

Scriptural Promises

Scripture is jam-packed with promises made to us by **יהוה** (Yahuah). When we start digging into the promises of **יהוה** (Yahuah), we find that he promises us many things:

- **יהוה** (Yahuah)'s help and guidance
- **יהוה** (Yahuah)'s Faithfulness
- Our Salvation
- Wisdom
- Shalum (Peace), Joy, and Aahbah (Love)
- Riches in Shamym (Heaven)
- Adoption into his family
- Strength and Power
- **יהוה** (Yahuah)'s provision
- Eternal life
- Deliverance (from enemies, from danger, from temptation)
- Healing
- Renewal

Knowing the promises of **יהוה** (Yahuah) can help us in our daily lives, to be able to navigate both big and small decisions, and to conquer fear, temptation, and danger. When we know what **יהוה** (Yahuah) has promised us, we can confidently claim those things in our own lives.

Fourteen (14) Promises of **יהוה** (Yahuah)'s Guidance & Help

For this Alhym is our Alhym for ever and ever; he will be our guide even to the end. **Psalms 48:14**

I am with you and will watch over you wherever you go, and I will bring you back to this land. I will not leave you until I have done what I have promised you. **Genesis 28:15**

Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for **יהוה** (Yahuah) your Alhym will be with you wherever you go. **Joshua 1:9**

Though he may stumble, he will not fall, for **יהוה** (Yahuah) upholds him with his hand. **Psalms 37:4**

Your word is a lamp to guide my feet and a light for my path. **Psalms 119:105**

For I am **יהוה** (Yahuah) your Alhym who takes hold of your right hand and says to you, Do not fear I will help you. **Isaiah 41:13**

יהוה (Yahuah) says, "I will guide you along the best pathway for your life. I will advise you and watch over you. **Psalms 32:8**

Those who know your name trust in you, for you, **יהוה** (Yahuah), have never forsaken those who seek you. **Psalms 9:10**

In all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight. **Proverbs 3:6**

If you return to **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), then your fellow Yasharalites (Israelites) and your children will be shown compassion by their captors and will return to this land, for **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) your Alhym is gracious and compassionate. He will not turn his face from you if you return to him. **2 Chronicles 30:9**

Whether you turn to the right or to the left, your ears will hear a voice behind you, saying, “This is the way; walk in it.” **Isaiah 30:21**

יְהוָה (Yahuah) will guide you always; he will satisfy your needs in a sun-scorched land and will strengthen your frame. You will be like a well-watered garden, like a spring whose waters never fail. **Isaiah 58:11**

In their hearts humans plan their course, but **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) establishes their steps. **Proverbs 16:9**

The gatekeeper opens the gate for him, and the sheep listen to his voice. He calls his own sheep by Name and leads them out. When he has brought out all his own, he goes on ahead of them, and his sheep follow him because they know his voice. **John 10:3-4**

Ten (10) Promises about **יְהוָה (Yahuah)’s Faithfulness**

Though the mountains be shaken and the hills be removed, yet my unfailing love for you will not be shaken nor my covenant of Shalum (Peace) be removed, “says **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), who has compassion on you. **Isaiah 54:10**

Understand, therefore, that **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) your Alhym is indeed Alhym. He is the Faithful Alhym who keeps his covenant for a thousand generations and lavishes his unfailing love on those who love him and obey his commands. **Deuteronomy 7:9**

If we are Faithless, He remains Faithful, for He cannot deny Himself. **2 Timothy 2:13**

יְהוָה (Yahuah) is Faithful, who will establish you and guard you from the evil one. **2 Thessalonians 3:3**

For the Word of **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) is upright, and all His work is done in Faithfulness. **Psalms 33:4**

Your Faithfulness endures to all generations; you have established the earth, and it stands fast. **Psalms 119:90**

Alhym is Faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of his Son, **וְיֵשׁוּעַ** (Yahusha) HaMashiach our Adon (Lord/Master). **1 Corinthians 1:9**

Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who promised is Faithful. **Hebrews 10:23**

Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid or terrified because of them, for **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) your Alhym goes with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you. **Deuteronomy 31:6**

יְהוָה (Yahuah)’s loving kindnesses indeed never cease, For His compassions never fail. They are new every morning; Great is Your Faithfulness. **Lamentations 3:22-23**

Thirty-Four (34) Promises about Salvation

For it is by grace you have been saved, through Amunah (Faith)—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of **יְהוָה** (Yahuah). **Ephesians 2:8**

So, don’t be afraid, little flock. For it gives your Father great happiness to give you the Kingdom. **Luke 12:32**

But people are counted as righteous, not because of their work, but because of their Amunah (Faith) in Alhym who forgives sinners. **Romans 4:5**

Who dares accuse us whom Alhym has chosen for his own? No one, for Alhym himself has given us right standing with himself. Who then will condemn us? No one, for **OWYAZL** (Yahusha) HaMashiach died for us and was raised to life for us, and he is sitting in the place of honor at Alhym's right hand, pleading for us.

Romans 8:33-34

But if we confess our sins to him, he is Faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness. **1 John 1:9**

Therefore, accept each other just as Mashiach has accepted you so that Alhym will be given glory. **Romans 15:7**

Just think how much more the blood of Mashiach will purify our consciences from sinful deeds so that we can worship the living Alhym. For by the power of the eternal Ruch (Spirit), Mashiach offered himself to Alhym as a perfect sacrifice for our sins. **Hebrews 9:14**

All praise to Alhym, the Father of our Adon (Lord) **OWYAZL** (Yahusha) HaMashiach. It is by his great mercy that we have been born again, because **AYAZL** (Yahuah) raised **OWYAZL** (Yahusha) HaMashiach from the dead. Now we live with great expectation, and we have a priceless inheritance—an inheritance that is kept in Shamym (Heaven) for you, pure and undefiled, beyond the reach of change and decay. **1 Peter 1:3-4**

“Believe in Adon (lord) **OWYAZL** (Yahusha), and you will be saved—you and your household.” **Acts 16:31**

If you declare with your mouth, “**OWYAZL** (Yahusha) is Adon (Lord/Master),” and believe in your heart that **AYAZL** (Yahuah) raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your Amunah (Faith) and are saved. **Romans 10:9-10**

I tell you the truth, those who listen to my message and believe in Alhym who sent me have eternal life. They will never be condemned for their sins, but they have already passed from death into life. **John 5:24**

For the grace of **AYAZL** (Yahuah) has appeared that offers salvation to all people. It teaches us to say “No” to unrighteousness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright and Righteous lives in this present age. **Titus 2:11-12**

Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for Alhym's wrath remains on them. **John 3:36**

And how from infancy you have known the Qadosh Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through Amunah (Faith) in **OWYAZL** (Yahusha) HaMashiach. **2 Timothy 3:15**

For **AYAZL** (Yahuah) so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. **John 3:16**

In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of **AYAZL** (Yahuah)'s grace. **Ephesians 1:7**

So, if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed. **John 8:36**

For I am not ashamed of the good news, because it is the power of Alhym that brings salvation to everyone who believes: first (1st) to the Hebrew, then to the Gentile. **Romans 1:16**

But the one (1) who stands firm to the end will be saved. **Matthew 24:13**

This is good, and pleases Alhym our Savior, who wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth. **1 Timothy 2:3-4**

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) has united you with **וְיֵשׁוּעַ** (Yahusha) HaMashiach. For our benefit אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) made him to be wisdom itself. Mashiach made us right with אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah); he made us pure and Qadosh (Holy), and he freed us from Sin. Therefore, as the Scriptures say, “If you want to boast, boast only about אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah). **1 Corinthians 1:30-31**

He saved us, not because of the righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He washed away our sins, giving us a new birth and new life through the Ruch Ah Qudesh (Holy Spirit). **Titus 3:5**

For you know that Alhym paid a ransom to save you from the empty life you inherited from your ancestors. And it was not paid with mere gold or silver, which lose their value. It was the precious blood of Mashiach, the sinless, spotless Lamb of Alhym. **1 Peter 1:18-19**

And Mashiach lives within you, so even though your body will die because of sin, the Ruch (Spirit) gives you life because you have been made right with אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah). The Ruch (Spirit) of אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), who raised **וְיֵשׁוּעַ** (Yahusha) from the dead, lives in you. And just as אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) raised **וְיֵשׁוּעַ** (Yahusha) HaMashiach from the dead, he will give life to your mortal bodies by this same Ruch (Spirit) living within you. **Romans 8:10-11**

This is real love—not that we loved אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to take away our Sins. **1 John 4:10**

So just as Sin ruled over all people and brought them to death, now אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah)’s wonderful grace rules instead, giving us right standing with אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) and resulting in eternal life through **וְיֵשׁוּעַ** (Yahusha) HaMashiach our Adon (Lord/Master). **Romans 5:21**

But he was pierced for our rebellion, crushed for our sins. He was beaten so we could be whole. He was whipped so we could be healed. **Isaiah 53:5**

For אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) chose to save us through our Adon (Lord) **וְיֵשׁוּעַ** (Yahusha) HaMashiach, not to pour out his anger on us. **1 Thessalonians 5:9**

I am overwhelmed with joy in אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) my Alhym! For he has dressed me with the clothing of salvation and draped me in a robe of righteousness. I am like a bridegroom dressed for his wedding or a bride with her jewels. **Isaiah 61:10**

You are a chosen people. You are royal priests, a Qadosh (Holy) nation, Alhym’s very own possession. As a result, you can show others the goodness of Alhym, for he called you out of the darkness into his wonderful light. **1 Peter 2:9**

Brothers, listen! We are here to proclaim that through this man **וְיֵשׁוּעַ** (Yahusha) there is forgiveness for your Sins. Everyone who believes in him is made right in אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah)’s sight—something the Turah (law) of Moshah (Moses) could never do. **Acts 13:38-39**

For אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah)’s will was for us to be made Qadosh (Holy) by the sacrifice of the body of **וְיֵשׁוּעַ** (Yahusha) HaMashiach, once for all time.... For by that one offering he forever made perfect those who are being made Qadosh (Holy). **Hebrews 10:10; 14**

For he has rescued us from the kingdom of darkness and transferred us into the Kingdom of his dear Son.

Colossians 1:13

Yet to all who did receive him, to those who believed in his Name, he gave the right to become children of **אֵלֹהִים** (Yahuah)— children born not of natural descent, nor of human decision or a husband's will, but born of Alhym. **John 1:12-13**

Kepha (Peter) replied, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of **וְיֵשׁוּעַ** (Yahusha) HaMashiach for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Ruch Ah Qudesh (Holy Spirit).

Acts 2:38

Three (3) Promises of Wisdom

For **אֵלֹהִים** (Yahuah) gives wisdom; from his mouth come knowledge and understanding. He holds success in store for the upright, he is a shield to those whose walk is blameless. **Proverbs 2:6-7**

Come and listen to my counsel. I'll share my heart with you and make you wise. **Proverbs 1:23**

If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask Alhym, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you. **James 1:5**

Eight (8) Promises about Shalum (Peace), Joy, and Aahbah (Love)

Shalum (Peace) I leave with you; my Shalum (Peace) I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid. **John 14:27**

Therefore, since we have been made right in **אֵלֹהִים** (Yahuah)'s sight by Amunah (Faith), we have Shalum (Peace) with **אֵלֹהִים** (Yahuah) because of what **וְיֵשׁוּעַ** (Yahusha) HaMashiach our Adon (Lord) has done for us. **Romans 5:1**

Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself unless it abides in the vine, so neither *can* you unless you abide in Me. **John 15:3**

The fruit of that righteousness will be Shalum (Peace); its effect will be quietness and confidence forever. **Isaiah 32:17**

Take delight in **אֵלֹהִים** (Yahuah), and he will give you the desires of your heart. **Psalms 37:4**

Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from **אֵלֹהִים** (Yahuah). Everyone who loves has been born of **אֵלֹהִים** (Yahuah) and knows **אֵלֹהִים** (Yahuah). Whoever does not love does not know **אֵלֹהִים** (Yahuah), because **אֵלֹהִים** (Yahuah) is Aahbah (love). **1 John 4:7-8**

And the Shalum (Peace) of Alhym, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in **וְיֵשׁוּעַ** (Yahusha) HaMashiach. **Philippians 4:7**

And I am convinced that nothing can ever separate us from **אֵלֹהִים** (Yahuah)'s love. Neither death nor life, neither Malkym (Angels) nor demons, neither our fears for today nor our worries about tomorrow—not even the powers of Gehenna can separate us from **אֵלֹהִים** (Yahuah)'s love. No power in the sky above or in the earth below—indeed, nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of **אֵלֹהִים** (Yahuah) that is revealed in **וְיֵשׁוּעַ** (Yahusha) HaMashiach our Adon (Lord). **Romans 8:38-39**

Five (5) Promises about Gaining Riches in Shamym (Heaven)

Therefore, whoever takes the lowly position of this child is the greatest in the kingdom of Shamym (Heaven).

Matthew 18:4

Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moths and vermin destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. But store up for yourselves treasures in Shamym (Heaven), where moths and vermin do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

Matthew 6:19-21

If anyone gives you even a cup of water because you belong to the Mashiach, I tell you the truth, that person will surely be rewarded. **Mark 9:41**

Baruk (Blessed) are you when people insult you, persecute you and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of me. Rejoice and be glad, because great is your reward in Shamym (Heaven), for in the same way they persecuted the prophets who were before you. **Matthew 5:11-12**

My Father's house has many rooms; if that were not so, would I have told you that I am going there to prepare a place for you? **John 14:2**

Six (6) Promises about Adoption into Alhym's Family

The Ruch (Spirit) you received does not make you slaves, so that you live in fear again; rather, the Ruch (Spirit) you received brought about your adoption to sonship. And by him we cry, "Abba, Father." **Romans 8:15**

Baruk (Blessed) are the meek, for they will inherit the earth. **Matthew 5:5**

But now, this is what **אֵלֹהִים** (Yahuah) says— he who created you, Yaqoob (Jacob), he who formed you, Yasharal (Israel): Do not fear, for I have redeemed you; I have summoned you by name; you are mine. **Isaiah 43:1**

I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you. **John 14:8**

All praise to **אֵלֹהִים** (Yahuah), the Father of our Adon (Lord) **וְיֵשׁוּעַ** (Yahusha) HaMashiach. It is by his great mercy that we have been born again, because **אֵלֹהִים** (Yahuah) raised **וְיֵשׁוּעַ** (Yahusha) HaMashiach from the dead. Now we live with great expectation, and we have a priceless inheritance—an inheritance that is kept in Shamym (Heaven) for you, pure and undefiled, beyond the reach of change and decay. **1 Peter 1:3-4**

But to all who believed him and accepted him, he gave the right to become children of **אֵלֹהִים** (Yahuah). **John 1:12**

Five (5) Promises of Strength & Power

He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak. **Isaiah 40:29**

But those who hope in **אֵלֹהִים** (Yahuah) will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary; they will walk and not be faint. **Isaiah 40:31**

So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your Alhym. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand. **Isaiah 41:10**

“Have Amunah (Faith) in אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah),” אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahusha) answered. “Truly I tell you, if anyone says to this mountain, ‘Go, throw yourself into the sea,’ and does not doubt in their heart but believes that what they say will happen, it will be done for them”. **Mark 11:22-23**

And I will put my Ruch (Spirit) in you and move you to follow my decrees and be careful to keep my Turah (laws). **Ezekiel 36:27**

Thirty-Two (32) Promises of אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah)’s Provision

He will love you and Barak (Bless) you and increase your numbers. He will Barak (Bless) the fruit of your womb, the crops of your land—your grain, new wine and olive oil—the calves of your herds and the lambs of your flocks in the land he swore to your ancestors to give you. **Deuteronomy 7:13**

Keep this Book of the Turah (Law) always on your lips; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful. **Joshua 1:8**

Those who are honest and fair, who refuse to profit by fraud, who stay far away from bribes, who refuse to listen to those who plot murder, who shut their eyes to all enticement to do wrong 16. these are the ones who will dwell on high. The rocks of the mountains will be their fortress. Food will be supplied to them, and they will have water in abundance. **Isaiah 33:15-16**

But if a wicked person turns away from all the sins they have committed and keeps all my decrees and does what is just and right, that person will surely live; they will not die. None of the offenses they have committed will be remembered against them. Because of the righteous things they have done, they will live. **Ezekiel 18:21-22**

So, if you sinful people know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give good gifts to those who ask him. **Matthew 7:11**

Trust in אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) and do good; dwell in the land and enjoy safe pasture. Take delight in אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah), and he will give you the desires of your heart. Commit your way to אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah); trust in him and he will do this: **Psalms 37:3-5**

Worship אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) your Alhym, and his Barakah (Blessing) will be on your food and water. I will take away sickness from among you. **Exodus 23:25**

But seek first (1st) his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. **Matthew 6:33**

If they obey and serve him, they will spend the rest of their days in prosperity and their years in contentment. **Job 36:11**

If you believe, you will receive whatever you ask for in prayer. **Matthew 21:22**

I will provide grass in the fields for your cattle, and you will eat and be satisfied. **Deuteronomy 11:15**

אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) is good to those whose hope is in him, to the one who seeks him; **Lamentations 3:25**

Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this,” says אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) Almighty, “and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of Shamym (Heaven) and pour out so much Barakah (Blessing) that there will not be room enough to store it. **Malachi 3:10**

יְהוָה (Yahuah) gives sight to the blind, יְהוָה (Yahuah) lifts up those who are bowed down, יְהוָה (Yahuah) loves the righteous. **Psalm 146:8**

Those who trust in their riches will fall, but the righteous will thrive like a green leaf. **Proverbs 11:28**

Take delight in יְהוָה (Yahuah), and he will give you the desires of your heart. **Psalm 37:4**

Moreover, when יְהוָה (Yahuah) gives someone wealth and possessions, and the ability to enjoy them, to accept their lot and be happy in their toil—this is a gift of יְהוָה (Yahuah). **Ecclesiastes 5:19**

But Alhym will never forget the needy; the hope of the afflicted will never perish. **Psalm 9:18**

I will Barak (Bless) her with abundant provisions; her poor I will satisfy with food. **Psalm 132:15**

And my Alhym will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in **וְיֵשׁוּעָה (Yahusha) HaMashiach. Philippians 4:19**

Then, turning to his disciples, **וְיֵשׁוּעָה (Yahusha)** said, “That is why I tell you not to worry about everyday life—whether you have enough food to eat or enough clothes to wear. For life is more than food, and your body more than clothing. Look at the ravens. They don’t plant or harvest or store food in barns, for יְהוָה (Yahuah) feeds them. And you are far more valuable to him than any birds! **Luke 12:22-24**

Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up. **Galatians 6:9**

For I will pour water on the thirsty land, and streams on the dry ground; I will pour out my Ruch (Spirit) on your offspring, and my Barakah (Blessing) on your descendants. **Isaiah 44:3**

Then **וְיֵשׁוּעָה (Yahusha)** declared, “I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never go hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty.” **John 6:35**

Carefully follow the terms of this covenant, so that you may prosper in everything you do. **Deuteronomy 29:9**

יְהוָה (Yahuah) is my shepherd, I lack nothing. He makes me lie down in green pastures, he leads me beside quiet waters, he refreshes my soul. He guides me along the right paths for his name’s sake. **Psalm 23:1-3**

The poor will eat and be satisfied; those who seek יְהוָה (Yahuah) will praise him, may your hearts live forever! **Psalm 22:26**

Therefore, we do not lose heart. Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day. For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all. **2 Corinthians 4:16-17**

Baruk (Blessed) are the meek, for they will inherit the earth. **Matthew 5:5**

No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And יְהוָה (Yahuah) is Faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it. **1 Corinthians 10:13**

They are like trees planted along the riverbank, bearing fruit each season. Their leaves never wither, and they prosper in all they do. **Psalm 1:3**

Stay on the path that יְהוָה (Yahuah) your Alhym has commanded you to follow. Then you will live long and prosperous lives in the land you are about to enter and occupy. **Deuteronomy 5:33**

Ten (10) Promises of Eternal Life

He will wipe every tear from their eyes, and there will be no more death or sorrow or crying or pain. All these things are gone forever. **Revelation 21:4**

He will swallow up death forever. The Sovereign Adon (Lord) will wipe away the tears from all faces; he will remove his people's disgrace from all the earth. **Isaiah 25:8**

But your dead will live, אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah); their bodies will rise, let those who dwell in the dust wake up and shout for joy, your dew is like the dew of the morning; the earth will give birth to her dead. **Isaiah 26:19**

Surely your goodness and love will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) forever. **Psalms 23:6**

He will take pity on the weak and the needy and save the needy from death. **Psalms 72:13**

But Alhym will redeem me from the realm of the dead; he will surely take me to himself. **Psalms 49:15**

My Father's house has many rooms; if that were not so, would I have told you that I am going there to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am. **John 14:2-3**

I tell you the truth, anyone who obeys my teaching will never die! **John 8:51**

I tell you the truth, those who listen to my message and believe in אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) who sent me have eternal life. They will never be condemned for their sins, but they have already passed from death into life. **John 5:24**

Sixteen (16) Promises of Deliverance (from enemies, from danger, from temptation)

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) helps them and delivers them; he delivers them from the wicked and saves them, because they take refuge in him. **Psalms 37:40**

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) will fight for you; you need only to be still. **Exodus 14:14**

But whoever listens to me will live in safety and be at ease, without fear of harm. **Proverbs 1:33**

The name of אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) is a fortified tower; the righteous run to it and are safe. **Proverbs 18:10**

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) keeps you from all harm and watches over your life. אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) keeps watch over you as you come and go, both now and forever. **Psalms 121:7-8**

Sing to אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah)! Give Halal (Praise) to אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah)! He rescues the life of the needy from the hands of the wicked. **Jeremiah 20:13**

Bauruk (Blessed) are those who have regard for the weak; אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) delivers them in times of trouble. אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) protects and preserves them, they are counted among the Baruk (Blessed) in the land, he does not give them over to the desire of their foes. **Psalms 41:1-2**

Submit yourselves, then, to אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah). Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. **James 4:7**

For אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) your Alhym is the one who goes with you to fight for you against your enemies to give you victory. **Deuteronomy 20:4**

Those who trust in themselves are fools, but those who walk in wisdom are kept safe. **Proverbs 28:26**

You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. **Psalm 23:5**

No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) is Faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it. **1 Corinthians 10:13**

But in that coming day no weapon turned against you will succeed. You will silence every voice raise up to accuse you. These benefits are enjoyed by the servants of אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah); their vindication will come from me. **Isaiah 54:17**

About Benjamin he said: "Let the beloved of אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) rest secure in him, for he shields him all day long, and the one אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) loves rests between his shoulders." **Deuteronomy 33:12**

Though I walk in the midst of trouble, you preserve my life. You stretch out your hand against the anger of my foes; with your right hand you save me. **Psalm 138:7**

Therefore, everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock. The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house; yet it did not fall, because it had its foundation on the rock. **Matthew 7:24-25**

Eight (8) Promises for Healing

And the prayer offered in Amunah (Faith) will make the sick person well; אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) will raise them up. If they have sinned, they will be forgiven. **James 5:15**

Heal me, אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah), and I will be healed; save me and I will be saved, for you are the one I praise. **Jeremiah 17:14**

He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds. **Psalm 147:3**

But I will restore you to health and heal your wounds, declares אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah). **Jeremiah 30:17**

I am אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah), who heals you. **Exodus 15:26**

Worship אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) your Alhym, and his Barakah (Blessing) will be on your food and water. I will take away sickness from among you. **Exodus 23:25**

And my Alhym will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in **OWYAH** (Yahusha) HaMashiach. **Philippians 4:19**

Nevertheless, I will bring health and healing to it; I will heal my people and will let them enjoy abuShalum (Peace) and security. **Jeremiah 33:6**

Eleven (11) Promises of Renewal

Therefore, if anyone is in Mashiach, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here! **2 Corinthians 5:17**

For the grace of Alhym has appeared that offers salvation to all people. It teaches us to say "No" to unrighteousness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright and Righteous lives in this present age. **Titus 2:11-12**

אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of Alhym. **2 Corinthians 5:21**

For Sin shall no longer be your master, because you are not under the Turah (law), but under grace. **Romans 6:14**

Do not lie to each other, since you have taken off your old self with its practices and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge in the image of its Creator. **Colossians 3:9-10**

And we know that in all things אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose. **Romans 8:28**

But if we confess our sins to him, he is Faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness. **1 John 1:9**

Then I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean. Your filth will be washed away, and you will no longer worship idols. And I will give you a new heart, and I will put a new Ruch (Spirit) in you. I will take out your stony, stubborn heart and give you a tender, responsive heart. **Ezekiel 36:25-26**

So, you also should consider yourselves to be dead to the power of sin and alive to אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) through **OWYָּהּ** (Yahusha) HaMashiach. **Romans 6:11**

All praise to אַיָּהּ (Yahuah), the Father of our Adon (Lord) **OWYָּהּ** (Yahusha) HaMashiach. It is by his great mercy that we have been born again, because אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) raised **OWYָּהּ** (Yahusha) HaMashiach from the dead. Now we live with great expectation, and we have a priceless inheritance—an inheritance that is kept in Shamym (Heaven) for you, pure and undefiled, beyond the reach of change and decay. **1 Peter 1:3-4**

So, all of us who have had that veil removed can see and reflect the glory of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah). And אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) —who is the Ruch (Spirit)—makes us more and more like him as we are changed into his glorious image. **2 Corinthians 3:18**
