

Promises with Instructions

He has remembered his covenant for ever, the promise which he commanded to a thousand generations. **9** Which covenant he made with Abraham, and his oath unto Yitshaq (Isaac); **10** And confirmed the same unto Yaqoob (Jacob) for a statute (choq 2706: something prescribed or owed, a statute), and to Yasharal (Israel) for an everlasting covenant. **Psalm 105:8-10**

He remembers his covenant forever, the promise he made, for a thousand generations, **16** the covenant he made with Abraham, the oath he swore to Yitshaq (Isaac). **17** He confirmed it to Yaqoob (Jacob) as a decree, to Yasharal (Israel) as an everlasting covenant. **1 Chronicles 16:15-17**

Promises / Instructions

James 4:8 - "Come near to אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) and he will come near to you."

James 4:10 - "Humble yourselves before אַיָּהּ (Yahuah), and he will lift you up."

1 John 1:9 - "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness."

Romans 10:9 - "If you confess with your mouth, "אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahusha) is Mashiach," and believe in your heart that אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) raised him from the dead, you will be saved."

Psalm 50:15 - "and call upon me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you will honor me."

James 1:5 - "If any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask אַיָּהּ (Yahuah), who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to him."

Deuteronomy 31:8 - "אַיָּהּ (Yahuah)" himself goes before you and will be with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged."

Psalm 32:8-9 - "I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you and watch over you."**9** Do not be like the horse or like the mule, Which have no understanding, Which must be harnessed with bit and bridle, Else they will not come near you.

Matthew 6:14-15 - "For if you forgive men when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive men their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins."

Luke 6:35 - "But love your enemies, do good to them, and lend to them without expecting to get anything back. Then your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High, because he is kind to the ungrateful and wicked."

John 3:16 - "For אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life."

Luke 12:31 - "But seek his kingdom, and these things will be given to you as well."

John 5:14-15 - "This is the confidence we have in approaching אַיָּהּ (Yahuah): that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. And if we know that he hears us-- whatever we ask-- we know that we have what we asked of him."

Psalm 86:7 In the day of my trouble I will call upon You: for You will answer me.

Psalm 91:15 He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him and honor him.

Psalm 107:6 Then they cried to אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) in their trouble, and He delivered them out of their distresses.

Matthew 7:7,8 Ask and it shall be given you; seek and you shall find; knock and it shall be opened to you: For everyone that asks receives; and he that seeks finds; and to him that knocks it shall be opened.

Matthew 21:22 And all things, whatsoever you shall ask in prayer, believing, you shall receive.

John 14:13,14 And whatsoever you shall ask in My Name (Yahusha), that will I do, that the Father (Yahuah) may be glorified in the Son (Yahusha). If you shall ask any thing in My Name, I will do it.

Hebrews 11:6 But without Amunah (Faith) it is impossible to please אַיָּהּ (Yahuah): for he that comes to אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him.

1John 5:14,15 And this is the confidence that we have in Him, that, if we ask any thing according to His will, He hears us: And if we know that He hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of Him.

Genesis 15:6 And he believed in אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) and He accounted it to him for righteousness

2 Chronicles 20:20 “Hear me, O Yahudah and you inhabitants of Yarusalym (Jerusalem): Believe in אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) your Aluhym, and you shall be established; believe His prophets, and you shall prosper.”

Mark 9:23 אַיָּהּ (Yahusha) said to him, “If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes.”

Mark 11:23 For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, ‘Be removed and be cast into the sea,’ and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says.

Mark 11:24 Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them.

Mark 16:16 He who believes and is immersed (baptized) will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned.

Mark 16:17-19 And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; ¹⁸ they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.”

John 3:16 For אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son אַיָּהּ (Yahusha), that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

John 7:38 He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.”

John 12:46 I have come into the world as light, so that no one who believes in me should stay in darkness."

John 14:12 “Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father.

John 1:12 Yet to all who received him, to those who believed in his name **OWYAZL** (Yahusha), he gave the right to become children of **AYAZL** (Yahuah)."

Romans 10:11 For the Scripture says, “Whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame.”

Psalms 138:3 When I cried to You, You answered me, and made me bold with strength in my soul.

Proverbs 14:26 In the fear of **AYAZL** (Yahuah) is strong confidence, and His children have a place of refuge. The fear of Yahuah is a fountain of life, to avoid the snares of death.

Matthew 10:19,20 But when they deliver you up, take no thought how or what you shall speak: for it shall be given you in that same hour what you shall speak. For it is not you who speak, but the Ruach (Spirit) of your Father **AYAZL** (Yahuah) who speaks in you.

Acts 18:9,10 Be not afraid, but speak, and hold not your Shalum (Peace). For I am with you, and no man shall set on you to hurt you: for I have much people in this city.

Hebrews 4:16 Let us therefore come boldly to the Throne of Grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in the time of need.

Luke 6:38 Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap."

Matthew 11:28 Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest."

Matthew 7: 7,8 Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find' knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives he who seeks finds; and to him who knocks, the door will be opened.

Isaiah 43:1 Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have summoned you by name; you are mine"

Matthew 17:20 So **OWYAZL** (Yahusha) said to them, “Because of your unbelief; for assuredly, I say to you, if you have Amunah (Faith) as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, ‘Move from here to there,’ and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you.

Luke 17:6 So **OWYAZL** (Yahusha) said, “If you have Amunah (Faith) as a mustard seed, you can say to this mulberry tree, ‘Be pulled up by the roots and be planted in the sea,’ and it would obey you.

Ephesians 6:16 above all, taking the shield of Amunah (Faith) with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one.

Deuteronomy 4:40 Keep His decrees and commands, which I am giving you today, so that it may go well with you and your children after you and that you may live long in the land **AYAZL** (Yahuah) your Aluhym gives you for all time.

Proverbs 14:26 He who fears (Reverences) **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) has a secure fortress, and for his children it will be a refuge.

Proverbs 20:7 The righteous man leads a blameless life; Baruk (Blessed) are his children after him.

Proverbs 22:6 Train a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not turn from it.

Ephesians 6:1-4 Children, obey your parents in **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), for this is right. "Honor your father and mother" - which is the first commandment with a promise - "that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on the earth." Fathers, do not exasperate your children; instead, bring them up in the training and instruction of **יְהוָה** (Yahuah).

James 1:12 Baruk (Blessed) is the man who perseveres under trial, because when he has stood the test, he will receive the crown of life that **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) has promised to those who love him.

Psalms 16:8,9 I have set **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) always before me: because He is at my right hand, I shall not be moved. Therefore my heart is glad, and my tongue rejoices: my body also shall dwell secure.

Psalms 56:9 When I cry to You, then shall my enemies turn back: this I know; for **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) is for me.

Proverbs 4:20,21,22 My son, attend to My words; incline your ear to My sayings. Let them not depart from your eyes; keep them in the midst of your heart. For they are life to those that find them, and health to all their flesh.

Proverbs 16:7 When a man's ways please **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), He makes even his enemies to be at Shalum (Peace) with him.

Isaiah 58:10 And if you draw out your soul to the hungry, and satisfy the afflicted soul; then shall your light rise in obscurity, and your darkness be as the noon day.

Proverbs 3:6 In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct your paths.

Luke 11:9-13 "And I say to you, ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you shall find; knock and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened..... If You then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give the Ruch Ah Qudesh to those who ask Him!"

Proverbs 21:21 He who pursues righteousness and love finds life, prosperity and honor.

Malachi 3:10 Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this, says **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) Almighty, and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of Shamym (Heavens) and pour out so much Barakah (Blessing) that you will not have room enough for it.

Joshua 3:5,7 **וַיֹּאמֶר** (Yahusha) said to the people, "Sanctify yourselves: for tomorrow **Psalm 89:** will do wonders among you." **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) said to **וַיֹּאמֶר** (Yahusha/Joshua), "This day will I begin to magnify you in the sight of all Yasharal (Israel), that they may know that, as

I was with Moshah (Moses), so I will be with you.”

Psalms 1:1-3 Baruk (Blessed) is the man that walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of the scornful. But his delight is in the Torah of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah); and in אַיָּהּ (Yahuah)’s Torah he meditates day and night. He shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that brings forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatever he does shall prosper.

Psalms 89:15,16,17,18 Baruk (Blessed) is the people that know the joyful sound: they shall walk, O אַיָּהּ (Yahuah), in the light of Your countenance. In Your name shall they rejoice all the day: and in Your righteousness shall they be exalted. For You are the glory of their strength: and in Your favor our horn shall be exalted. For אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) is our defense; and the Qadosh (Holy) One of Yasharal (Israel).

Isaiah 12:2,3 Behold אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) is my salvation; I will trust, and not be afraid: for אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) is my strength and my song; He also is become my salvation. Therefore with joy shall you draw water out of the wells of salvation.

Isaiah 12:5,6 Sing to אַיָּהּ (Yahuah); for He has done excellent things: this is known in all the earth. Cry out and shout, you inhabitant of Zion: for great is the Qadosh (Holy) One of Yasharal (Israel) in the midst of you.

Isaiah 55:12 For you shall go out with joy, and be led forth with Shalum (Peace): the mountains and the hills shall break forth before you into singing, and all the trees of the field shall clap their hands.

Isaiah 61:10 I will greatly rejoice in אַיָּהּ (Yahuah), my soul shall be joyful in my Aluhym; for He has clothed me with the garments of salvation, He has covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decks Himself with ornaments, and as a bride adorns herself with jewels.

Matthew 5:11,12 Baruk (Blessed) are you, when men shall revile you..... Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great is your reward in Shamym (Heavens).

John 14:23 O WYָּהּ (Yahusha) answered and said to him, “If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word; and My Father אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him.

John 14:27 Shalum (Peace) I leave with you, my Shalum (Peace) I give you. I do not give as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.”

Philippians 4:5-7 Let your gentleness be known to all men. אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) is at hand.

⁶ Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to אַיָּהּ (Yahuah); ⁷ and the Shalum (Peace) of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah), which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through O WYָּהּ (Yahusha).

John 14:12 Verily, verily, I say to you, He that believes on Me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go to My Father.

Jeremiah 29:12 Then you will call upon me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you.”

1 John 5:14 This is the assurance we have in approaching **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah); **that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us.**"

Psalms 55:16,17 But I call to **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah), and **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) saves me. **Evening, morning and noon I cry out in distress, and he hears my voice.**

Matthew 6:5,6 And when you pray, do not be like the hypocrites, for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and on the street corners to be seen by men. I tell you the truth, they have received their reward in full. **But when you pray, go into your room, close the door and pray to your Father who is unseen.** Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.

Matthew 6:7,8 And when you pray, do not keep on babbling like pagans, for they think they will be heard because of their many words. **Do not be like them,** for your Father knows what you need before you ask him.

Matthew 18:19 Again, I tell you that if two (2) of you on earth agree about anything you ask for, it will be done for you by my Father in Shamyim (Heavens).

Hebrews 4:16 Let us then approach the throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.

Proverbs 1:33 But whoever listens to me will live in safety and be at ease, without fear of harm

Psalms 37:3-4 Trust in **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) and do good; dwell in the land and enjoy safe pasture. **Delight yourself in אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) and He will give you the desires of your heart.

Proverbs 2:11-12 Discretion will protect you, and understanding will guard you. **Wisdom** will save you from the ways of wicked men.

Deuteronomy 8:6-11 Therefore you shall keep the Commandments of **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) your Aluhym, to walk in His ways, and to fear Him. For **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) your Aluhym brings you into a good land, a land of brooks of water, of fountains and depths that spring out of valleys and hills; a land of wheat, and barley, and vines, and fig trees, and pomegranates; a land of olive oil, and honey; a land wherein you shall eat bread without scarceness, you shall not lack anything in it; a land whose stones are iron, and out of whose hills you may dig brass. **When you have eaten and are full, then you shall Baruk (Bless) אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) your Aluhym for the good land which He has given you. Beware that you forget not **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) your Aluhym, in not keeping His commandments, and His judgments, and His statutes, which I command you this day.

Genesis 22:18 But you shall remember **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) your Aluhym: for it is He that gives you power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day.

Deuteronomy 28:1,2 And it shall come to pass, if you shall listen diligently to the voice of **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) your Aluhym, to observe and to do all His commandments which I command you this day, that **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) your Aluhym will set you on high above all nations of the earth: and all these blessings shall come on you, and overtake you.

Psalms 112:1,2,3 Baruk (Blessed) is the man that fears **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah), that delights greatly in

His commandments. His seed shall be mighty upon earth: the generation of the upright shall be blessed. Wealth and riches shall be in his house.

Matthew 6:33 Seek first the kingdom of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah), and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added to you.

2 Chronicles 20:17 You will not need to fight in this battle. Position yourselves, stand still and see the salvation of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah), who is with you, O Yahudah and Yarusalym (Jerusalem)! Do not fear or be dismayed; tomorrow go out against them, for אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) is with you.”

Acts 16:31 So they said, “Believe on **OWYָּהּ** (Yahusha) and you will be saved, you and your household.”

Romans 10:9 that if you confess with your mouth **OWYָּהּ** (Yahusha) HaMashiach and believe in your heart that אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.

Romans 10:13 For “whoever calls on the name of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) shall be saved.”

Isaiah 40:31 But they that wait upon אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.

Joshua 1:9 Have not I commanded? Be strong and of a good courage, be not afraid, neither be dismayed: for אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) your Aluhym is with you wherever you go.

2 Chronicles 15:7 Be strong therefore, and let not your hands be weak: for your work shall be rewarded.

Isaiah 41:10 Fear not; for I am with you: be not dismayed; for I am your Aluhym: I will strengthen you; yes, I will help you; yes, I will uphold you with the right hand of My righteousness.

Haggai 2:4 Be strong, all you people of the land, and work: for I am with you, says אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) of Hosts.

Joshua 1:8 This Book of the Turah (Law) shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.

Proverbs 3: 5-6 "Trust in אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge him, אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) shall direct you paths.

Psalms 37:5 Commit your way to אַיָּהּ (Yahuah), Trust also in Him, And He shall bring it to pass.

Jeremiah 39:18 For I will surely deliver you, and you shall not fall by the sword; but your life shall be as a prize to you, because you have put your trust in Me,” says אַיָּהּ (Yahuah).

Nahum 1:7 אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) is good, A stronghold in the day of trouble; And He knows those who trust in Him.

Deuteronomy 28:13 “And אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) will make you the head and not the tail; you shall be above only, and not be beneath, if you heed the commandments of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) your Aluhym, which I command you today, and are careful to observe them and to do them.”

Joshua 10:24-25 Then **OWYAZL** (Yahusha/Joshua) said to them, “Fear not, nor be dismayed; be strong and of good courage, for thus **AYAZL** (Yahuah) will do to all your enemies against whom you fight.”

1 Corinthians 15:57,58 But thanks be to **AYAZL** (Yahuah), who gives us the victory through our Mashiach **OWYAZL** (Yahusha). Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of **AYAZL** (Yahuah), knowing that your labor is not in vain in **AYAZL** (Yahuah).

Proverbs 2:6-8 For **AYAZL** (Yahuah) gives wisdom; From His mouth come knowledge and understanding; ⁷ He stores up sound wisdom for the upright (Righteous); He is a shield to those who walk uprightly; ⁸ He guards the paths of justice, And preserves the way of His Chosen.

Proverbs 11:2 When pride comes, then comes shame; But with the humble is Wisdom.

James 1:5 If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of **AYAZL** (Yahuah), who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him

Hebrews 10:26 For if we sin willfully after we have received the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins, ²⁷ but a certain fearful expectation of judgment, and fiery indignation which will devour the adversaries. ²⁸ Anyone who has rejected Moshah (Moses) law dies without mercy on the testimony of two (2) or three (3) witnesses. ²⁹ Of how much worse punishment, do you suppose, will he be thought worthy who has trampled the Son of **AYAZL** (Yahuah) underfoot, counted the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified a common thing, and insulted the Ruch (Spirit) of Chen (grace)? ³⁰ For we know Him who said, “Vengeance is Mine, I will repay,” says **AYAZL** (Yahuah). And again, “**AYAZL** (Yahuah) will judge His people.

Psalms 1:1-5 Baruk (Blessed) is the man that walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of the scornful. But his delight is in the Turah (law) of **AYAZL** (Yahuah); and in His Turah (law) does he meditate day and night. And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that brings forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he does shall prosper. The ungodly are not so: but are like the chaff which the wind drives away. Therefore the unrighteous shall not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous. For **AYAZL** (Yahuah) knows the way of the righteous: but the way of the ungodly shall perish.

Proverbs 3:7-10 Be not wise in your own eyes: fear **AYAZL** (Yahuah), and depart from evil. It shall be health to your navel, and marrow to your bones. Honor **AYAZL** (Yahuah) with your substance, and with the first fruits of all your increase: so shall your barns be filled with plenty, and your presses will burst out with new wine.

Isaiah 58:9-11 Then you shall call, and **AYAZL** (Yahuah) will answer; You shall cry, and He will say, ‘Here I am.’ If you take away the yoke from your midst, The pointing of the finger, and speaking wickedness, ¹⁰ If you extend your soul to the hungry And satisfy the afflicted soul, Then your light shall dawn in the darkness, And your darkness shall be as the noonday. **11** **AYAZL** (Yahuah) will guide you continually, And satisfy your soul in drought, And strengthen your bones; you shall be like a watered garden, And like a spring of water, whose waters do not fail.

Amos 14,15 Seek good, not evil, that you may live. **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) Aluhym Almighty will be with you, just as you say He is. Hate evil, love good; maintain justice in the courts. Perhaps **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) Aluhym Almighty will have mercy on the remnant of Joseph.

James 1:25 But whoso looks into the perfect law of liberty, and continues therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be Baruk (Blessed) in his deed.

1 John 3:21-23 Beloved, if our heart condemn us not, then have we confidence toward **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah). And whatsoever we ask, we receive of Him, because we keep His commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in His sight. And this is His commandment, "that we should believe on the name of His son **וְיָהוּשָׁע** (Yahusha), and love one another, as He gave us commandment."

Revelation 2:26,28 And he that overcomes, and keeps My works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of My Father.

Revelation 3:5 He that overcomes, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before My Father, and before His Malakym (Angels)

Romans 8:5-7,9 For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Ruch (Spirit), the things of the Ruch (Spirit). For to be carnally minded is death: but to be spiritually minded is life and Shalum (Peace). Because the carnal mind is enmity against **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah): for it is not subject to the Turah (law) of **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah), neither indeed can be. But you are not in the flesh, but in the Ruch (Spirit), if so be that the Ruch (Spirit) of **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Ruch (Spirit) of **וְיָהוּשָׁע** (Yahusha), he is none of His.

2 Corinthians 9:6-8 But this I say, "He which sows sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which sows bountifully shall reap also bountifully. Every man according as he purposes in his heart, so let him give: not grudgingly, or of necessity: for **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) loves a cheerful giver. And **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) is able to make all grace abound toward you; that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work."

Ephesians 4:29 Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers.

Ephesians 4:30-32 And grieve not the Ruch Ah Qudesh of **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah), whereby you are sealed unto the day of redemption. Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamor, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice: and be you kind one to another, tender-hearted, forgiving one another, even as **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) for **וְיָהוּשָׁע** (Yahusha)'s sake has forgiven you.

Philippians 2:14-16 Do all things without murmurings and disputings, that you may be blameless and harmless, the sons of **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah), without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom you shine as lights in the world; holding forth the word of life.

Philippians 4:6-7 Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah); 7 and the Shalum (Peace)

of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah), which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through אוֹיָּהּ (Yahusha) Ha Mashiach.

Philippians 4:8,9 Finally, brethren, [whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things. Those things, which you have both learned, and received, and heard, and seen in me, do: and the אַיָּהּ \(Yahuah\) of Shalum \(Peace\) shall be with you.](#)

Philemon 6 [pray that you may be active in sharing your Amunah \(Faith\),](#) so that you will have a full understanding of every good thing we have in אוֹיָּהּ (Yahusha).

Jeremiah 29:11-13 "For I know the thoughts that I think toward you", says אַיָּהּ (Yahuah), "thoughts of Shalum (Peace), and not of evil, to give you an expected end. [Then shall you call upon Me, and you shall go and pray unto Me,](#) and I will hearken unto you. [And you shall seek Me, and find Me, when you shall search for Me with all your heart.](#)"

1 Peter 5:6-8 [Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of אַיָּהּ \(Yahuah\),](#) that He may exalt you in due time: [casting all your care upon Him;](#) for He cares for you. [Be sober, be vigilant;](#) because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walks about, seeking whom he may devour.

1 John 2:15-17 [Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world.](#) If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. And the world passes away, and the lust thereof: [but he that does the will of אַיָּהּ \(Yahuah\)](#) abides forever.

1 Corinthians 3:16,17; 6:19,20 Do you not Know that you are the temple of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah), and that the Ruch (Spirit) of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) dwells in you? [If any man defile the temple of אַיָּהּ \(Yahuah\),](#) him shall אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) destroy; for the temple of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) is Qadosh (holy), which temple you are... Know you not that your body is the temple of the Ruch Ah Qudesh, which is in you, which you have of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah), and you are not your own? For you are bought with a price: [therefore glorify אַיָּהּ \(Yahuah\) in your body, and in your ruch \(spirit\), which are אַיָּהּ \(Yahuah\)'s.](#)

1 John 1:9-2:2 [If we confess our sins,](#) He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. [If we say that we have not sinned,](#) we make Him a liar, and His word is not in us. My little children, these things write I unto you, [that you sin not.](#) And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) , אוֹיָּהּ (Yahusha) the righteous: and He is the atonement (propitiation) for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world.

Ezra 8:22b The hand of our Aluhym is upon all them for good [that seek Him;](#) but His power and His wrath is against all them [that forsake Him.](#)

Romans 5:1 [Therefore being justified by Amunah \(Faith\),](#) we have Shalum (Peace) with אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) through our Mashiach אוֹיָּהּ (Yahusha).

1 John 5:3,4 For this is the love of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah), [that we keep His commandments: and His commandments are not grievous.](#) For whatsoever is born of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) overcomes the world: and this is the victory that overcomes the world, even our Amunah (Faith).
