Biblical Name	History	
Aaron (Aharon) אַהֲרֹן (אהרון)	Aaron, the high priest, was Moses's brother.	
Abi (Avi) אַבִּי	Abi, or Abijah, was the mother of Hezekiah, the king of Judah.	
Abiasaph (Aviasaf, Avi'asaf) אַבִּיאֶסָף	Abiasaph was one of Korah's sons.	
Abiathar (Evyatar) אַבִּיָּתָר	Abiathar, the son of Ahimelech, was one of King David's priests.	
Abidan (Avidan) אַבִּידָן	Abidan was the captain of the tribe of Benjamin.	
Abiel (Aviel, Avi'el) אַבְיֵאל	There are two people in the Bible called Abiel. One of them is King Saul's grandfather.	
Abiezer (Aviezer, Avi'ezer) אַבִּיעֶזֶר	There are several men in the Bible called Abiezer. One of them is an offspring of Manasseh.	
Abigail (Avigayil) אַבִּיגַיִל	Abigail was Nabal's wife, and after her husband's death – one of King David's wives.	
Abihail (Avihayil, Avichayil) אַבִּיחַיִל	There are several men in the Bible called Abihail. One of them is Queen Esther's father.	
abihu (Avihu) אַבִּיהוּ (אַבִּיהוּא)	Abihu was one of Aaron's sons.	
Abijah (Aviya, Aviyah, Abiah) אַבִּיָּה	There are different people in the Bible called Abijah. One of them is the second son of the prophet Samuel; another one - Abijah the son of Jeroboam - was the king of Judah; and another one - Abijah the son of Rehoboam - was the king of Israel. There is also one woman called Abijah: the mother of Hezekiah, the king of Judah.	
Abimelech (Avimelech) אַבִּימֶלֶךְ	There are several people in the Bible called Abimelech. One of them is Abimelech king of Gerar.	
Abinadab (Avinadav) אַבִּינָדָב	There are several men in the Bible called Abinadab. One of them is one of King Saul's sons.	
Abinoam (Avinoam, Avinoam) אַבִּינוֹעַם (אַבִּינוֹעַם)	Abinoam was the father of Barak, judge of Israel.	
Abiram (Aviram) אַבִּירָם	There are two people in the Bible called Abiram. One of them is a man of the tribe of Reuben.	
Abishag (Avishag) אַבִּישָׁג	Abishag was King David's personal servant.	
Abishai (Avishai, Avshai)	Abishai, the son of Zeruah, David's sister, was one of King David's heroes.

Abishalom (Avishalom) אַבִּישָׁלֹם	The name "Abishalom" is a version of the name "Absalom". Abishalom was the father of Maachah, King Rehoboam's wife.	
Abital (Avital) אַבִּיטָל	Abital was one of King David's wives.	
Abner (Avner) אַבְנֵר	Abner son of Ner was King Saul's captain of host.	
Abraham (Avraham) אַבְרָהָם	The name of the first of the "three fathers" of the Jewish people. Originally, he was called "Abram". His name was altered to "Abraham" by God who spoke to him. He was Sarah's husband.	
Absalom (Avshalom) אַבְשָׁלוֹם	Absalom was one of King David's sons.	
Adah (Ada) אֲדָה	There are two women in the Bible called Adah. One of them is the wife of Lamech, Cain's offspring. The other one is Esau's wife.	
Adam אָדָם	Adam was the name of the first man created by God. Eve's husband.	
Addar (Adar) אַדָר	Addar was one of Benjamin's offspring.	
Adiel (Adi'el) אֲדִיאֵל	There are several people in the Bible called Adiel. One of them is the father of one of the priests.	
Adin אֲדִין	One of the people who returned from Babylon to Israel at the time of Ezra and Nehemiah.	
Ahiezer (Ahi'ezer) אַחִיעֶזֶר	There are two men in the Bible called Ahiezer. One of them is the captain of the tribe of Dan.	
Ahijah (Ahiya, Ahiyah, Achiya, Achiyah) אַחִיָּה	There are several people in the Bible called Ahijah. One of them was a prophet in the time of King Jeroboam.	
Ahinadab (Ahinadav) אַחִינָדָב	Ahinadab is the name of one of the twelve officers of King Solomon.	
Ahinoam (Achinoam, Achino'am) אַחִינוֹעַם (אַחִינוֹעַם)	There are two women in the Bible called Ahinoam: the first one is King Saul's wife, and the second – one of King David's wives.	
Alon (Allon) אֵלוֹן	One of Simeon's descendants.	
Amaziah (Amatzia, Amatsya) אַמְצִיָּה (אַמְצִיָּהוּ)	There are several people in the Bible called Amaziah. One of them is Amaziah, the son of Jehoash, the king of Judah.	
Amittai (Amitay) אַמִּתַּי	The name of the father of Jonah, the prophet.	
Ammiel (Amiel, Ami'el) עַמִּיאֵל	There are several people in the Bible called "Ammiel". One of them is one of the twelve people sent by Moses to search the land of Canaan.	
Amminadab (Aminadav)	There are a few people in the Bible called Amminadab. One of them is the father in law of Aaron, the high priest.

Amnon אַמְנוֹן	There are two people in the Bible called Amnon. One of them is King David's elder son.	
Amos עָמוֹס	Amos was one of the prophets of Israel.	
Amoz (Amotz, Amots) אַמוֹץ	Amoz was the father of Isaiah the prophet.	
Amram עֲמֵרָם	There are two people in the Bible called Amram. One of them is the father of Moses and Aaron.	
Anath (Anat) עֲנַת	The name of the father of Shamgar, one of Israel's Judges. This is also the name of the goddess of war and fertility in the ancient Middle East.	
Aner עֵנֶר	Aner is the name of a man who was Abraham's ally.	
Aram אַרָּם	There are several men in the Bible called Aram. One of them is one of the sons of Shem, Noah's son.	
Ariel (Ari'el) אַרְיֵאל	Ariel was the name of a man contemporary with Ezra. This is also one of Jerusalem's appellations, as attested in the verse: "Woe to Ariel, to Ariel, the city where David dwelt." Isaiah 29, 1.	
Asa אַסָּא	There are two people in the Bible called Asa. One of them was a king in Judah.	
Asahel (Asael, Asa'el) אַשָּׁחָאֵל	There are several people in the Bible called "Asahel". One of them is the brother of Joab son of Zeruiah, King David's captain of the host.	
Asaph (Asaf) אַסָּף	There are several people called Asaph in the Bible. One of them is a poet of the Levites of the time of King David.	
Asenath (Asnat, Osnat) אַסְנַת	The name of Joseph's wife.	
Asher אַשֶׁר	"Asher" is the name of one of Jacob's son, as well as the name of his tribe.	
Atarah (Atara) אַטָּרָה	Atarah was the wife of Jerahmeel, one of Judah's offspring.

Athaliah (Atalya, Atalia) אַתְלִיָּה	Athaliah, the mother of Ahaziah, was the queen of Judah. There are also two men in the Bible called Athaliah.	
Aviad (Avi'ad) אַבְיָעַד	This is one of the appellations given to the Messiah by the prophet Isaiah.	
Aya (Aiah) אַיָּה	There are two men in the Bible called Aya. One of them is the father of Rizpa, King Saul's concubine.	
Azareel (Azarel, Azar'el) אַזָּרְעֵל	There are several people in the Bible called "Azareel". One of them is one of King David's heros.	
Azariah (Azaria, Azarya) אַזָּרְיָה	There are several people in the Bible called "Azariah". "Azariah" is an alternative name of Uzziah, the king of Judah.	
Azriel (Azri'el) אַזְרִיֵּאל	There are several people in the Bible called "Azriel". One of them is a person of the tribe of Manasseh.	
Barak בָּרַק	A captain of the army of Israel in the time of Deborah the prophetess. He fought against Sisera, the Captain of Jabin, King of Canaan.

Baruch בָּרוּךְ	A scribe of the time of Jeremiah the prophet.	
Bashemath (Basmat, Bosmat) בַּשְׁמַת	Bashemath is the name of one of Esau's wives; this is also the name of one of King Solomon's daughters.	
Bath-Sheba (Bat-Sheva) בַּת-שֶׁבַע	Bath-Sheba, Uriah's wife, later became King David's wife. She was King Solomon's mother.	
Beeri (Be'eri) בְּעָרִי	There are two people in the Bible called Beeri. One of them is the father of the prophet Hosea.	
Ben בֶּן	A name of one of the porters from the Levites in King David's time.	
Benaiah (Bnaya) בְּנַיָּהוּ	There are several people in the Bible called Benaiah. One of them was one of the heroes of King David.	
Benammi (Ben-Ammi, Ben-Ami) בֶּן-עַמְמִי	Benammi, Lot's son, is the ancient father of the people of Ammon.	
Benjamin (Binyamin) בִּנְיָמִין	The youngest son of Jacob and Rachel.	
Bezaleel (Betsalel, Betsal'el) בְּצַלְאֵל	Bezaleel was the artisan who constructed the Tabernacle as well as its appliances.	
Billhah (Billha) בִּלְהָה	Billhah was Rachel's maid and Jacob's mistress.	
Bithyah (Bitya) בִּתְיָהָה	Bithyah was the daughter of Pharaoh.	
Boaz (Bo'az) בועז (בועז)	The second husband of Ruth the Moabitess. The father of King David's grandfather.	
Bracha (Berachah) בְּרַכָּה	Berachah was one of King David's heroes.	
Bukki (Buki) בֻּקִי (בוקי)	There are two men in the Bible called Bukki. One of them is an offspring of Aaron the priest.	
Canaan (Knaan, Kna'an) כְּנַעַן	Canaan was the son of Ham, the son of Noah.	
Carmela (Karmela) כַּרְמֶלָה	Carmel is the name of a mountain ridge where the city of Haifa is located today. The prophet Elijah: "So Ahab sent unto all the children of Israel, and gathered the prophets together unto mount Carmel." 1 Kings 18,20	
Dan דָּן	Dan was one of Jacob's son. One of the twelve tribes is named after him.	
Daniel דָּנִיֵּאל	There are several men called Daniel in the Bible. One of them is a wise person of the time when Nebuchadnezzar, king of Babylon, reigned in Jerusalem.	
David דָּוִד (דויד)	David son of Jesse (Yishai) was Israel's second king and King Solomon's father. He occupied Jerusalem and made it his capital. According to tradition, the Messiah is going to be of his seed.	
Debir (Dvir) דְּבִיר	Debir is the name of a city in Judah. It is also the name of the King of Eglon in Joshua's time.	
Deborah (Dvora) דְּבוֹרָה	There are two women in the Bible named Deborah. One of them is the prophetess Deborah.	
Diklah (Dikla) דִּקְלָה	Diklah is an offspring of Shem, the son of Noah.

Dinah (Dina) דינה	Dinah was the daughter of Jacob and Leah.	
Eden עדן	Eden is the place where God planted a garden for Adam and Eve; this is also the name of a Levite of the time of Hezekiah, king of Judah; this is also one of the names given to Jerusalem.	
Ehud אהוד	Ehud, son of Gera, was one of the judges of Israel, who killed Eglon, the king of Moab.	
Elah (Ela) אלה	There are different people in the Bible called Elah. One of them - the son of Baasha - was the king of Israel.	
Elam (Eilam) עילם	There are several men in the Bible called Elam. One of them is one of the sons of Shem, Noah's son.	
Eldad אלדד	The name of a person of the time when the Israelites wandered in the desert.	
Elead (Elad, El'ad) אלעד	Elead was one of Ephraim's sons.	
Eleazar (Elazar, El'azar) אלעזר	There are several people in the Bible called Eleazar. One of them is one of the sons of Aaron, the high priest.	
Elhanan (Elchanan) אלחנן	Two of King David's heroes are called Elhanan.	
Eli (2) עלי	Eli is the name of a high priest in Shiloh.	
Eliab (Eliav, Eli'av) אליאב	There are several men in the Bible called Eliab. One of them is the captain of the tribe of Zebulun.	
Eliada (Elyada) אליאדע	There are several men in the Bible called Eliada. One of them is one of King David's sons.	
Eliel (Eli'el) אליאל	There are several men in the Bible called Eliel. This was the name of a few of King David's heroes.	
Eliezer (Eli'ezer) אליעזר	There are several people in the Bible called Eliezer, one of which is Moses' son.	
Elijah (Eliyahu) אליהו	Elijah the Tishbite was a prophet in Israel in the time of King Ahab.	
Elimelech אלימלך	Naomi's husband, and Ruth's father in law.	
Elisha אלישע	Elisha the son of Shaphat was one of the prophets of Israel.	
Elisheba (Elisheva) אלישבע	Elisheva was the wife of Aaron, the high priest.	
Elizur (Elitzur, Elitsur) אליצור	Elizur was the captain of the tribe of Reuben.	
Elkanah (Elkana) אלקנה	There are several men in the Bible called Elkanah. One of them is the father of Samuel the prophet.	
Elnathan (Elnatan) אלנתן	There are several men in the Bible called Elnathan. One of them is an army leader of King Jehoiakim.

Elon (Eylon, Eilon) אילון	There are two people in the Bible called Elon. One of them was a Judge of Israel.	
Enan (Einan) עיןן	Enan was the father of the captain of the tribe of Naphtali.	
Enoch (Chanoch) חנוך	There are few people in the Bible called Enoch. The first of them is Cain's son.

Ephraim (Efrayim, Efra'im) אֶפְרַיִם	Ephraim was Joseph's second son; the tribe of Ephraim is called after his name.	
Ephrath (Efrat) אֶפְרַת	Ephrath was the wife of Caleb, the son of Hezron, Judah's offspring.	
Eran עֵרָן	Eran is the name of a man of the tribe of Ephraim.	
Eshcol (Eshkol) אֶשְׁכּוֹל	Eshcol is the name of a man who was Abraham's ally.	
Esther (Ester) אֶסְתֵּר	Queen Esther was King Ahasuerus's wife.	
Ethan (Eitan, Eytan) אֵיתָן	There are several people in the Bible called Ethan. One of them is one of the wise men of King Solomon's time.	
Eve (Chava, Hava) חַוָּה	Eve was the first woman created by God. Adam's wife.	
Ezekiel (Yehezkel, Yechezkel) יְחִזְקִאל	There are two people in the Bible called Ezekiel. One of them is the prophet Ezekiel the priest, son of Buzi.	
Ezer עֶזֶר	There are several people in the Bible called Ezer. One of them was a hero of King David.	
Ezra עֲזָרָא	There are several people by this name in the Bible. One of them is Ezra the scribe, an offspring of Aaron the high priest, who immigrated from Babylon to Jerusalem during the time of the Persian Empire.	
Ezri עֶזְרִי	"Ezri" is the name of a minister at the time of King David.	
Gabriel (Gavriel, Gavri'el) גַּבְרִיאֵל	A name of an angel who appeared in Daniel's vision.	
Gad גָּד	There are two people in the Bible called Gad. One of them is one of Jacob's sons, the father of one of the twelve tribes.	
Gamaliel (Gamliel) גַּמְלִיאֵל	Gamaliel was the leader of the tribe of Manasseh.	
Gedaliah (Gedalya, Gdalya) גְּדַלְיָה	Gedaliah was the grandfather of the prophet Zephaniah.	
Gera גֵּרָא	There are several people in the Bible called Gera. One of them is the father of Ehud, the judge of Israel.	
Gershom גֵּרְשׁוֹם (גֵּרְשֹׁם)	There are several people in the Bible called Geshom. One of them is the elder son of Moses. Another is the elder son of Levi son of Jacob.	
Gershon גֵּרְשׁוֹן	Gershon (or: Gershom) is the name of the elder son of Levi son of Jacob.	
Gideon (Gidon, Gid'on) גִּדְעוֹן	One of Israel's judges. He fought against the Midianites.	
Gilead (Gilad, Gil'ad) גִּלְעָד	There are two people in the Bible called Gilead. One of them is the father of Jephthah, one of the judges of Israel. Gilead is also the name of a Geographical region east to the Jordan river and a name of a city in that region.	
Ginath (Ginat) גִּינַת	Ginath was the father of Tibni, who almost became the king of Israel.	
Guni גֻּנִי	There are several men in the Bible called Guni. One of them is one of Naphtali's sons.	
Hadassah (Hadasa) חַדְסָה	Hadassah is the first name of Queen Esther, King Ahasuerus's wife.	
Hagar חַגָּר	Hagar, Sarah's Egyptian maid, was Ishmael's mother.

Haggai (Chagai) חגי	Haggai was one of the prophets of the return to Zion. He carried God's order to build the Second Temple.	
Haggith (Chagit) חגיית	Haggith was one of King David's wives.	
Hamutal (Chamutal) חמוטל	Hamutal was the wife of King Josiah and the mother of King Jehoahaz.	
Hanan (Chanan) חנן	There are few people called Hanan in the Bible. One of them of one of King David's heros.	
Hannah (Chana) חנה	Hannah was Elkanah's wife and the mother of the prophet Samuel.	
Harel (Har'el) הרצל	In the Jewish tradition, Harel is one of the names of Jerusalem.	
Hen (Chen) חן	Hen is the name of one of the immigrants from Babylon.	
Hepher (Hefer, Chefer) חפר	There are several men in the Bible called Hepher. One of them is one of King David's heros.	
Hephzi-bah (Hefziba, Heftziba) חפצי-בה		
Hezekiah (Hizkiya, Chizkiya) חזקיהו	There are several people in the Bible called Hezekiah. One of them is Hezekiah the son of Ahaz, king of Judah.	
Hiddai (Hidai, Hiday) חידאי	Hiddai was one of King David's heros.	
Hillel (Hilel) הלל	Hillel is the name of the father of Abdon, one of Israel's judges. This is also the name of "Hillel the Elder", the head of Sanhedrin ("The Assembly") in the first century C.E. He is the founder of the Beit Hillel ("House of Hillel") tradition, which is paired with the Beit Shammai tradition.	
Hobab (Hovav, Chovav) חובב	Hobab was the son of Raguel, Moses' father in law.	
Hosea (Hoshea, Hosh'e'a) הושע	There are several men in the Bible called Hosea. One of them is the prophet Hosea.	
Huldah (Hulda, Chulda) חולדה	Huldah was a prophetess in the time of King Josiah.	
Ibri (Ivri) עברי	Ibri is the name of one of Levi's offspring.	
Iddo (Ido) אידו	Iddo was a man of the time of Ezra.	
Iddo (Ido) עידו, עדוא, עידו	There are several people called Iddo in the Bible. One of them is the prophet Zechariah's grandfather.	
Ilai (1) (Ilay) עילאי	Ilai was one of the heros of King David.	
Immanuel (Emanuel, Imanuel, Imanu'el)	According to the words of Isaiah the prophet, Immanuel is the name of a boy whose birth shall be a sign from God.

Isaac (Yitschak) יִצְחָק	The name of the second of the "three fathers" of the Jewish people. He was born to Abraham and Sarah when they were already old. His wife was Rebekah.	♂
Isaiah (Yeshaaya, Yeshaayah) יִשְׁעִיָּהוּ	There are several people in the Bible called Isaiah. One of them is the prophet Isaiah son of Amoz.	♂
Ishi (Yishi, Yish'i) יִשְׁעִי	There are several people in the Bible called "Ishi". One of them is a man of the tribe of Judah.	♂

Israel (Yisrael, Yisra'el) יִשְׂרָאֵל	"Israel" is the name given to Jacob after he wrestled with God's angel; it is also the name of the Biblical kingdom of Israel, the land of Israel, the people of Israel and the modern state of Israel.	♂
Issachar (Yisachar) יִשָּׁשְׁכָר	Issachar was the fifth son of Jacob and Leah; the tribe of Issachar is called after him.	♂
Ithamar (Itamar, I'tamar) אִיתָמָר	Ithamar was one of the sons of Aaron, the high priest.	♂
Ithiel (Itiel, Iti'el) אִיתֵיֵל	There are two men in the Bible called Ithiel. One of them is a sage who is mentioned in the book of "Proverbs".	♂
Ittai (Itay) אִתַּי	This was the name of one of King David's friends (2 Samuel 15, 19-22). It was also the name of one of King David's heros (2 Samuel 23, 29).	♂
Izhar (Yitzhar) יִצְהָר	Izhar was Levi's grandson and Korah's father.	♂
Jaakobah (Yaakova, Ya'akova) יַעֲקֹבָה	Jaakobah was an offspring of Simeon.	♀
Jabin (Yavin) יָבִין	Jabin is the name of two of Hazor's kings.	♂
Jachin (Yachin) יָכִין	There are two people in the Bible called "Jachin". One of them is one of Simeon's sons. The other one is a priest of the time of Nehemiah.	♂
Jacob (Yaakov, Ya'akov) יַעֲקֹב	The name of the third of the "three fathers" of the Jewish people. He was also called "Israel". His wives were Leah and Rachel.	♂
Jael (Yael, Ya'el) יַעֲל	Jael was the woman who killed Sisera, the commander of Jabin's (king of Canaan) army.	♀
Jair (Yair, Ya'ir) יָאִיר	There are three people called Jair in the Bible: one is the son of Manasseh, son of Joseph; the second is one of the judges of Israel; and the third is Mordecai's father.	♂
Jarah (Yaara, Ya'ara) יָעָרָה	"Jarah" is the name of one of the offsprings of Jonathan son of King Saul.	♀
Jarib (Yariv) יָרִיב	There are three different people in the Bible called Jarib. One of them is a man contemporary with Ezra.	♂
Jedidah (Yedida) יְדִידָה	Jedidah was the mother of Josiah, the king of Judah.	♀
Jedidiah (Yedidia, Yedidya) יְדִידְיָהּ	"Jedidiah" is the name that Nathan the prophet gave to King Solomon when he was born.	♂
Jehiel (Yehiel, Yechiel, Yechi'el) יְחִיֵּאל	There are several people in the Bible called "Jehiel". Some of them are Levites.	♂
Jehoiachin (Yehoyachin, Yoyachin) יְהוֹיָכִין	Jehoiachin, the son of Jehoiakim, was one of Judea's kings.	♂

Jehoiada (Yehoyada) יְהוֹיָדָע	There are several people in the Bible called "Jehoiada". One of them is Jehoiada the priest, the brother in law of Ahaziah, the king of Judah.	
Jehonadab (Yehonadav, Yonadav)	There are two people in the Bible called "Jehonadab". One of them is Jehonadab, the son of Rechab, who helped Jehu, the king of Israel, to establish his reign and to fight the priests of Baal.	
Jehoshaphat (Yehoshafat, Yoshafat)	There are several people in the Bible called "Jehoshaphat". One of them was the king of Judea.

Jemima (Yemima) יְמִימָה	"Jemima" is the name of one of Job's daughters.	
Jephthah (Yiftach) יִפְתָּח	One of the judges of Israel, who fought against Ammon.

Jerahmeel (Yerahmiel, Yerahmi'el)	There are several people in the Bible called Jerahmeel. One of them is one of Judah's offspring. Later on in history, the pronunciation of this name changed to "יֶרְחֵמְיָאֵל".

Jeremiah (Yirmiya, Yirmiyahu)	There are several people in the Bible called Jeremiah. One of them is the prophet Jeremiah the son of Hilkiah.

Jeroham (Yeroham, Yeruham, Yerucham)	One of the people in the Bible called Jeroham was the grandfather of Samuel the prophet.	
יֶרֶחָם (ירחם)		
Jesse (Yishai) יֵשָׁע	Jesse, the grandson of Boaz and Ruth, is King David's father.	
Jesurun (Yeshurun) יֵשׁוּרוּן (ישורון)	Jesurun is another name for the people of Israel.	
Joab (Yoav, Yo'av) יֹאָב	There are several people in the Bible called Joab. One of them is Joab son of Zeruiah, King David's captain of the host.	
Joash (Jehoash, Yoash, Yo'ash)	There are several people in the Bible called "Joahs" or "Jehoash". Among them are the king of Judah and the king of Israel.

Jobab (Yovav) יֹבָב	There are several people in the Bible called "Jobab". One of them was a decendent of Shem, the son of Noah.
