אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah), the Aluahym (God) of the Ruachs (Spirits) of the prophets, has sent his Malak (Angel) to show his servants what must soon take place.”

Now you have heard from אֲדֹנָי (Yahuah), now consider what he is saying to you today. What he has declared in his Word has not changed, thus it remains! Shalum
